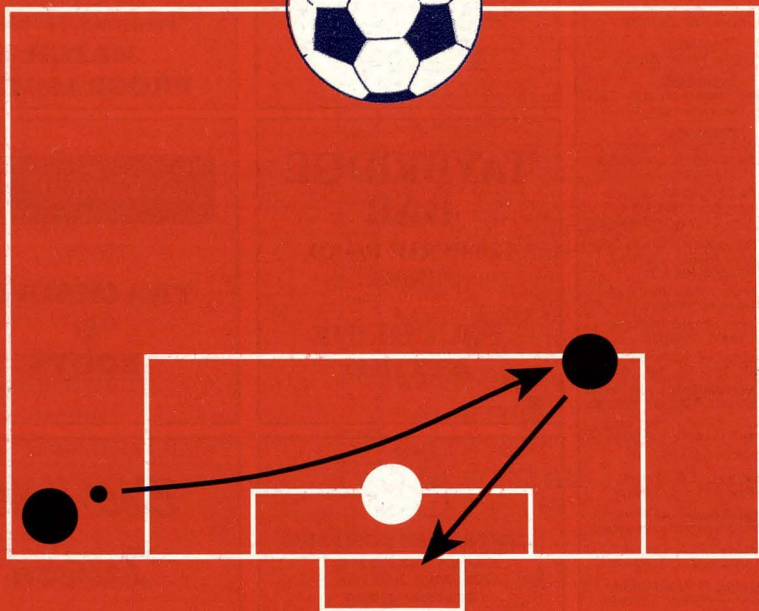

## TODAY'S GAME

After Tayport's stunning midweek performance at Fairfield Park, this afternoon's game can surely only be an anti-climax. You don't invest the sort of money in a squad that the Joey's are reputed to have invested to lose games 5-0. But, as they say, 'That's Football'! One thing is certain. St Joseph's manager Les Barr will require little effort to psyche his charges up for this Intersport quarter final tie, such will be their resolve to erase Tuesday from their memory and set themselves up for Monday evening's crunch.

Today's tie will be a repeat of last season's final which Tayport won 2-1 with goals from Jackie Devine & Ewan Cameron against a single from Rab McLaren. Devine will be an absentee as will Cameron. Devine has been out with a back injury for the past three months while a toe injury has kept Ewan out since our Whyte & Mackay win at Fairfield. Both are still likely to be out of action again today so Tayport will probably rely on the same thirteen.

Ex-Tayport men Heggie and Lamont didn't get a jersey in midweek but, along with their signing from East Fife, Bobby Skelligan, one of the twelve players which St Joseph's have signed from the Seniors, will be in contention for a place today as Les Barr looks to freshen up his team.

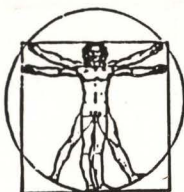

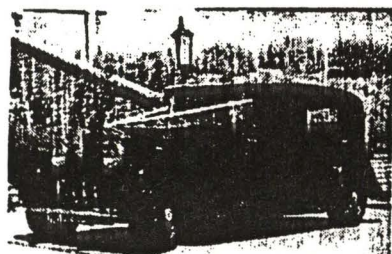

## The Baker's Bit

Good afternoon to the Port Support and a warm welcome to the players and officials of St Joseph's.

Once again we haven't had a bad week. A 5-1 win over North End last Saturday saw us reach the semi-final stage of the Cream of the Barley Trophy. You might think that the most pleasing aspect of the game was the five goals which we scored. This indeed was pleasing but, for me, it was our discipline on the day. We could easily have 'taken the bait'. I can't really say much more or I would probably get myself into trouble.

Tuesday past saw us record another fine win in our last league game of the season away to our opponents this afternoon. Our performance on the night was very pleasing, especially in the second period. I felt that we were in command for most of the game but the lack of midfield support prevented us from creating better scoring opportunities. However we certainly rectified that matter in the second half, scoring five without reply.

So, our league campaign is over for another season and, really, whatever the outcome of the St Joseph's v Lochee United game on Monday evening, I can't complain. If someone had said to me away back in August last year that Tayport FC would go through the season unbeaten in the league, gain as many points as in any of our previous three championship wins, score 76 and concede only 12 goals in 26 games, I'm certain I'd have grabbed it with both hands. Twenty wins meant six drawn games and I can recall each of those drawn games vividly. With the exception of our drawn game against St Joseph's, the result of which was probably the correct outcome, the other five draws were snatched from the jaws of victory.... we really should have won them handsomely.

We must now concentrate totally on what lies ahead. We've one cup final, two semi-finals and this afternoon's Intersport Shield quarter final. We know that today is another day and our opponents will be desperate to repair their dented pride. Our attitude and discipline must continue to be of the highest standard. Our players realise this and, if they continue to do so, I can see no reason why victory cannot be achieved.

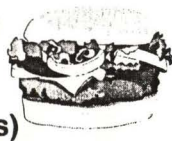

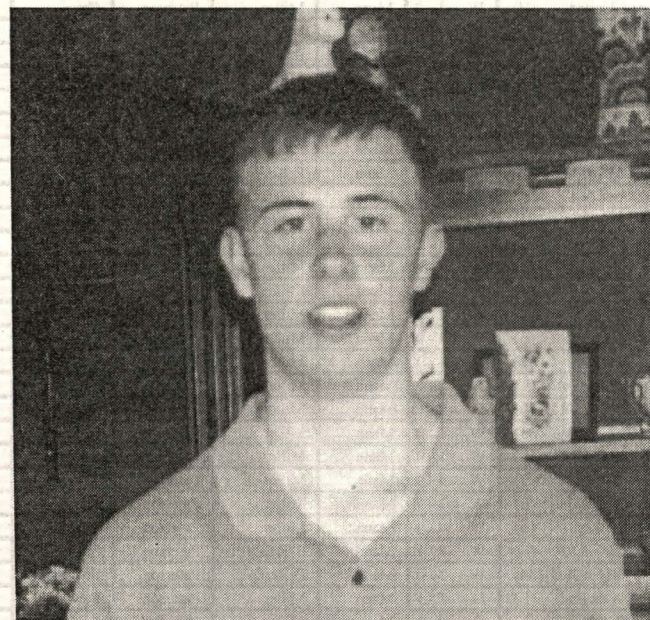

## DANNY 'BOOT' BOY CALLS IT A DAY



DANNY OSWALD had just turned 13 when he was taken on as the club's first boot boy in July 1990. Now, over 100 tins of Cherry Blossom polish and some 25,000 boots later, he has announced his retirement.

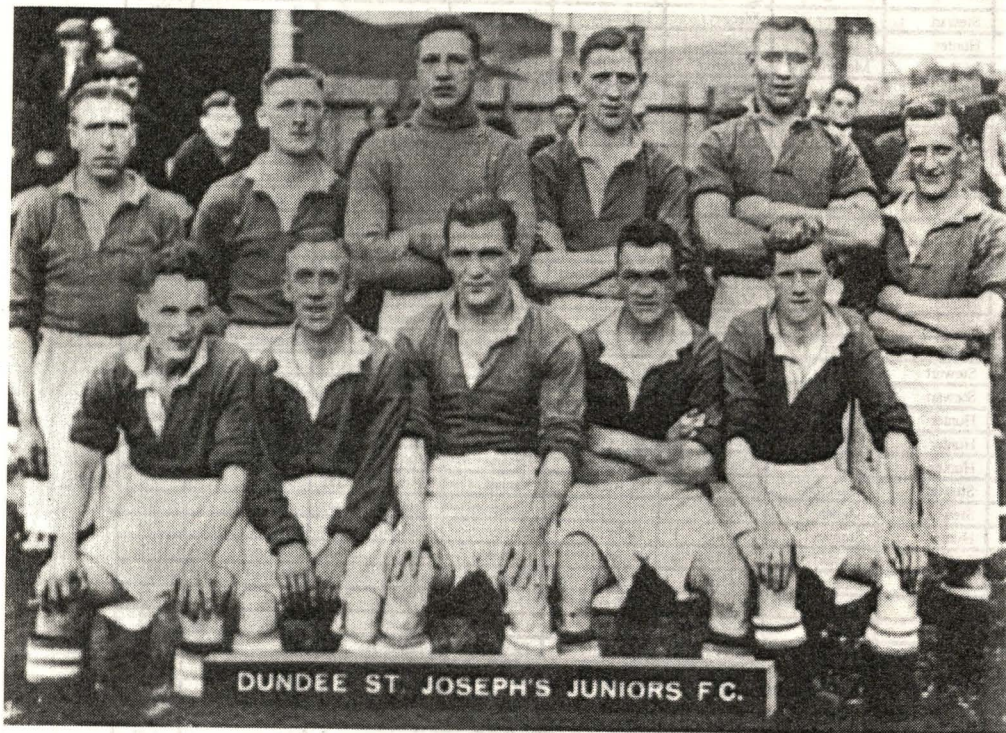

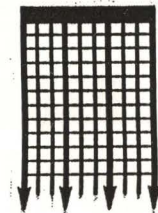

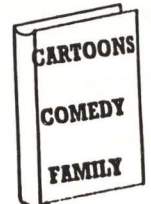

### TODAY'S VISITORS

First choice last line of defence is STEVE O'HANLON, signed from Cowdenbeath 2½ years ago. Steve missed our last meeting on the Canniepairt in September when BRIAN BROWN kept a clean sheet, the week after he had turned out for us when Fraser was on holiday. PAUL BRUCE, who wore the No.2 jersey against us in midweek, was signed from Dundee. Stays in Tayport, his father works for our sponsor Scott & Fyle. The other full-back position has been held down by SCOTT KOPEL since he signed from Forfar Athletic earlier this season. Was formerly with Dundee United. Another ex-United man, CHARLIE ADAM, teams up in central defence with an ex-Dundee man GARY OGILVIE. Adam, a superb striker of a dead ball, has played for most of the Senior clubs in the area while Ogilvie, a member of the Tayside Constabulary, is a resolute competitor who gives little away.

GUS MALONE needs no introduction to Canniepairt fans, having played here for the Amateurs before setting off on his travels in 1982. Joined up from Cowdenbeath at the same time as O'Hanlon. Also in midfield is another ex-Tayport man GRANT CUSHNIE who left here two seasons ago to seek fame & fortune at Fairfield. A prized signing earlier this year was midfielder JOHN YOUNG. Always prominent with Downfield John was transferred to Elgin City in the Highland League last close season for a substantial fee but Joeys brought him back to Dundee in mid-season to strengthen their midfield division. Top scorer RAB McLAREN was running Hamish Mackay close in the Tayside scorers charts but has fallen a wee bit behind in recent games. Has been subbed against us in both our recent games. KENNY McDONALD was, in his day, one of the most sought after strikers in Scotland. Has played for a host of Senior clubs but first teamed up with Joey's chief Peter Marr as a teenager at Timex FC. 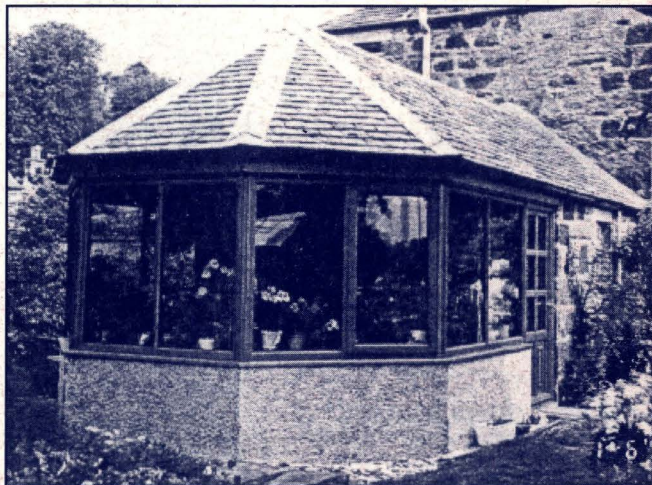
