

Despite the bad winter, there will be no problems getting the division two programme finished on time, indeed Brechin Vics have only one game to play. It makes one wonder when the season might have finished if we had had a mild winter!

### **TODAY'S GAME**

This evening brings the third meeting this season between Jeanfield and Tayport, with the sides each having recorded a win.

The most recent, of course, was our Whyte & Mackay Cup win here the other week. The first meeting resulted in our sole league defeat to date (as if we need reminding) and we will be going all out to redress the balance.

The early season meeting on 11th September was described thus -

"Tayport got off to a great start and were quickly 2-0 ahead but Jeanfield , playing out of their skins, none more so than ex-Tayport Amateur Kenny Cameron, battled away, took their chances and the points. Tayport had much of the second half but too many players were not at their best. In a game littered with yellow cards, Jackie Devine collected two late in the game and took the long walk

Jeanfield will have every incentive for doing well tonight. As well as seeking early revenge for that cup defeat they'll be looking to record a notable double.

Jeanfield's win at Downfield at the beginning of April indicated just what they are capable of and Tayport would be foolish to treat the Perth side with anything other than respect.

Since they played on the Canniepairt eleven days ago Swifts' displays have confounded their supporters. A shock 1-4 defeat by relegation candidates Broughty Athletic last Wednesday was followed by another home league reverse on Saturday, this time a 0-4 defeat by St Joseph's.

Manager Drew Hay will be reading the riot act, of that there is little doubt and the spectators this evening will see a Swifts side determined to get back on the rails.

Tayport's victory at Glenesk was comfortable in the end but before the tie was put out of their reach, the Pansies' Steve Vanderdyl missed a couple of reasonable chances. Then the home side's Brian Peacock was taken to hospital with a back injury. Violet, already short of several key players through injury, were never really at the races after the fifteen minute injury break.

We don't have our problems to seek on the injury front either with Paul Reilly, Billy Coventry and Andy Dolan still absent. Of that trio Andy looks the best bet to be back in action at an early date.

Top scorer Ewan Cameron missed the Violet game through attending a wedding and is available again this evening. Jackie Devine, injured at Carnoustie, returned to the starting line-up at Glenesk and capped a welcome return with a typical Divvy goal.




