## TODAY'S VISITORS - LEWIS UNITED

Lewis United are paying their first visit to the Canniepairt but it will be the second meeting of the sides, the first being an OVD Scottish Junior cup tie at the Chris Anderson Stadium in Aberdeen back in 1991 which Tayport won 5-0.

After missing out on promotion to the North Region's Premier Division in 1996/97, Aberdeen based Lewis finally made it last season when they went up as champions, losing only one of their 22 games and conceding only 15 goals.

Their first season in the top division has seen them settle in a comfortable mid-table position and they still have an interest in three local cups.

In the Scottish Cup they had two high scoring wins over Dalkeith and Hall Russell before going down by 2-1 at Glenafton in the 3rd round.

A quick look at the Lewis squad for today's match. Keeper is **TONY BUCKLEY** ex-Forres and an Under 23 internationalist. Full-back **DAVIE MILNE** (21) is a former Brechin City youth player. Left-back **KEVIN MURRAY** is a former Banks O'Dee player now in his mid 30's. Skipper **ALAN GOLIGHTLY** is a long serving defender and he is partnered in defence by 28 years old ex-Keith centre half **JAMIE COLLIE**.

22 years old midfielder **BRIAN MURRAY** is on loan from Highland League Cove Rangers as is 23 years old **PAUL MORRISON**, a former Arbroath FC player. Longest serving player at the club is midfield man **DAVIE MARNOCH** who has been at Lewis for 10 seasons.

Up front Lewis will be looking to the talents of 18 years old schoolboy internationalist **MARTIN BAVIDGE**, a former S signing with Dundee FC. Main striking partner for Martin is **GORDON GUTHRIE** who has the reputation of being a prolific scorer in junior football. The other front man likely to start today is **ATHOL MENZIES**, formerly with Cruden Bay and who has the reputation of being the club joker.

**GREIG MILNE**, a 22 years old midfield player was formerly with Deveronvale as was team mate **STUART HADDON**. Another midfielder **SEAN McMAHON** is getting his first taste of junior football, having arrived in this country from South Africa this season. Completing the pool is **SCOTT ALLAN**, a reliable clubman and utility player.

Co-managers are **ERNIE DREWS**, a former Aberdeen and Rothes player, and **GEORGE ROBERTSON** who joined the club when Bon Accord went defunct during the close season.

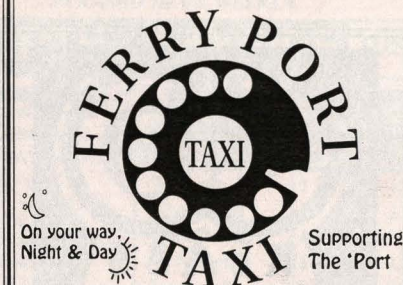

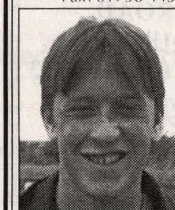

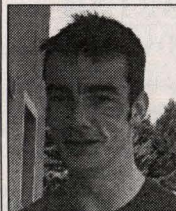

## OUT BUT NOT DOWN



Tayport may be out of the Scottish Junior Cup but they can be well pleased with their efforts. By their own admission, **Pollok** thought their tenure as Cup holders was ended after 18 minutes of the first game at Tayport but two key moments proved to be crucial in Pollok eventually going through to the semi-final. One was the brave yet shrewd decision of manager Jim O'Donnell to substitute top scoring midfielder Davie Elliot during the first half when he clearly realised that it wasn't going to be that player's day. At 0-2 behind, how many managers would have made that decision when O'Donnell did? The other key moment was Tayport's brief lapse in concentration immediately after their late third goal, allowing Pollok to strike back before Tayport could gain a grip of the tie.

A penalty kick situation was never going to be far from the minds in the replay and of course that's what happened. From there on in it's always going to be something of a lottery.

Tayport, though perhaps unlucky not to have taken one of the half chances, of which they had the majority, during the match, finished the stronger side and should not be downhearted. At least the tie revived the arguments as to how a drawn tie should be determined - golden goal?, number of corners awarded? taking penalty kicks *before* the match? an unchallenged run from the halfway line? On Saturday I'd have settled for the toss of a coin!

At least Tayport have finished the campaign unbeaten, having taken the scalps of the East Region champions, the Ayrshire runaway league leaders and been unbeaten over 210 minutes against the Central League leaders. And earlier in the season we stuffed Longside, the current North Region leaders, in the North End Cup into the bargain.

Well, that's the first part of the season over. We'd best get on with the second part today.

Who's going to win the cup now that the favourites are out? Already awaiting the semi-final draw along with **Pollok** are **Arthurlie** and **Maryhill**. The fourth contender will be known today, either **Hill O'Beath** or **Kilwinning Rangers**.

The Haws and the Buffs will be outsiders with little separating the Central sides. Arthurlie have gone so close in recent times and I have a suspicion this time they'll go all the way. Preference would be Haws to win and bring the cup back to Fife, particularly if they were to beat Pollok in a penalty shoot-out in the final!

The final is at Fir Park on Sunday 17th May



## FROM THE ARCHIVES - 23 YEARS AGO - 1974/75

### GLASGOW RANGERS' NEW CHIEF EXECUTIVE, BOB BRANNAN,

#### PLAYED FOR TAYPORT

When Bob Brannan pulled on a Tayport FC jersey back in 1974, little did he realise that 23 years on he would be appointed to the role of Chief Executive of Glasgow Rangers, an appointment made to coincide with the start of Dick Advocaat as manager. Of course, if David Murray had any doubts over the man whom he was appointing to take over total responsibility for Ibrox business affairs, they would have been dispelled when he checked out Bob's CV and noted that he had played for Tayport!



## ARCHIVES (continued) New Ibrox Chief Executive, Is Ex-Tayport Player

Bob Brannan joined Tayport FC for the 1974/75 season along with the late George Taylor. George's father had the Tayport Arms at the time and when we signed George, Bob Brannan, his school pal from Lawside Academy, came too. The Tayport line-up at that time had two other Lawside FP's, Davie Henderson and Frank Feechan.



Rangers' David Murray headhunted Brannan saying "**Bob Brannan has a proven track record within the business community and will be a major asset in the long term growth of the club**".

Brannan worked for Hewlett Packard for nine years after qualifying as an accountant, before moving into management consultancy. he was then appointed financial director of Matthew Gloag Distillers before moving quite recently to William Grant & Sons Distillers. The *Rangers News* reports that their chief executive designate once played for junior side Tayport and quotes Bob as saying "**I used to play for Tayport during the 1970's and slogging away with them it never crossed my mind I'd one day be**

**in such a position within one of Europe's most powerful clubs**".

Brannan's going to Ibrox but where are the others now? Amazingly, 23 years later 11 of those in the photograph are still working with the same employer. Feechan, Ancell, Howe, Abby Oswald and Wilson are still with Dundee Council., Doug Henderson is teaching at Bell Baxter HS, Alastair Oswald and Hughes are still with Fife Council, Fleming, who was recovering from a cartilage operation when the photo was taken, is still with Brown Construction, Iain Cougan is still with DC Thomson and Callander is with the Bank of Scotland. Mathers is building the new Overgate, McLaren is proprietor of *Clubsport* and Davie Henderson, who was back in town for last year's reunion, works in accountancy down south. Waddell works for Port Prog advertisers *EP Engineering*. Sadly, George Taylor died tragically a couple of years ago. For the record Howe and the Hendersons with a goal apiece were the scorers in a 3-0 win. Tayport finished 5th in the first division, 7 points behind champions Broughty United. Although Mathers, McLaren, Howe and Doug Henderson still turn out for the Tayport Veterans X1, Hughes is the only one still playing seriously.

## OUR LAST MEETING WITH LEWIS UNITED

TAYPORT and LEWIS UNITED last met on **Saturday 30 November 1991** at the Chris Anderson (formerly Linkfield ) Stadium in Aberdeen in an OVD Scottish Junior Cup 2nd round tie. Tayport led 3-0 at the break and ran out comfortable 5-0 winners with goals from Dave Reilly (2), Kevin Thoms, Grant Cushnie and Jackie Devine.

Eight members of Tayport's 13 that day are still with the club, seven are in Tayport's squad this afternoon, the other is coach **Jimmy Hunter**. The team was **Mann, Paul Reilly, Paterson, Wilkie, Sommerville, Spalding, Hunter, Cushnie, Thoms, Dave Reilly** and Jackie Devine. **Coventry** replaced Spalding and Lamont replaced Cushnie.

Incidentally, Lamont and Cushnie along with another ex-Tayport man Ewan Cameron are currently with Riverside Athletic, all three having been reinstated to the amateur grade.

According to the club archives the attendance was 40, 37 of whom were from Tayport. The comment was "the lights on in the second half helped Tayport sparkle"

The *Fife Herald* said "*Tayport comfortably booked their place in the third round of the OVD Cup with this emphatic victory in Aberdeen....from the 23rd minute when Dave Reilly steered the ball past home keeper Michie to open the scoring, Tayport never looked back*".

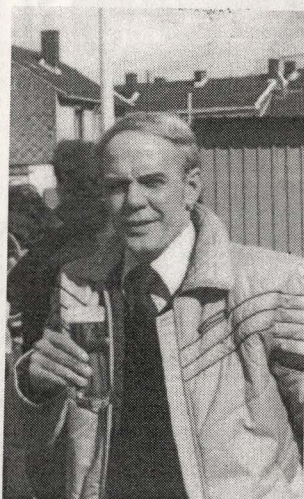


**HIT AND MISS . . . Grant Miller holds his head in disbelief after sending his spot-kick high and wide of the goal**

Sadly, William Payne, Honorary President of the club for almost 19 years died peacefully at his home in Tayport on 17th March 1998.

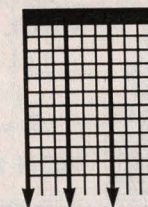

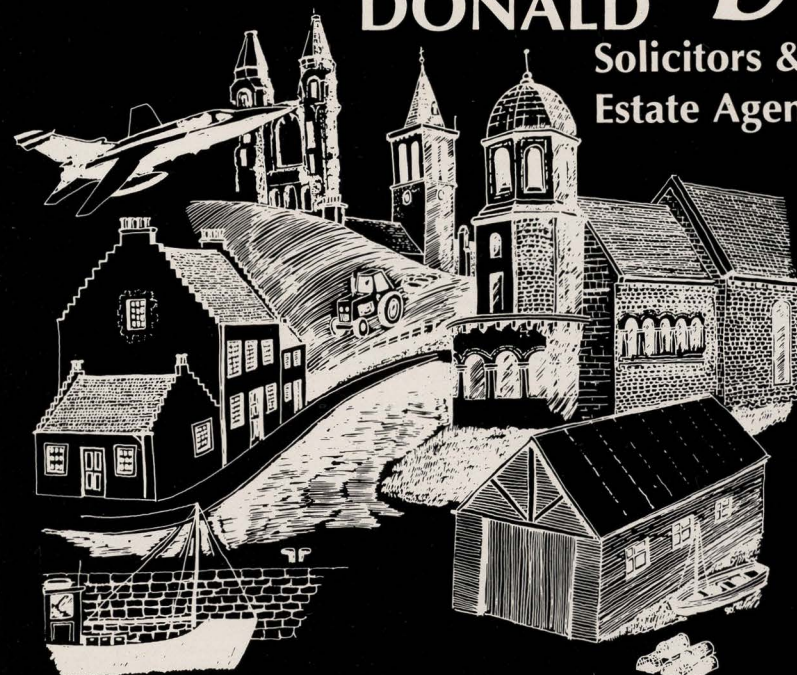

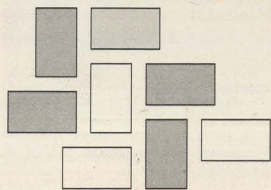
