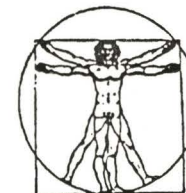
SUPER LEAGUE/CUP PLANS ON HOLD

It is now unlikely that a competition of any nature will get off the ground this season but the plans of Kilwinning and Glenafton have certainly given plenty of food for thought and have provided a necessary spark. Change is definitely in the air. The SJFA will be in full control of any new competition and to this end a working party consisting of a small number of informed individuals - not directly connected with any club - is to be set up to gauge the thoughts of the clubs throughout the length and breadth of the country.

This is a photo of WORMIT AMATEURS thought to be from the mid-1950's, around the time Wormit were one of only two clubs to break the NCR/YM Anchorage monopoly which was to last 35 years by winning the Midlands championship in 1955/56 and 1956/57.

Why should this be in a Tayport programme, you may ask. Well, there's a fair Tayport connection. Take the forward line. There's Andy Phin (with hair!) mine host at Cobbies Inn on the right wing and mine host at The Tayport Arms, 'Jolly' Jim Rodger on the left wing. If you had suggested forty years ago that they would be both be Tayport publicans as we approach the Millenium, you'd have been carted away!

What about the mean looking hombre in the centre? It's Maurice Flynn a current season ticket holder here at The Canniepairt. Sandwiched between Maurice and Jim is Tayport resident Graeme Hughes. The other forward is Clem Dempster, the custodian of this photo. Back row has (from left) Alfie Donaldson of Tayport (now deceased), Bob Watt, Donald Ross, Harry Pringle (a Tayport Amateurs' manager of not so long ago), Norrie Thomson and Jack Cunningham.

I would guess that the photo was taken outside one of the NCR factories in Dundee.

TODAY'S GAME

This afternoon's A.T. & T. League game against Dundee Violet is sponsored by Andrew Robertson of the Dubai Tayport Supporters Club. Andy, a former committee stalwart, is on leave at present and is taking the opportunity to wine and dine a few acquaintances prior to accompanying them to today's game.

Violet are having an indifferent season as their mid table placing and average of just under one point per game would suggest. A six game unbeaten run was ended a couple of weeks ago when they went out of the OVD Cup at Irvine Meadow and the Pansies slipped up again last week, losing by the odd goal in five to a Carnoustie team which was notching up its fifth straight win.

Experience is not in short supply with the Glenesk Park team. They've the choice of two ex Senior goalkeepers, Ian Boardley and Alan Morris. Morris, of course is well known in these parts having played with Newport Amateurs in his early days and having helped us out on several occasions in the past. Player/manager Phil Smith may elect to leave himself out of the starting line-up but he will have confidence in a fairly resolute defence. In midfield the guile of ex-Spider Brian Peacock will be evident. He was missed last week after he received his marching orders at Carnoustie.

There is a twin danger up front in the shape of Eric Manderson and Paul McIlreavy. Big Eric, it's probably fair to say, will never win a popularity poll amongst the Port Support but he's always been a threat with whatever team he has faced us. Young McIlreavy is on loan to Violet from Dundee United and is tipped to have a future in the game and will take a bit of watching today.

As well as Phil Smith, there are a couple of others in the Violet party with a Tayport FC connection. Stevie Black had a spell with the Amateurs' Alliance team and kit supervisor Graeme 'Micky' McPherson put in many a stirring display for the Amateurs during the eighties, both home and abroad.

Manager Dave Baikie has potentially his strongest ever squad at his disposal following last week's signing of Jimmy Henry but as usual there are injuries with which he has to contend. Paul Reilly, who sustained a broken leg against St Josephs in September, has just had the plaster removed. Billy Coventry has hardly played a game in two years because of injury and his rehabilitation has been hindered by the fact that he's been working in Aberdeen and has been unable to train with the squad.

Otherwise flu seems to be the only problem on the horizon as far as Tayport's team selection is concerned. Should everyone be available it will be interesting to see if changes are made from last week's successful starting line-up. The three substitutes Grant Buist, Barrie Gray and Steven Stewart all acquitted themselves well when they came on.

THE BAKER'S BIT

A warm welcome to the Port Support and a good afternoon to our league opposition, Dundee Violet.

I said prior to our home game with Baillieston that "if we didn't match our opponents' commitment, we were going to struggle" and really that was the case for most of the game. Fortunately some of our players managed to pull their game together sufficiently for us to salvage a replay.

As to the reasons why we struggled, I think that, basically, up until then we'd had a bit too much of our own way and when Baillieston kicked off playing the way a Scottish Cup-tie should be played, having done their homework and "got right in about us", our players struggled badly for long spells to find a response. On the day, defensively and creatively, we were a non event but we did get the chance of another bite at the cherry.

The replay also gave us the opportunity to take stock and realise how close to defeat we put ourselves. We also discovered that, especially in the Scottish Cup, it's a battle all the way. I'm sure that Baillieston left Tayport feeling that they were closer to winning the battle than we were. The question I was asking myself was: did our players have the capability to fight back against the odds? It took them a wee while to answer me but they did, with a comprehensive 3-0 victory and, really, it could have been more.

So we savoured a victory on foreign soil. But we will not go overboard. It only puts us a step closer. The next step will be just as hard if not harder but maybe, just maybe the penny's dropped with our players that they can't enter a battle polishing their fingernails.

I must mention that it was great to hear our fans in full voice last week and, after some deliberation, it's my conclusion that it must be related to the pre-match visit to the social club. So, for future games the club will provide buses and have a tour of north Fife, visit some social clubs and return just on kick-off time! You'll now be asking yourself, 'is he for real'? Well, I'd do anything to make you lot noisier at home matches!

I've no doubt we raised a few eyebrows last week by throwing the club's new acquisition Jimmy Henry straight in and I suppose it was a bit of a gamble. However we felt that, even although Jimmy hadn't played for five weeks or so, it was the correct decision and I'm confident he'll be a great attribute to Tayport FC.

Today we've got an opportunity to go back to the top of the table. That in itself should be incentive enough for our players and if it's not enough I can always remind them of our last game down here. But we know we are capable of a victory here this afternoon.
