TODAY'S GAME TAYCARS TROPHY 3rd ROUND

As beaten semi-finalists two seasons ago and beaten finalists last season, Tayport will be seeking to go one better this time round but, before thinking about that, there's today's hurdle to overcome. Lochore's record, by contrast makes bleak reading - a 12-0 1st round defeat at Lochee United in '95/96 and a 7-1 thumping at Scone Thistle last season. However as is noted elsewhere in the 'Port Prog this isn't the same team which suffered in this ignominious fashion, but a new club, a new side determined to put the past behind them and make their mark.

A measure of this determination and improvement is the fact that Lochore exacted quick revenge for their defeat at the hands of Scone last season by knocking them out of this season's competition, 2-1 at Crosshill. A 1-5 defeat by Kelty Hearts three weeks ago was no disgrace considering the Jam Tarts are unbeaten in the league and have conceded only a goal a game. LMW tightened things up the following week with a 1-1 draw at Glenrothes, a result that precipitated the removal of Glens' manager Tom Houston from his post. Then last week today's opponents consolidated their position with a 4-0 win over Kirkcaldy YM, four different players sharing the goals.

Five games into an eight home games out -of -nine run, Tayport will certainly not take their opponents lightly as they seek to build on recent good results. Allan Ramsay just failed to make it last week and could return today while Barrie Gray is another looking for a return to competitive action. Mark Spalding and Martin Wilkinson, neither of whom have played these last two weeks, will also be looking for some action this afternoon.

The fact that we've played Pollok twice within the last year and they'll have seen us in action at least on another couple of occasions, won't prevent the Newlandsfield club from calling at the Canniepairt today to plan for a fortnight's time.

The game today will be played to a finish, with extra time and penalty kicks if necessary. Referee is Mr Alan Thurston and his assistants are Alfie Forbes and Ron Smith.



DAVID HOWSE (midfield) Bought from Kelty Hearts only two weeks ago as Lochore continue to strengthen their squad.

ALAN ARCHIBALD (forward) Arrived from Newtongrange with his brother. A veteran of many a Scottish Junior Cup tie whilst with Hill O'Beath Hawthorn.

HUGH O'NEILL (forward) bought from Cowdenbeath at the start of this season.

CLIVE REES (defender) The only survivor of the Lochore Welfare Junior side of last season. The only player who elected to stay as the the committee went about building a new side.

MARK GIBSON (forward) Signed from Crossgates Primrose earlier this season. Was on the goal standard last Saturday.

I don't suppose it was any great surprise when Tayport came out of the hat first in Tuesday evening's OVD Cup draw, after all we've been drawn at home in 21 of our last 23 ties! Since we embarked on the Junior Cup trail in 1990, discounting 6 semi final and final ties, we've had 33 home draws and only 8 away from home.

So, Pollok return to the Canniepairt for the first time in seven years. When Pollok made that first visit in 1991, who could have imagined that, despite their 1-4 reverse that day, Tayport would go on to dominate the Junior game and become the most successful team of the Nineties.

It wasn't just on the field that Tayport has made progress, and the Pollok folk will see a very different Canniepairt from that which they visited in 1991. The attendance that day was a record for the ground but that was topped in 1993 when Downfield were the visitors in that epic quarter final but, given decent weather, there's a good chance that the 2,187 record could be bettered on 14 March.

Tayport could field five of the team which played in that encounter, Wilkie, Paterson, Spalding, Coventry and Dave Reilly but Pollok have no survivors in their squad.

Fife's other survivors, Hill O'Beath, if they can overcome Kilbirnie Ladeside in this afternoon's replay, return to Ayrshire to meet Kilwinning Rangers. Haws made it hard for themselves at Kilbirnie. Bobby Wilson was sent off but they took the lead through Jim McNab before Hugh Houston equalised for Ladeside. Keirs Park will be well packed today and the local support can help carry the day.

The shock of the day, however was the defeat of Auchinleck Talbot at Neilston where a Paul Greene goal after 50 minutes was sufficient to take the Central League side through to their first quarter final since the 1960's when Celtic legend Dixie Deans played with the Brig O'Lea side. Neilston now play host to Maryhill in the quarter finals.

Arthurlie meet Beith at home after disposing of Petershill in a tense tie at Barrhead. A Johnny Miller special put 'Lie ahead from a free kick but Stuart McIvor levelled for Peasies before substitute Steve Watson grabbed an injury time winner for Arthurlie.

'FORGET THE REST GET THE BEST'

LOCHORE MINERS WELFARE EPITOMISE COMMUNITY SPIRIT

Founded in 1934, Lochore Welfare have known some great days in the past and the club has produced players who have left an indelible mark in the Scottish Football history books. Players such as Willie 'Bud' Johnston (hero of Rangers & West Brom, villain of Argentina'78), Ian Porterfield (goalscorer in Sunderland's never to be forgotten FA Cup win over Leeds in '73), Arthur Mann (Hearts), Craig Levein (Hearts) and Jimmy Logie (Arsenal) are amongst others who wore Lochore colours.

Three successive league titles in 1962-63-64 and a lot of cups along the way had established Lochore Welfare as one of the best known clubs in the land. However a Fife Cup win back in 1980 was the last time Lochore tasted success and, as the years rolled on, the good times became but a memory at Central Park. The last two seasons saw an average of less than a goal a game scored by Welfare and an incredible 284 goals lost in the league alone during this period

It's during these times - and all clubs experience such times - that it's important the club doesn't die. Invariably there is at least one dedicated stalwart who keeps things going in the hope that the good times will return.. Credit for keeping Lochore Wefare going as the club reached its nadir is largely down to John Steel and his daughter Linda Dunlop.

Ironically whilst the Juniors were at a low ebb during the last ten years, the local amateur side was thriving with Lochore Miners being one of the Kirkcaldy & District Amateur League's most successful sides. Tayport can vouch for that as, during Dave Baikie's time, we played friendly matches against the Miners on a few occasions and always enjoyed a good contest

Lack of a committee at Central Park meant that the end looked nigh for Welfare but there was growing public support in the community for an amalgamation of the amateur and junior clubs rather than allow a club with a great sense of history to fade away. A number of meetings were called at the end of last season and from these the present club emerged.

John Tolson (club treasurer), whose grandfather was a founder member of Welfare back in 1934, was with the Miners amateur side and he was one of those who helped form the new committee along with Harry Anderson (chairman), George Whisker (vice chairman) and others. Linda Dunlop is secretary and her father, John Steel, is the new club's delegate to the League.

Gordon Marr, successful manager of the Miners' amateur side assumed the reins of the new club. He was assisted by Terry McGowan, coach Jim Davis and physio Billy O'Brien. Work commitments saw Gordon relinquish his position early in the season with Eric Archibald taking over.

The name of the new club wasn't really a problem. The clubs had amalgamated, so the name became an amalgam as well and Lochore Miners Welfare was born. It was important to the club, despite the wholesale closures, to keep the link with coal mining. This is reflected in the club colours of black, red and grey - black for the coal, red for the blood spilled hewing the coal and grey for the mornings at 5am when the miners waited for the bus to take them to the pithead.

There is a new sense of purpose about the club these days. The committee is working hard to get a long neglected ground back into shape and on the field the players are responding, having already collected more points than were gathered in the last five seasons or so put together.




