



THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS

In October 1989 if anyone had ventured the thought that, in seven years time, the Canniepairt would be the stage for the home team kicking off a defence of the Scottish Junior Cup, they'd have been carted off or else would certainly have been subjected to ridicule. And who could think otherwise?

By then, however, the seed of a Junior side at Tayport had been sown and later that season the committee's pre-launch brochure had stated their intention "to create a Junior team of some standing, a team of which the community can be proud"

Well, here we are, just over six years down the line and, by an amazing coincidence, we begin the defence of our title versus the team against which we made our Junior baptism - Forfar Albion. The intervening period has seen Tayport achieve unprecedented success whilst Albion have led a more mundane existence with as many downs as ups. Threatening to deliver at times but failing to achieve consistency. This season - to date - they are experiencing something of a down.

A struggling start to the season saw the Albion committee axe their team manager. It was a piece of drastic surgery and the wound is perhaps taking a bit longer to heal than they had anticipated. The committee's action didn't please everybody with several players deciding to leave.

Into the hot seat comes Ian Cochrane assisted by Billy McGann. By a strange twist of fate Cochrane was also manager of Albion that August evening back in 1990.

The new management duo have been left with a sizeable injury list and the task of making new signings at a notoriously difficult stage of the season.

Problems or not, the Guthrie Park lads will be well psyched up for today's encounter. They've nothing to lose and everything to gain. And, of course, as the press never tire of reminding us, were the only side to defeat us in an otherwise unbeaten 46 game run during last season.

Scorer of the goal in that 0--1 defeat, Neil Scott, is one of only two Albion players from that 1990 meeting still with Albion, the other being Ian Ferguson.

Albion aren't alone in having injury problems. Not one of the three substitutes we listed last week was fit and physio Andy Bell has been working overtime to try and improve the situation. Maher and Cameron are still unavailable and it's no secret that

manager Dave Baikie is keen to add to his pool.

When it comes to the Scottish Cup, league positions, track records and the like go by the board as the players seek the buzz that comes with victory. It's a great feeling. We'll hopefully see an entertaining match this afternoon with the Tayport players again experiencing that winning feeling which they have become so used to since these two clubs first met.



FROM THE ARCHIVES OCTOBER 1989


This was the last season before the club took the major step of 'going Junior'. The club was running three amateur sides playing in the Midlands AFA, the Midlands Alliance and the East Fife AFA.

The Midlands team was enjoying a 20th successive season in the top division and had made a reasonable start to the season, with six points from six games. That afternoon, however things didn't go to plan and the team lost what was to be their only defeat in a run of ten games. Playing on the Canniepairt against a Lawside FP team which included the Reilly brothers, the home team went down 3-5.

The line up was: Paul Hunt; Steve Rollo, Mickey McPherson, Neil Downie, Gordon McRae, Gerry McCluskey, Jimmy Anderson, Eddie McIntyre, Lawrie Hill, Bruce Burnett and Chris Hay. Grant McLean and Neil Clark were the substitutes. Goalscorers were Burnett, McCluskey and Hill.

The Fife XI (or 2nd XI) that afternoon was winning an East Fife Division Two match by 9-2 against Leven Rovers at King George V Park, Leven. The line-up was Steve McGregor, Neil Munro, Gibby Valentine, Alan Hart, Bryan Fitchet, Roddy Davie, John Petrie, Ian Ness, John Fernie, Gerry McCabe and Andy Heggie. Sub was Ewan Willison. Fernie(5), Heggie(2) Munro and Petrie were the scorers. Of that team only Heggie (now Deveronvale) and Willison (now St Andrews United) went on to better themselves.

It was goals all the way that afternoon for Tayport's teams. The Alliance or StrollersXI was at Monymusk (set to be St Joseph's new stadium?!) for a Midlands Alliance Division Two game against Birkdale and they returned with an 11 - 0 victory - their first win of the season. Line-up was Ian Lyall; Fergus Mann, Mike Smith, Dougie Hill, Dunc McKellar, Lyall Clark, Stuart Davie, Roger Welsh, Alan McDade, Roddy McCafferty and Glen Pearson. McCafferty was assassin in chief with 4 goals, McDade had 3 and there were singles for Davie, Pearson and Welsh. The match comment was "firing on all cylinders against a clueless Birkdale side". The Mann at right back is Juniors' keeper Fraser Mann's older brother. Despite his goalscoring feat McCafferty was to retire the following week!


