It's the game of the day in the Junior programme and it's a match which has caught the imagine of the public and should attract the best attendance at the Canniepairt since 1993 when the visit of Downfield at the same stage of this competition set the ground record of 2.187. This will be reflected by the press pack, which normally comprises only of our local scribe covering the game for the Fife Herald, Sporting Post and Sunday Post, being augmented by hacks from the nationals. Why, the game might even get a mention on Monday in that most national of newspapers, the (Glasgow) Herald, assuming they can find their way east of Stirling.

It is, of course a repeat of last season's Cup Final which, as if anybody needs to be reminded, Pollok won by 3 goals to 1. It was, however, generally accepted as one of the best Junior finals of recent years. Try telling that to a Tayport punter, though. Both clubs will rely very much on the squads which contested that game.

Pollok, although they could field the eleven which started the game at Fir Park, have strengthened their squad by the addition of Davie Walker (Glenafton), Milton Thomson (Irvine Meadow), Gary McGrotty (ex St Mirren, Stirling Albion) and Ian McLaughlin (Shettleston).

Full-back Craig Cranmer and John Barrett have both missed recent Pollok matches through suspension, but are available today and it's likely Jim O'Donnell will give both an early return to the side. Barrett, of course is well remembered from the cup final for his early challenge on Grant Buist which caused much comment from the TV commentators.

Although he was credited with flogging the jerseys in the team's last outing against Arthurlie, veteran goalkeeper Ronnie Lowrie is very much a key member of the team and has an extremely experienced central defence in front of him in Ian Spittal and Iain Ashcroft. Ashcroft and teammate Milton Thomson have both played at Tayport previously. Both were with Arthurlie when we met the Barrhead side at the Canniepairt in 1992

Midfielders Sean Bonnar and David Walker aren't unknown either. Both played in OVD Cup finals v Tayport, Bonnar for Camelon and Walker for Glenafton. Pollok's squad is probably one of the most experienced line-ups in the junior game with a goal threat from all areas of the team. Indeed 16 different players have netted for the 'Lok this season, including keeper Lowrie who has tucked away a penalty. Midfielder Davie Elliot is top scorer with 14 strikes and, after a slow start, Danny Diver is now on 11.

Tayport go into their 56th Scottish Cup tie, their 22nd against Central League opposition, anxious to atone for the defeat at Fir Park, and like their opponents, have an experienced squad which has been

For Tayport it's much the same pool as last season, with only Allan Kennedy (retired) missing from the 16 who contested last season's final. Additions to the squad for this season are winger Barry Gardiner (Forfar Athletic), full-back Martin Wilkinson (English non-league) and midfielder Ian Greig (Arbroath SC).

The sides are well matched and, having also met in a pre-season friendly at Newlandsfield in August (1-1), will know each other's game inside out. Pollok boss Jim O'Donnell took in Tayport's game at home to East Craigie last week and also had us watched the previous week. With Pollok's game v Lesmahagow postponed last Saturday, the Tayport backroom staff missed the chance of a further look at their opponents, having been at Newlandsfield the previous week for the Arthurlie game. A keen contest looks in prospect.

Match officials today, Referee Mr Macauley and his assistants, Mr Maskell and Mr Marshall, are from Glenrothes.

Today's match ball has been sponsored by Jackie Martin, Builder, Tayport and Carnoustie.



GARY McGROTTY (winger) A new face at Newlandsfield this season but has missed much of the action through a lengthy suspension. Good young prospect with pace and good close control. Previously with St Mirren and Stirling Albion.



GARY FAULDS (striker) had an illustrious career in the Ayrshire Juniors and this experience stands him in good stead for his dual role as one of manager Jim O'Donnell's assistants.

JIM O'DONNELL (manager - pictured) Was previously assistant at Newlandsfield to Tommy Reynolds before moving to Irvine Meadow and bringing the league title to the New Town. Now in his third season as boss, Jim ensured his place in club history by bringing the Cup back to Pollok after a gap of 12 years. As a player he won virtually all the honours in the game during spells at East Kilbride and Auchinleck Talbot, winning the Scottish Cup with both clubs.

PHOTOGRAPH FROM 16 YEARS AGO



This photograph, taken at a Tayport FC Player of the Year Dance in the Gregory Hall in May 1982, shows the club's guest of honour, then Dundee United boss Jim McLean presenting Bobby Waddell with the club's Fife X1 Player of the Year award

Twenty years after winning the Scottish League Championship with **Dundee FC**, Bobby had been reinstated to amateur and played with Tayport Amateurs' 3rd X1 and 2nd (or Fife X1) from 1979 to 1982.

Bobby finally hung up his boots aged around 42. He had played 44 games for Tayport, mostly operating in midfield, and scored 15 goals, a striking average of 34%.

Deedle' had joined Dundee FC from St Andrews Swifts in 1959 and had 6 seasons at Dens Park, playing in 84 games, scoring 43 goals, an average of 51%, before being transferred to Blackpool.

Bobby had the fortune to be a member of probably Dundee's best ever squad, which reached the semi - final of the European Cup in addition to the winning the Championship. Bobby, however often had to play second fiddle to the legendary Alan Gilzean whose strike rate with the Dark Blues was phenomenal - 165 goals in 185 games.

Jim McLean and Bobby never played together at Dens, Jim arriving a few months after Bobby had left for England where he played alongside Alan Ball at Bloomfield Road.



LAST TIME WE MET

TAYPORT and POLLOK last met at the Canniepairt on 9th March 1991 when they

contested a 5th Round tie. It was Tayport's first season in the Juniors and the club's form in the Scottish Cup had raised a few eyebrows as they stormed into the 5th round.

The home tie against Pollok attracted a near 1,500 crowd but the Glasgow team proved too big a hurdle that day for the game's newcomers and the Central League side ran out 4-1 winners.

The cup run had proved a taster for Tayport however, and their success in the competition in succeeding years is the stuff of which dreams are made.

An indication of just how far Tayport have come is reflected in the match coverage by the Sporting Post. Compare the Sporting Post's 1991 report (below) with the report of today's match which which will appear in tonight's edition.

TAYPORT v. POLLOK

Tayport were quickly under pressure in this Scottish Junior Cup tie but their defence dealt with the Pollok attacks.

In the seventh minute, MARSHALL fired Pollok ahead with a fine volley. O'BRIEN scored twice with headers in a 10 minute spell to put the visitors three up.

Half-time—Tayport 0, Pollok 3.


Reilly (Tayport) headed narrowly over the bar.




The Port Prog cover from the first ever meeting of Tayport and Pollok.

Between them since then, these five players have gone on to make more than 1,600 appearances for the club and feature in three OVD Cup Finals. Testimony to the ability, loyalty and commitment. Reilly and Paterson also went on to become Scottish Junior Internationalists.

TODAY'S VISITORS



POLLOK. A name synonymous with success in the Junior game. Certainly as far as the last twenty or so years are concerned anyway. Although formed in 1908 it wasn't really until 1980/81 when they won the first of their three Scottish Cups that things started to take off in a big way down Pollok way. The club built on that success to become the power they are now. A dip in form in the OVD Scottish Cup during the early 90's appears to have been arrested as they look to emulate last season's Cup win.

RONNIE LOWRIE (goalkeeper) been No.1 at Newlandsfield since signing from Partick Thistle in 1991. His consistent displays between the sticks have played a big part in Pollok's recent successes. Takes the occasional penalty kick including one against Blantyre in last season's OVD semi-final.

GRAHAM SMITH (goalkeeper) understudy to Lowrie since he signed from Dunfermline 3 seasons ago. A local lad, he has turned in some excellent performances when deputising for the No.1. A bright future predicted.

CRAIG CRANMER (full-back) signed four seasons ago from Renfrew and has an impressive scoring record for a defender. Noted for his long throwing prowess.

IAN SPITTAL (central defence) played with Pollok in the 80's before moving to the seniors with Stranraer and Arbroath. Returned to Newlandsfield in 95/96 and has proved to be an inspirational figure, typified by his display in the OVD Cup final.

IAIN ASHCROFT (central defence) uncompromising defender with a wholehearted approach. Has served several clubs before joining up at Newlandsfield 3 seasons ago. Forms an effective partnership with Spittal.

KEVIN O'NEIL (full-back) in his fifth season with the club after signing from High Blantyre Amateurs. Very consistent defender, resolute in the tackle and always keen to get forward.

DAVIE ELLIOT (midfield) This is his third season with Pollok after moving from Largs Thistle where he was a member of the side which caused a major upset in winning the OVD Cup in 1994. Knows the way to the rostrum, having picked up a medal again last season after scoring the goal that clinched the match. For a midfielder his strike rate is prolific and he's currently leading marksman at the club.

JOHN MORRISON (midfield) Signed in 1996, following boss O'Donnell from Irvine Meadow. A versatile player who is particularly dangerous at set pieces. Has probably a unique claim in that he's probably the only current Junior to have turned out in a Wembley final and a Junior Cup final. He was a member of the Torquay United team which contested the final of the Freight Rover Trophy before 60,000. A far cry from last season's paltry assembly at Fir Park.

DOUGIE FONTANA (midfield) Into his third season, he's a favourite with the Pollok faithful for his no nonsense approach (that's a nice way of saying something but I can't think what!) and commitment. Got the winner at Fairfield in the last round.

PAUL McLEAN (midfield) Formerly with Motherwell and Ayr United, he was signed from Stranraer a couple of seasons ago. Had to settle for a place on the bench in the final last season but was in for the suspended Cranmer against the Joeys in the last round.

SEAN BONNAR (midfield) Signed last season from Camelon following a long spell frozen out of the game when he didn't re-sign for the Carmuirs club. Injury and suspensions have kept him from being a regular this season. All behind him now, and he'll be looking to re-establish himself in the side and get an opportunity to display his silky skills.






