

# Today's Game



This is the big game in the Region this afternoon. Two Tayside teams bidding for a place in the last eight of the Junior game's biggest prize. For Tayport it's a fourth appearance in the 5th round in five years. For Carnoustie it's a reminder of the halcyon days of the late 1970's and 1978 in particular when the Gowfers reached the cup semi final only to lose 4-2 to eventual winners Bonnyrigg Rose at Tynecastle. Amazingly, not since that occasion 17 years ago have Carnoustie graced this stage of the competition.

For Carnoustie chairman and local businessman David Laing it's an'opportunity to taste the success for which he was surely hoping when he took over the reins of the ailing club a few years back.

Since the teams met first back in 1991, the games between the sides have been littered with goals, an average of over five goals per game. Indeed no game between Tayport and Carnoustie, home or away, has ever produced fewer than four goals.

Carnoustie's attack has been prolific this season, finding their opponents' net in all but one of their twenty three games to date including, interestingly enough, all their away games. Tayport's attack has been even more prolific and they can boast the soundest defence in the country. Indeed only one goal has been conceded on the Canniepairt since October 8 last year.

For today's tie Tayport hope to see the return of Hamish Mackay who has missed the last three games following a training injury. Mackay is presently the Region's top marksman but his scoring exploits in the OVD Cup have been overshadowed by those of Panmure's Mark Kelly who has found the target in every tie to date.

Missing from the Tayport starting line-up last week as well as Mackay were Gray, Hunter, Wilkie and Paul Reilly. All will be in contention for a place today. Carnoustie brought back experienced defender Gerry Conway last week at Kinnoull and he will likely retain his place despite the return today of the ex-Dundee FC defender Stewart Forsyth who was unavailable last Saturday.

Adding spice to the tie is the fact that two of the Carnoustie team formerly wore Tayport colours, keeper Brian Anderson who was with us last year at this time and Gary Christie who was one of Dave Baikie's first signings back in 1990.

The stage is set then for a classic cup tie.

Tayport will wear their change strip this afternoon as the clubs' colours are the same and, unless the clubs can agree otherwise, the home club has to change

The referee is Linlithgow solicitor Jim Carlin who is returning to the Canniepairt for the first time in almost exactly four years. He had charge of the Scottish Cup tie against Pollok.

We are once again indebted to Tayport and Carnoustie businessman Jackie Martin for sponsoring the match and the match ball. The Man of the Match award will be selected by Mr Martin's party and presented immediately after the match.

# Today's Visitors

BRIAN ANDERSON (goalkeeper) An ever present this season. Signed for Tayport in January last year from DCFE when Fraser injured a hand at work. Was transferred to North End before signing for Panmure at the start of the season.

STEWART FORSYTH (defender) Ex-Dundee, Arbroath and Montrose. Left Senior football on joining the police force. Strong, experienced defender who can take a goal as his strike against us earlier this season can testify.

MARK N. KELLY(defender) The pony tailed Kelly. Joined up at Westfield in 1994 from Arbroath. Like most of the Gowfers' defenders, he likes to get forward.

GERRY CONWAY (defender) signed at the start of this season from Forfar West End. An experienced Junior, Gerry has seen service also with Broughty Athletic and Lochee United. Has been out recently through injury but made a successful return last week at Kinnoull.

ALAN CRANSTON (defender)Hefty central defender who was signed as a centre forward from St James. Notched 19 goals in each of his last two seasons. Still knows the road to goal and hasseveral to his credit already this season.

BRIAN CRAIK (midfield) spindly, unorthodox player with no shortage of skill. A regular goalscorer regardless of whether he plays in midfield or up front. Signed in 1993 from St Joseph's having previously seen service with East Craigie.

ALAN RAMSAY (midfield) Terrier in the Panmure boilerhouse. Always in the thick of the action where his tenacious play rarely endears him to the opposition. Ex-Forfar Athletic, Alan has represented Tayside's Under 23 side.

LEX RICHARDSON (sweeper) can truly be described as a veteran. Doubles up as assistant to team boss Mark Bennett. Normally turns out in the sweeper role where his guile can compensate for any loss of pace. Played Junior with Blantyre Celtic and Arthurlie before having a fairly distinguished Senior career with St Mirren and Dundee prior to moving on to Morton , Arbroath and Albion Rovers.

GARY CHRISTIE (midfield) Joined Tayport from East Craigie when we made our debut in the Junior ranks but didn't settle and returned to Craigie before going Senior with Montrose from where he joined Carnoustie. The team's playmaker who is comfortable on the ball and uses deadball situations to good effect.

MARC HUITON (forward) signed at the start of this season from Forfar Albion.
Had Senior experience with Forfar Athletic, Dundee United, St Johnstone and Hearts.

MARK KELLY (forward) The Kelly without the ponytail, Mark has been a prolific marksman for the Gowfers. Was top scorer last season with 28 strikes and looks like bettering that total this time round. Was with Montrose before he joined up at Westfield and during his time at Links Park had the distinction of notching a winning goal at Hampden Park - against Queen's Park in the B & Q Cup.


JOHN HENDRIE (forward) Man of many clubs, John joined up in 1992. A skilful left sided player who can take a goal. Had previous Junior experience with St Joseph's.

BARRY WILL (defender) Youngster who signed from Arbroath at the start of this season . Had a spell at Lochee United before stepping up to the Seniors. Was a regular at the start of the season but might have to settle for a place on the bench this afternoon.

GLEN KNOX (midfield) Promising youngster who was also with Arbroath. If manager Bennett goes for experience, Glen might also have to settle for a place on the bench this afternoon.

STEPHEN KYDD (forward) Joined Panmure at the start of this season on a delayed transfer from Montrose. Came off the bench to open the scoring against Kinnoull last week and with an OVD goal to his credit already this season will be hankering after a place in the starting line-up.

KENNY ROBERTSON(forward) signed earlier this season from Lochee Harp. Yet to make his mark. GARY HAILSONES(midfield) former player re-signed last week from Wishaw Juniors.


