



TODAYS MATCH

### TODAY'S MATCH

Eight days ago this would have been billed as a top of the table clash with Arbroath SC a point behind ourselves. Last week's results have increased that gap to four points with our visitors slipping down to sixth in the table. However, there's still not much between the sides at the top as yet with six clubs, including Arbroath SC, looking to establish early ascendancy.

Their good start to the league season brings them to the Canniepairt with a 100% away record. Their improved form this season is due in no small measure to the hard work put in by manager Davie Martin who, until earlier this week, was assisted by the experienced George Grier.

George apparently was happy with his role at Seaton Park but had been wooed by Lochee United and, after several overtures, chucked in the towel and joined his brother Willie at Thomson Park.

Dave Martin has at his disposal a healthy pool of players with a wealth of experience in the senior and junior game. Several have turned out for the local senior side at one time or another including most recent signing midfielder Jeff Strachan. Strachan is in his third spell at Seaton Park after being fixed up from Highland League Keith as recently as last week. Strachan had both his side's goals in their 2-2 draw on the last occasion on which they played at the Canniepairt.

Big Bob Duncan in goal formerly played with Arbroath Vics and is one of the nine players in the pool with senior experience. The versatile Bobby Skelligan, who was a regular marksman last season with his previous club Carnoustie Panmure, had a spell with East Fife with whom he turned out at full back. Another who played in Fife is Steve Craib, signed from Cowdenbeath following service at Arbroath and Montrose.

For goals, Sporting Club will look to the two Smiths, Mark and Raymond. Mark, signed from North End, is one of the Region's top scorers at present with ten strikes under his belt already.

With Keith Nicolson injured (he underwent an operation earlier this week), Ewan Cameron working, Jimmy Henry at Crewe, Tayport's pre-match problems at Carnoustie last week were exacerbated when Mark Spalding broke down in the pre-match warm-up. The same fate was to befall Billy Coventry at Pollok.

Henry should be back in the frame today, however, and hopefully there should be some better news on the injury front for what is always a tough contest.

The new enclosure which dominates the railway side of the Canniepairt, although not finished, will be available for use this afternoon should the weather be inclement. Concrete terracing and barriers have yet to be constructed.





## FROM THE ARCHIVES 50 YEARS AGO - OCTOBER 1946

Unfortunately no club records exist from the immediate post war period but we know that Tayport Violet Boys X1 played in the Angus Amateurs' 16 team League and,on the corresponding weekend 50 years ago,they defeated Glentoran (goodness knows where they hailed from) by 3-2. On the Common Tayport Rangers were playing 3rd BB from Dundee.

In the Midlands Junior League there was only one division of 19 clubs. Eight of those clubs have fallen by the wayside in the intervening half century - Stobswell, who were at the top of the table, Arnot, Osborne, Forfar East End, Alyth United, Forfar Celtic, Anchorage and Broughty Ex-Service. [East End and Celtic later amalgamated to form Forfar Albion]. It was reported that Norman Davie, a promising winger of Broughty Ex-Service was wanted by Dundee United.

Newburgh topped the 15 team Perth Junior League. Only survivors 50 years on are Luncarty, Blairgowrie, Bankfoot and Kinnoull. Amongst the member clubs were Auchtermuchty Juniors and Auchterarder Juniors. (who said a Fife team playing in a Tayside Junior League was something new.?!)

In the Seniors it would cost you 1/- (5p) to watch Dundee United with Forces and boys 6d  $(2\frac{1}{3}p)$  A bit more pricey at Dens Park where to see the Dark Blues v a Silesian X1 on Monday afternoon would cost 1/6d for the ground and 3/6d  $(17\frac{1}{3}p)$  for the Stand. A lot of famous names in the Dundee line-up of that era - Bennett; Follon, Ancell; McKenzie, Gray, Smith; Gunn, Pattillo, Juliussen, Ewen and Hill.

United's regular line-up was - Clark; Simpson, Jardine; S.Ross, R.Ross, Miller; McKinnon, Buchan, Pacione, Davidson and Smart. This month 50 years ago Manchester United were reported to have made a "three figure" bid for North End's Ewan Fenton who was trysted to Blackpool.

No shortage of entertainment in 1946. Dundee boasted 23 cinemas, 11 dance halls and 3 theatres. At the Ballroom Locarno there was dancing every night from 8-11pm for 2/-. Saturday 3pm-5.30pm was 1/6d while Saturday night was 3/- from 7.45pm-11pm. The Sunday Cafe session was on from 6.30pm-9pm.

A newspaper of the day reported that a Mrs Nicol of Forfar (b.1844) was celebrating her 102nd birthday. She had 46 grand children and 57 great grandchildren. How did she remember all their birthdays!

Office bearers elected at the AGM of the Tayport Social Club which met in the Maitland Street Hall were President - Mr J.Burnett; Secretary Mrs F.Wilkie; Treasurer - Mr R.Bathgate; on the committee were Mr & Mrs Borthwick, Mr James Donaldson and Miss R.Gray.




