## TODAY'S GAME

Tayport face one of their toughest tasks of the season to date when they run out against Kelty Hearts, bidding for a quarter final place in the Fife/Tayside knockout competition sponsored by Taycars.

Kelty, under the management of former Forfar Athletic stalwarts Rab Morris and his assistant Billy Bennett, visit the Canniepairt for the first time looking for a seventh successive win. Indeed their only defeat in their last 14 games was a 0-1 defeat by OVD Cup favourites Kilwinning Rangers.

Kelty's last four wins have been particularly impressive, two Whyte & Mackay (East of Scotland) Cup wins over Linlithgow Rose and Pumpherston and 6-1 and 7-1 drubbings of Fife League opponents Kirkcaldy YM and Lochgelly Albert respectively.

Doing most of the damage is the strike force of Tom Condie (8), Calum Graham (8) and Ian Pryde (6) which has netted twenty two goals in their last seven outings.

Seven goals against Lochgelly last week put a smile on the faces of the Kelty support while, at Thomson Park, the Port Support was positively purring over the 8-2 demolition of Lochee United. Lochee's new manager Charlie Wilson must hate the sight of Tayport. Charlie was at the helm of Lochgelly when they crashed 6-0 down here earlier this season.

The weather and ground conditions at Thomson Park deteriorated steadily throughout the game last Saturday but Tayport still turned in a five star (or should it be a 14 star!) display to delight the large attendance. Some more of the same today wouldn't go wrong!

Hamish Mackay and Barrie Gray took full advantage of being in the starting line-up last week, each grabbing a brace while Jim Henry, Gary Maher and Stevie Ross came off the bench to stake their claim for a starting place today. Billy Coventry, striving to regain match fitness, had a workout during the week and he could also find himself in contention.

We are delighted to have this afternoon's game sponsored by BRE Limited and welcome Rob Robertson and his party to the Canniepairt and trust that our guests and the supporters of both teams enjoy a thrilling tie, the outcome of which must be decided this afternoon.

## O. V. D. Scottish Junior Cup



If it had been Wimbledon's All England Tennis Championships and not the OVD Cup, then it's likely that seven of the eight quarter finalists in this season's OVD Scottish Junior Cup would have started as top seeds.

The unseeded team in the quarter finals two weeks today would be Kirkintilloch Rob Roy but, as we've seen in tennis and football (Largs Thistle a couple of years ago!), unseeded teams are well capable of going the whole way.

When the draw was made, Tayport fans would have been delighted to avoid old adversaries Pollok, Arthurlie, Glenafton, Auchinleck, Camelon and probably Kilwinning Rangers as well. Mind you, Rob Roy's choice would probably also have been to avoid these teams and settle for Tayport, a team outwith their normal zone of competition.

Of the eight quarter finalists, Tayport is the odd one out in that we don't have our name on the 109 years old Scottish Junior Cup.

Camelon are, of course the holders, Auchinleck have six wins, Rob Roy three, Pollok two, Arthurlie, Kilwinning and Glenafton (perish the memory!) have each lifted it on one occasion.

The draw has certainly thrown up four titanic ties and the crowds that roll up to Newlandsfield, Loch Park, Carnuirs Park and the Canniepairt on March 16th will far exceed the attendances at many Senior grounds that same afternoon.

Last Saturday's replays went very much as

expected although Auchinleck were within a whisper of making their exit at Glenrothes where the nine man Fifers went out on penalty kicks after it had finished at 1 - 1 after 120 minutes play. Petershill lost key defender Pat Cairney, voted 'man of the match' when Arthurlie drew 1 - 1 here on the Canniepairt four years ago, when he was sent off just before half time in their home replay against his former club. Cairney lost the rag after being baited

by his former fans. The referee asked him to repeat what he had shouted back at the 'Lie fans and, when the big defender obliged, he was sent packing for foul language! It was to be a significant loss, the Peasies going down 1 - 2.

Kilwinning Rangers also finished with ten men, the influential Gerry Peline being ordered off for elbowing. However,

by then the Buffs were in control of their replay against Vale of Leven at Alexandria, having netted what turned out to be the only goal of the game just on half-time.

An early goal from John Miller (remember him!) set Glenafton on their way at home to Reebok Division Two side Carlisle Rovers. There was a 25 minute break for hooliganism before further goals from Kennedy and Miller took Glens to their fifth quarter final appearance in as many years.

## TODAY'S VISITORS KELTY HEARTS

Kelty Hearts have only been in the Junior ranks since 1980 but have amassed a fair array of silverware in the fifteen years since, including 3 league titles, five Fife Cups and half a dozen or so Cowdenbeath Cups. Last season Kelty finished runners-up to champions Hill O' Beath in the John Fyfe League.

Although Hearts lost a wee bit of ground in the league early on, their form this season has been good enough to get within a whisker of silverware already, losing out by the only goal of the game to eternal rivals Hill O' Beath in the final of the Peddie Smith Maloco Cup, the Fife Association's early season cup tournament.

Striker Calum Graham looked to be out for some time with a knee injury but has made an excellent recovery to return to the front line alongside Ian Pryde and Tom Condie. Condie, the ex-Stenhousemuir and Cowdenbeath player, celebrates his 30th birthday in a month's time and is currently playing some of the best football of his career. He has hit 23 goals to date including a hat-trick against Lochgelly last week.

Recent recruits to the squad have been 26 years old midfielder Stewart Ollis from Hill O' Beath and Dave McCaw, a defender fixed up last month from Arbroath Vics. McCaw was last season the player/manager at Luncarty Juniors.

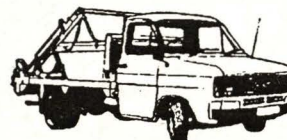

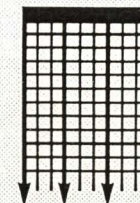

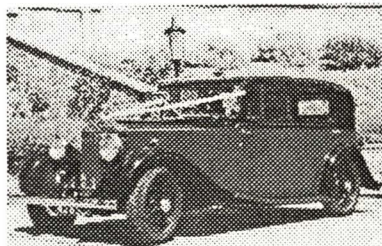

## THE BAKER'S BIT

Good afternoon to the Port Support and a warm welcome to the players and officials of our visitors today, Kelty Hearts.

Over a number of years now the name 'Kelty Hearts' has featured prominently in Fife and Scottish Junior football and this season looks to be no exception. I know, and our players realise, that we have a tall order this afternoon.

It's been a couple of weeks since the last Port Prog and between times we've managed two important victories. Over Aberdeen Bon Accord in the fifth round of the Scottish Cup and Lochee United in a second round PA Cup-tie. Although both results were pleasing, they were achieved in very different manners.

It's amazing how much that 'tension' can influence performances. In my opinion - and you may disagree - I felt that Lochee United would have provided the stiffer opposition but the scorelines certainly wouldn't have supported my argument.

So, what's the reason for the 'day & night' difference in performances? 'Tension'! We played one game with it and one game without it. We struggled throughout the Scottish tie to find any sort of fluency against what was an average side. Then we decided to shove that burden to one side prior to last week's encounter at Thomson Park. We provided not only an emphatic drubbing of our hosts but ~~some~~ even said that they spotted a glimmer of a smile on my face! I can't recall that moment but what I did see was a smile in our play and, for the first time this season, we played with an arrogance, something that's come a lot earlier than I expected.

I've no doubt in my mind what this pool of players is capable of. There's a lot of work ahead in order to fulfil their potential but, if the minds are willing, success will follow. I know this and our players must realise it. There's no room for tension in success.

I say to them - wash away the tension and the doubts and replace them with positive thoughts - arrogance, if you like. Do so and success will never be far away.
