# TODAY'S GAME WHYTE & MACKAY CUP IST ROUND

East Craigie and Tayport meet for the first time in this competition. It's a meeting of arguably the oldest Junior team in the country and one of the newest. Despite their vintage ,Craigie have not enjoyed the success of their hosts today but, nevertheless have their name on the Currie Cup, lifting it 27 years ago. The Currie Cup, is now, of course, the Whyte & Mackay Cup.

In common with most visitors to the Canniepairt, Craigie will be determined to make their mark and carve out a result this afternoon. With the outcome of the tie to be determined today it will be no surprise if manager Mark Bennett has his troops organised with the objective of preventing Tayport from scoring and, either holding out for a penalty shoot-out or grabbing a goal and hanging on.

Normally a key player in the Craigie line-up is long serving goalkeeper Scott Lindsay but injury has put him in the doubtful category and a trialsit keeper could be handed the No. I jersey. Stephen Flight has moved back to central defence to form an effective partnership with Scott Gorrie while up front the Shipbuilders will look to Davie Milne for goals.

Tayport turned in a performance last week which had Lochore on the ropes long before the end. There was also the welcome opportunity to provide match practice for Mark Spalding and Martin Wilkinson, both of whom have been out through injury recently. Barrie Gray was chomping at the bit to get a run also, but was out of luck and may get his opportunity today along with Billy Coventry.

Injury sidelined Barry Gardiner and Grant Buist last Saturday and for both, a late decision on their fitness looks to be on the cards.

Supporters will be looking for more of the same from their side. Five goals to Steve Hutcheon and three for Stevie Ross pulled them both dramatically up the Tayside Scorers list into second and third spot respectively behind that doyen of strikers, Davie Reilly. Such a generous chap is DR, having netted in each of his last nine games, he decided to give the rest of the lads a chance. No bookie would dared to have given odds on DR not hitting the net when the team notches nine.





## THE WHYTE & MACKAY CUP

Originally the Currie Cup, which dates from the early part of the century, and now sponsored by Whyte & Mackay, was dominated by Tayport during the early part of the decade. Tayport first contested the competition in 1990/91 and won the cup on four successive occasions. Indeed Tayport were unbeaten in the following two years also, drawing the 1995 final 0-0 and missing out in the penalty tie breaker. It was a tie breaker the following season also when North End were victorious after a 0-0 draw in the semi final.

Last season was the first real defeat, going out 2-1 to St Josephs in the 2nd round.

Of all the cups that the Tayside clubs contest, this is the oldest and the certainly the most impressive piece of silverware.





### POWER TO THE PEOPLE

In Junior football circles, the Tayport support takes a lot of beating, particularly when playing away from home. Such loyalty pales into insignificance, however when compared to the fanaticism of Spain and in particular, the fans of Celta Vigo as this tale illustrates.



Thanks to his exploits at Middlesborough, Juninho is a household name in the UK. Following his move to Valencia, he was enjoying a relatively successful season until a serious leg break ended not only his season, but also any chance he might have had of playing against Scotland in the World Cup, surely the dream of every Brazilian youngster.

The injury was sustained in a tackle with Celta defender Michel Salgado. As he didn't have a clear view of the tackle, the referee awarded a foul but chose to take no further action. Video evidence showed however, that the tackle was indeed malicious and, following a disciplinary hearing, Salgado was given a four match ban, a punishment thought lenient by many, considering the five month exile he had himself handed to the little Brazilian.

So, end of story? Not as far as the Celta fans were concerned. Following the judgement, more than 5,000 fans took to the streets of Vigo to protest, believing that their hero had been made a scapegoat.

With the national team due to play a friendly in Vigo later this month, the money grabbing powers which run the Spanish game—were obviously worried about the effect this local disenchantment might have on gate receipts. In an amazing twist the decision was then overturned as it was ruled that, by giving the foul, the referee had given the punishment which he had deemed fit and that video evidence was inadmissable.

Undoubtedly a victory for the people, although the general concensus with the Spanish public is that, in this case, victory for the people is not necessarily a victory for justice.

How many 'Port punters spotted Keith Nicolson on TV on Wednesday evening's news?

If you were watching Reporting Scotland, you would have seen him. It was in the item concerning Brechin City's David Will going for the big job at UEFA. To illustrate the item there was library film of Glebe Park and players running out on to the park for a match. Included amongst those players emerging from the tunnel was a serious looking Keith, obviously thinking, "if I play my cards right I could get a transfer to Tayport!"


