Today's tie is the only OVD game within 75 miles, so a healthy attendance is expected. Hopefully the teams will provide entertainment worthy of two of the top Junior teams in the country.

TODAY'S VISITORS SHETTLESTON

Shettleston, who this afternoon, pay their third visit to the Canniepairt, are one of the country's most respected Junior clubs. Formed in 1903, *The Town* have been prominent members of first the Glasgow Junior League and, since 1969, the Central League.

In goal this afternoon will be MARK HUTTON, the Central League and the Scottish Under 23's last line of defence. Signed from Partick Thistle after cost cutting had become a necessity at Firhill. Town's other keeper JIM McKIE, who played the last time the teams met, is recovering from injury.

Full back STEVEN JACK, another member of the Central League Under 23 team who had a wee spell at Parkhead as a youth. Signed from Benburb, he is reputed to be a fine prospect. In central defence will be STUART ALLISON who is in his fourth season with The Town. Still only 23, he's seen as a Senior prospect. Lists hillwalking as his other leisure pursuit. Stuart will be partnered at the back by PAUL MAHER, well known from his days with Petershill and several other Central clubs. Started off his Junior career with Shettleston around a dozen years ago, he's returned to Greenfield Park where his formidable presence adds steel to the defence.

Probably lining up behind these two will be FRANK LYNCH. Frankie was with Arthurlie for years and turned out at The Canniepairt in 1992 for the Barrhead team.

BILLY'DAZZLER'DALZIELL is a very experienced midfielder, having given service to Petershill and Cumnock. Has the knack of popping up to score crucial goals. No.8 will likely be DOUGIE FISHER, an ex Rob Roy player who turns in consistent performances week after week. Has been described as a manager's dream

PETER LAMONT is the club's leading scorer with a powerful shot in either foot. Has had Senior experience with Alloa and East Stirling. PETER JOHNSTONE, another who played when we last met. Peter, a fire fighter, is a regular marksman who gives his all for the club despite his amateur status. JOE GARDINER, a very strong and determined player, often described as a nuisance to play against for the way he makes life difficult for defenders. Ex-Glencairn and Benburb.

Midfielder DANIEL CHARTERS, a youngster signed from neighbours Vale of Clyde, is on the fringes of a regular place in the line-up. WILLIAM "BUDGIE"McGHEE, a very steady midfield player who has seen service with Partick Thistle and Clydebank. DAVID BRODIE, ex-Queens Park, a pacy front man who could get a starting jersey.

Others in pool are SCOTT TURNBULL who is just up from the amateurs and WILLIE MELVIN, another young prospect who is on Clydebank's books.

Team manager is DENNIS CURRAN, he who has a penchant for home made cherry cake. Dennis learned the business as assistant for four years under former boss Jack McCartney. Coach is WILLIE GIBSON, a hard taskmaster who is well thought of at the club. On the sponge bag is WALTER CANNON, but it's *Irn Bru* the lads get splashed on their faces. Walter's a salesman with Barr's.

THE BAIKER'S BIT

On behalf of the management, I'd like to extend a warm welcome to the players and officials of our Scottish Cup 4th round opponents. And a good afternoon to the Port Support.

The past four weeks or so has been a very frustrating time for almost every Junior club but I suppose we've been one of the more fortunate ones, missing out officially on only one Saturday. Even then we had a perfectly playable pitch but had to be content with a friendly. However it turned out to be a very worthwhile exercise, scoring seven against one of the best amateur teams in the country.

The week prior to that we had a difficult league fixture at home to Downfield, especially as it followed the Scottish. And it probably went to script, our performance being a bit flat. Not uncommon, the week after the high of the national competition. But, to the players' credit, they responded much better after the interval to produce a well deserved 2-0 win.

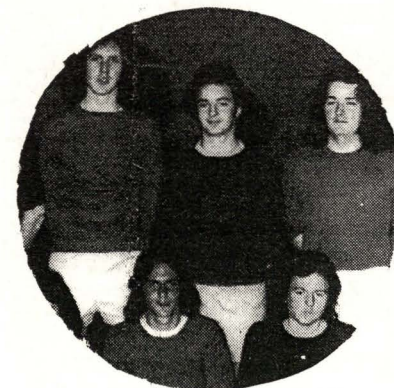
66 years on and Tayport are still playing with the same jerseys!

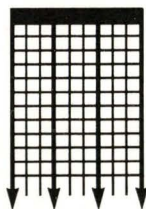

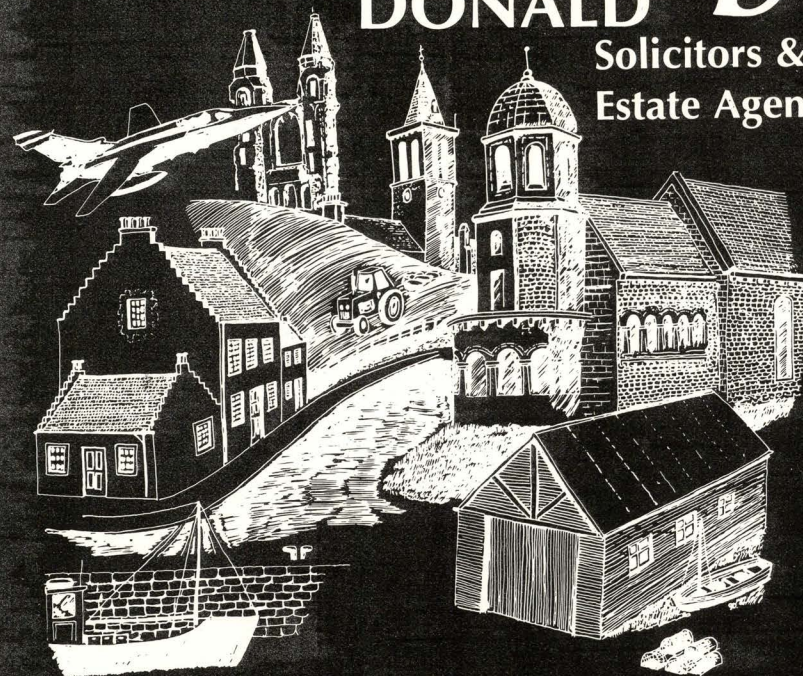
