TODAY'S GAME

We welcome Arbroath SC to The Canniepairt this afternoon (not Canniespairt as Dick Donnelly insists on calling it in the Radio Tay adverts and Sports Desk!) for this semi-final tie in the Taycars Trophy.

The Taycars is fast becoming established as one of the jewels in the Tayside JFA and Fife JFA crowns. The sponsors take a keen interest in the Junior game and are, quite using the opportunity of this sponsorship deal to promote their car sales business. There were vouchers for service savings at Taycars issued to those attending both semi-finals today and at the Final there will be vouchers for cash back on car sales at Taycars.

The other semi-final goes ahead simultaneously at North End Park where St Josephs play the Dokens. Ideally, of course, there would have been two Fife and two Tayside clubs contesting this stage of the competition but it wasn't to be. There will, however, be two Fife based members of the Taycars Executive Committee here today as observers, Bobby Weldon (Oakley United) and Norrie Clark (Glenrothes).

Arbroath SC have put together a great run recently and, but for a dreadful mid-season sag, would probably have been contesting the title. The recent good run has coincided with the signing of Jim Henry from ourselves. Jim's ability was never in doubt but he couldn't accept not being guaranteed a jersey every week and asked for a move. Arbroath SC boss Dave Martin, Jim's mentor whilst both were at Lochee United, was a front runner when it came to prospective moves but the clubs couldn't agree terms until literally the eleventh hour before the transfer deadline on 31 March.

Jim has been amongst the goals at Seaton Park, notching more in his short spell there than he did in his fifteen months and 37 games at The Canniepairt. Jim will be a key player for SC today, obviously anxious to do well against his former club.

Martin's assistant, Derek Carr, was at Downfield on Wednesday, missing his side's game with Kinnoull to run the rule over Tayport, a measure of how important this tie is to the club.

There is no shortage of experience in the SC pool today. Most of the players are well known to Junior fans. Big Bob Duncan is an imposing figure between the sticks, Scott Peters and Jeff Strachan are classy performers and Bobby Skelligan and Ian Greig are never short of energy. Indeed had a deal with Arbroath for Jim Henry gone through earlier, Greig might have been in a Tayport jersey today.

Arbroath had a good win in midweek over Kinnoull when Harry Cargill, with his first goal of the season, Jimmy Brown and a Steve Craib penalty counted for the winners.

Tayport reshuffled their front line on Wednesday against a Downfield but still secured a comfortable win. Allan Ramsay, injured against Sunnybank, wasn't fit enough to play but should be in contention today. Arbroath SC will provide much tougher opposition today and,







Recapturing past glories has proved elusive for the new town side and Jack is the latest to be charged with the task. It means he has had to stand down as manager of the Central League's Under 23 side which meets the East Region on Sunday. Winners meet Tayside in the final.

FROM THE ARCHIVES TWENTY YEARS AGO 1977

Back in Spring 1977 Tayport Amateurs were having a successful season, eventually finishing in third spot in a 16 team Midlands Division One (no Premier Divisions in those days).

It was the season in which Tayport lost an early season midweek league game at Windmill Park, Newport by 2-0 but successfully protested over a teamline irregularity and were eventually awarded the points. The circumstances caused a bit of ill-feeling at the time, particularly when this time of the season came along and our local rivals were rapidly spiralling towards Division Two.

The two teams finishing above Tayport were Auchterhouse and SMT. Auchterhouse were a power in the land at that time and were our opponents in a Bremner Cup tie up in the Sidlaws this corresponding weekend twenty years ago.

After being level 2-2 at half-time through a double from Ian Howe, Tayport eventually went down 4-2. The team was - Richard Callander; Bruce Ritchie, Ian Mathers, Bobby McMahon, Frank Feechan; Keith Ritchie, Ronnie Fleming, Gordon Gray; Doug Henderson, Ian Howe, Gordon Hughes. Subs. were Franky Dewar and Peter Spink. Not many locals in that line-up. Mathers, incidentally, is still pulling on a jersey, having been in the Amateurs line-up twice in the last couple of weeks.

Down on the East Common that same afternoon back in 1977, the Reserves were going down by 0-2 to Carnoustie in an Alliance League match. The team was - Derek White; Angus Robb, George Taylor, Alan Craig, Abby Oswald; George Ritchie, Stuart Davie, Stewart Ritchie; Bruce Burnett, Matthew Lawson, Andy Dewar; Subs. were Brian Boardman & Derek Nicoll.

It was a good end to the '77 season for the Alliance X1. Within 4 weeks the team had upset the odds to win the Alliance Cup, 4-3 in a thrilling final against Grove. Only two weeks previously Grove had beaten Tayport by 5-0 in a league match.

On the Club Committee in 1977 were Davie Hughes(chairman), Albert Oswald(vice-chairman), Abby Oswald(secretary), Matt Lawson(treasurer), Eddie Stewart, Andy Robertson, Freddie Bremner, Alastair Oswald, Ernie Simpson, Iain Cougan, Ian Rae, Robert Watson, Ian Mathers and Davie Henderson.

Amongst the matters discussed were the laying out of the Canniepairt pitch with the payment of £950 to Messrs Paterson Bros for works carried out, being authorised. Mr Finlay, the local farmer was to be engaged to rotavate the ground. Eric Beat was appointed to the committee vacancy caused by the resignation of Ernie Simpson.

The question of building a Social Club in Henderson Street in conjunction with Donaldsons and Lorimers Brewery was looking like becoming a very real possibility.

Arrangements were being made for various fundraising functions - a Coffee Morning and a dance to 'The Shipmates' in the Gregory Hall. There was a perceived problem here. The pubs were now allowed to open later but the suggestion was made that the dance should finish even later to take this into account.

Problems with getting a lease from the District Council were discussed, with the draft being described as 'being very one-sided in favour of the Council'. Comment was made that we shouldn't give an inch from what was agreed with the former Town Council. Twenty years on and nothing much has changed!

TAYSIDE REVIEW

The outcome of the Tayside League Championship is fairly straightforward. Because of their vastly superior goal difference, if St Josephs beat Kinnoull in midweek, then the title is their's. Two points dropped by St Josephs and Tayport win their last four games thenthe title stays at The Canniepairt.

Not so clearcut at the other end of the table. Forfar Albion and Bankfoot Athletic will be playing second division football next season but who will join them? Either Lochee United or Scone Thistle is the answer. Scone have matters in their own hands. Indeed had they not blown it in midweek when they went down to relegated Forfar Albion, they could have been only goal difference away from safety.

But the crunch game is undoubtedly the game at Thomson Park between Lochee United and Scone. With the backing of their commercial organisation and the Grier Brothers at the helm it's difficult to imagine United going down. However they lost an equally crunch fixture in midweek at Jeanfield so it's not impossible.

Moving up to play division one football next season are Kirrie Thistle, Forfar West End and Elmwood (*Oh good*,, I can hear the fans say, two social clubs out of three!)

The Dundee North End Centenary Cup Final between ourselves and St Josephs takes place on May 31st at North End Park.

In the Whyte & Mackay Cup(previously Currie Cup) the semi-finals are
Downfield v St Josephs & Scone Thistle or Violet v Arbroath SC.

In the D.J.Laing Homes Cup North End are in the semi-final awaiting the following quarter-final ties - Carnoustie v Lochee United; Harp v St Josephs Kirrie Thistle v Arbroath SC or Tayport

In the Intersport Shield, Kirrie Thistle are in the final and await the winners of the Montrose v Coupar Angus semi-final which is being played today.

When we see other Junior Associations floundering about at this stage of the season with three games a week for weeks and one club, would you believe, a week into May with more than half its league programme to go, the Tayside Association can take a pat on the back for the way in which the fixtures are planned out. All credit here to the clubs for agreeing to play off local cup-ties in one game and to Big Jock for his fixtures organisation although, given more flexibility in the winter months, Jock would probably be able to improve things further.




