

TODAY'S VISITORS FORFAR WEST END

Tayport's first season in the Juniors, 1990-91, coincided with West End's best ever league performance. While Tayport were winning the second divison championship, West End were effectively ending Downfield's domination of the Tayside Juniors with a storming finish to the season, coming from well behind to pip the Spiders on goal difference for the title.

A spell of West End success thereafter looked assured, but, a hint of what was in store came in the last game of that season. Tayport stunned the newly crowned champions with a 5-1 win in the final of the Intersport Shield.

A second place in 1992/3 was West End's best finish before a slump set in. The warning of finishing one place off a relegation spot in 1994/5 wasn't heeded and the following season the Strathmore Park club was relegated. There was only one season downstairs and last season West End came back up as runners-up to Kirrie Thistle.

Manager Jake Ferrier took over as manager this season and has relied on experienced players to establish his side in the top division. John Clenaghan, the ex-Harp stalwart, returned to the Junior game from Dundee Hibs to assist Ferrier and they are supported by coaches Brian Murray and Jim Hodgson.

Midfielder Lindsay Russell, who notched West's goal in their 2-1 defeat by Carnoustie last week, was signed from Arbroath SC. Winger Peter Feeney, who was also at Seaton Park for several seasons, is another experienced new face. Ian Simpson, who started the season as part of the Grier Brothers managerial team at Lochee Park before being replaced by Davie Martin, was persuaded to resume a playing role with FWE.

Big Davie Scott, recently a midfielder or central defender at Forfar Albion after returning from Arbroath FC, provides West End with an aerial threat. There's no shortage of goalpower in the squad with Nick Markowski, Shuggie McLaughlan and Eddie Wolecki to call upon. Wolecki was top scorer in the Tayside game back in 1990/91 when he hit 49 goals for St Josephs. Since then his travels have taken him to Montrose FC and Deveronvale amongst others places.

On the West End transfer list are experienced goalkeeper Bruce Glen and striker Mark Kubicki.

TODAY'S GAME

Forfar West End have made a spirited start to their return season in division one. Although they've lost their last two matches, both were by the odd goal, 2-3 to a rapidly improving Violet and 1-2 to title contenders Carnoustie Panmure. Four weeks ago West End put St Andrews United's gas at a peep when they eliminated the Fifers from the Taycars Trophy. As we read in the Port Prog a couple of weeks ago Saints thought that they should have walked the tie while the Forfar version was that it was an evenly contested game. I think we'll prefer the Forfar version!

A 0-0 draw at Kilbirnie in the 1st round of the Scottish Junior Cup is ample evidence that West End are perfectly capable of going out and getting a result and Tayport will have a tough job breaking down a resolute Forfar defence which will, as usual be expertly marshalled by Bobby Anderson.

Both teams will be unable to select from full pools. West End's veteran goalkeeper Ronnie Traynor was injured last week against Carnoustie and has been on the treatment table this week in an effort to make the game.

Top scorer Shuggie McLaughlan (15 goals this season) has been out injured since being clattered by the Violet 'keeper the other week and could again be absent. However Eddie Wolecki is back in the frame. A regular marksman with several clubs, Wolecki made his return from injury last week, coming on as substitute. It was almost a glorious return, an equalising goal being denied him by one of his own players who inadvertantly blocked his net bound header.

Tayport still look to be without the services of Paul Reilly and Billy Coventry and could also still be minus Dave Reilly, injured against St Josephs. It's still a point of debate amongst Tayport supporters that keeper Fitzpatrick escaped any punishment for conceding the penalty kick which cost DR his injury. Reilly's replacement last week, Stevie Ross, is away on a managemnet course with his work this weekend and will unavailable for selection.

Referee today is Graeme Curr and he is assisted by Jimmy Millar and Brian Rooney.

In today's other matches Carnoustie should comfortably put East Craigie to flight at Westfield while the improved form of late of both Violet and Jeanfield will be put to the test. Violet will be pleased with this season's signings, McGill and Heggie, both of whom have been amongst the goals. North End, annoyed at dropping two points last week, will have to blunt this goal threat if they are to collect the spoils.

Jeanfield caused a few raised eyebrows with their six goal demolition of Craigie last week but will be put under pressure by a St Josephs team who will be anxious to improve on their one point from six in their past two games. The other two Division One matches pair Downfield and Lochee United and Elmwood with Kirrie. Remember you can get these results on the Tayport Newsline on Saturday night.



FROM THE ARCHIVES 20 YEARS AGO 26th NOVEMBER 1977

20 years ago Tayport had only two amateur teams, both playing in the Midlands AFA. In season 1977/78 Tayport fielded one of its best ever Midlands sides and was cruelly unlucky only to pick up one trophy that season.

Only three points adrift of champions Auchterhouse in a 28 game campaign, Tayport went out of the Scottish Cup in the 5th round in a tie against Parkside in Uddingston. The tie went to three games and stretched over five weeks. Similarly in the Fife Cup it was an extra time defeat in the semi-final against Windygates and after extra time in the Midlands Bremner Cup against SMT. The season did finish on a high, however, with a 5-0 rout of champions Auchterhouse in the last game of the season, the final of the Gray Trophy on a bowling green of a park at NCR.

On 26th November 1977 Tayport was in the midst of a 25 game unbeaten run which was to stretch from August to February. That day it was a 3-0 league win over the now defunct Tay Valley at Dawson Park.

Team was Bobby Nicol; Bobby McMahon, Ian Mathers, Ronnie Fleming, Doug Henderson; Ian Dobie, Mike Clerihew, Jim Downie; Steve Braid, Ian Howe, Gordon Hughes. Subs were Ian Brown and Stuart Davie. Goals were from Hughes, Howe and Downie. Other first team regulars that season were Peter Wilson, George Ritchie and Doug Paterson.

Where are they now? All still around locally except McMahon who is in Canada and Clerihew whose whereabouts are unknown.

Ronnie Fleming played in all 44 competitive games that season and Ian Howe was top scorer with 35 goals (most of them taps-in, mind you). Team manager was Bobby Waddell.

The same afternoon at Tayport the Alliance XI was accounting for Kingsway TC by 2-1 in a league game.

The line-up was Derek White; Gary Cockburn, Frank Feechan, Alan Townshend, Lindsay Ancell; Bruce Ritchie, Terry Scanlon, Dave Henderson; George Ritchie, Stewart Ritchie, Bruce Burnett. Subs were Sandy Hamilton and Matthew Lawson.

Most are still local. Exceptions are Cockburn (Portsmouth), Henderson(down south) and Lawson (Australia).

Goals were scored by Burnett and G.Ritchie. The team reached the final of the Lunan Trophy that season but missed out by 2-3 to

Derek White and Stewart'Willie Gruff'Ritchie had most games (both 29) and Ritchie was also top scorer with 17 goals.
