From the Archives

FIFTEEN YEARS AGO IN DECEMBER 1978

In the People's Journal 'UNOMI JUNIOR' was telling his readers that the "Lochee United front line of Kevin Boyle, Dave Baikie, Glen Allison and Ian Fenton has goals written all over it"

Stobswell, who had only dropped five points, the same as First Division leaders Carnoustie Panmure, were in good shape for the visit of Downfield. Chippy Lowe (stitches removed from a leg injury), Andy Hutton (suspension) and Barry Toner (flu) were all set to return to the Stobbie line-up. (The same Barry Toner that was later to wear the colours of Tayport Amateurs).

In these days the Sporting Post printed the up to date Junior League tables on a Saturday night. Nowadays, despite all the technological advances, we're lucky if we see the league tables printed in the Courier, Tele or Sporting Post half a dozen times a season.

Jeanfield, our visitors today, were sitting fifth in Division Two and there were five teams in the Association which have disappeared from the scene these past fifteen years - Alyth, Perth Celtic, Osborne, Stobswell and Crieff Earngrove.

Christmas week saw a number of games postponed due to the weather and the following week matters were worse with all Junior games off and the Sporting Post reporting on the 30th of December that there was "almost a white-out on Scotland".

The previous week two McLagan goals for Blairgowrie finally eliminated St Andrews United from the Scottish Cup in a 2nd Round second replay. The same day Goodall, Harrison and Hardie were on the mark as Carnoustie defeated Downfield by 3-0.

A snippet in the Journal that same week noted that Auchterhouse Amateurs manager, Tom Mulgrew took the opportunity of promoting a young Gordon Winter from the 2nd XI to play in a 7-0 win for the first team in a North of Tay cup tie against Vale of Earn. Winter, of course went on to play for Downfield and St Johnstone and is now at Forfar Athletic.

The national newspapers were reporting that Alex Ferguson lost an Industrial Tribunal Action against St Mirren. The tribunal ruled that Saints "had every right to sack Alex Ferguson".

The Tayside Region announced their pool of players for a game against Fife on 17th December. The following were selected:- Nicoll (Osborne), Gillies (Crieff Earngrove), Mollison (Carnoustie), Urquhart (Lochee United), McManus (Harp), McDonald (Coupar Angus), McLardy (Carnoustie), Goodall (Carnoustie), Mason (Kinnohill), Black (Kinnohill), P. Boyle (Stobswell), Robbie (Breichin Vics), Stark (Blairgowrie), K. Boyle (Lochee United) and B. Nicoll (Carnoustie).

For this week's Flashback Photo we go back just under 25 YEARS to the 26th of APRIL 1969 for the Tayport Alliance XI which turned out against Harris FP on the East Common, losing 1-2 in the Alliance Cup. Pictured are Abby Walker (joint manager), Kevin Harte, Morris Flynn, Iain Bell, Andy Horan, Ian Mathers, George Bryson and Tammy Laing (joint manager). front - Fred Janssen, Dennis Auld, Murray Anderson, Michael Gray (mascot), Raymond White, Jimmy Foulis and Stan Cowe.

Apart from Bell (Australia), Foulis (England) and Bryson (England), all, except Tammy Laing who died some years ago, still live locally. Ian Mathers is a director of club sponsors Wimpey, Fred Janssen who scored the goal that day, designed the heating system for the new extension and Stan Cowe's claim to fame is that he was the first person ever to pay for admission to see the newly formed Juniors in action in August 1990 (how about that for a piece of useless information)

TODAY'S VISITORS

Our last visitors to the Canniepairt this year are Jeanfield Swifts who are meeting us for the third time at Tayport on league business. The previous visits have resulted in wins for us by 2-0 and 3-1. The results away from home haven't always gone our way, however, and this afternoon we will be seeking to avenge a 2-3 reverse at Simpson Park earlier this season. No doubt that Dave Baikie will be reminding us in his column that it was our sole league defeat to date. That win was one of four successive victories for Swifts but since then our visitors have had only one success in seven outings, a 2-1 win over the strong-going Kinnoull. In their thirteen league games not more than a one goal margin has separated Jeanfield from their opponents, so we can expect a tight contest today.

In his first season as manager at Simpson Park is Dundee man Davie Reid who is supported by coaches Kenny Bunce and Kenny Hearn. Neil McLagan is Swifts' Physio and the Club President at Jeanfield, Paddy Winton, also holds down that esteemed position with The Tayside Junior F.A..

The Jeanfield Squad 1993/94

ALAN MORRIS (Goalkeeper), one of three Jeanfield players with a local connection, Alan played with Newport Amateurs before joining Deveronvale in the Highland League from whom he joined Swifts. Deputised for Fraser in our goal during the pre-season. Alan has turned in some good performances this season but has only one clean sheet to his credit.

CRAIG HEALY (Defender). Recently put on the transfer list at his own request. Normally plays right back. Signed from Bankfoot. Had Senior experience with Brechin. GAVIN BUIST (Defender). Has also operated in midfield. Has been around the Perthshire Junior scene having worn the colours of Coupar Angus, Kinnoull, Scone Thistle and Luncarty. Joined Swifts in February this year.

CHRIS MARTIN (Defender). Formerly with Newport but joined Swifts from Riverside Athletic. Has played as striker on occasion. Scored his first goal for the club recently against Carnoustie.

BRIAN WILLIAMSON (Defender). Has also been used in midfield this season. Formerly with Kinnoull, Stobswell and Blairgowrie. Both his goals this season have been from the penalty spot.

ANDY GORDON (Defender). Will be winding down this week after a hectic spell at work. Andy works with the Royal Mail. Team Captain who normally plays as sweeper.

STUART CASSIDY (Defender). Formerly with Downfield, has settled into the left back position since signing from Forfar Albion in October. Made an immediate impact, scoring twice in his first three games for his new club.

STEVEN ROBERTSON (Midfield). Versatile young player with a promising future in the game. Signed from Scone Amateurs. Three goals to his credit this season.

SCOTT BROWN (Midfield). Left sided player in his second spell with club. Formerly with Bankfoot. On the fringe of the Tayside Under 23 team.

GEORGE NICOLL (Midfield). Has also appeared in the sweeper role but has missed a large part of the season through injury. Signed this season from Elmwood.

ROBBIE RODGER (Midfield). Can also operate effectively as a forward. Previously with Kinnoull and Bankfoot. Still looking to open his goal account for the season.

IAN SHEPHERD (Forward). Second spell with the club. Was Senior with Brechin City. A regular member of the Tayside Select, Ian scored one of the goals against us in September. Four goals this season.

WILLIE HUTCHISON (Forward). Young striker with a fair degree of potential. Was with Swifts' Under 18 side and Brechin City. Tends to lack consistency. 5 goals.

ANDY HUTCHISON (Forward). Signed after the Jeanfield pre-season tourney in which he displayed promise but has started only a handful of games to date.

KENNY CAMERON (Forward). Needs no introduction. Kenny was a youthful member of the Tayport Amateurs team which went to the semi final of the Scottish Amateur Cup in 1986 and guested for us on our pre-season tour to England in August prior to signing up at Simpson Park. Has proved to be a useful signing. Top scorer, Kenny notched twice against us in that early season defeat and was twice on the mark against Carnoustie earlier this month.

SCOTT ROBERTSON (Forward). Yet to make his impact but a handy player to have in the wings.
