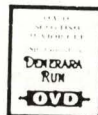

OVD SCOTTISH JUNIOR CUP ROUND 4 TAYPORT TRAVEL TO AYRSHIRE

The OVD Scottish Junior Cup fourth round draw is potentially the most exciting for some time.

TAYPORT meet CUMNOCK for the third time in the competition and with the teams currently top of their respective leagues, it should be a tie to savour.

Another in the same mould is the derby six miles down the road at AUCHINLECK where Talbot meet New Cumnock neighbours GLENAFTON ATHLETIC. Another Ayrshire side is certain to go out when IRVINE MEADOW meet KILBIRNIE LADESIDE.

ST JOSEPHS visit NEWTONGRANGE STAR's new stadium where Willie Garner will have his charges well psyched up. Joeys last visit to the Lothians put a blot on an otherwise perfect season when Tranent knocked them out of last season's competition.

KIRRIE THISTLE's prolific strike force of Hamish Soutar and Ian McKenna are in sparkling form just now and a long trip to Westview could prove tricky for Bobby Dickson's KILWINNING RANGERS.

NORTH END also have home advantage and, although the Dokens would fancy themselves to end LARKHALL THISTLE's cup progress, they'll underestimate the Reebok Premier team at their peril.

Westfield, CARNOUSTIE could be the last port of call on the Cup travels of HILL O' BEATH if Panmure can find the form of which they are undoubtedly capable. The other Fife survivors, DUNDONALD BLUEBELL have a very tough 'un in ARTHURLIE. 'Lie have shown indifferent form this season but will carry too many big guns for a Bluebell side whose appearance at this stage is a bonus for a club not enjoying a good domestic campaign.

POLLOK go in at home to LESMAHAGOW and, although they will be afford their fellow Central League opponents every respect, the holders will surely be in the hat for the last 16.

Unluckily for the Reebok Central League, however, eight of their thirteen last 32 survivors have been drawn together.

Ties are due on Saturday 17th January.

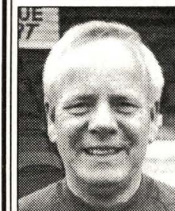

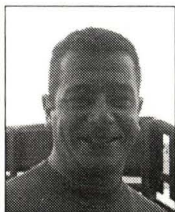

SNIFFING ABOUT WITH THE SNOOT

SHOULD Kirrie's Westview Park be unplayable next Saturday, then there could be the possibility of a switch to the Canniepairt. Any change will be intimated on th Newslne.

THE club is grateful to Foodmek and in particular, Ron Smith and Tam Campbell, for repairing the portable training goals.

THERE has been speculation that the Auchinleck v Glenafton OVD tie could be switched to Sunday to avoid a clash with Cumnock v Tayport scheduled to be played a few miles down the road at the same time. However that's all it is - speculation. Don't expect there to be any change.

SINCE we played ARMADALE Thistle pre-season, the East Region Premier side have had a major reshuffle. Carlo Crolla has taken over as manager and his assistant is ex Partick and Notts Forest player Martin Clark. The new duo have their work cut out - 'Dale lost their first 11 league games on the trot. However there's light at end of the tunnel. The new manager's ten new signings, several of whom are from the Senior game, are beginning to make an impact and the team managed to collect its first point of the season from a 1-1 draw at Arniston. Incidentally, Armadale's cup hopes were ended by Cumnock earlier this month when three late goals gave the Ayrshire League leaders a 4-1 win at Volunteer Park.

THE ABSOLUTE GAME, the Scottish Football fanzine looks like closing its doors after 55 issues. The current - and probably last ever - issue is on sale at McKenzies's in Castle Street and Irvine's the newsagent in Nelson Street.

IT's an amazing fact, but Tayport FC has made more appearances in the Scottish Junior Cup Final in five years than all the Tayside clubs together have made in 113 years. Violet in 1929 and Lochee Harp in 1954 were the only previous appearances since the cup was first contested in 1886.

GARY Maher, who left Tayport for Scone Thistle earlier this season, has netted in each of his new side's last two games to help lift them into pole position in Division Two. It's going to be tough going in the second division this season with only one team being promoted.

TAYPORT FC received a Christmas card from Grampian TV and in it they tell us that the club will feature in series 2 of *Under The Hammer* on Monday 9th February 1998 at 7pm.

NO, we've not got a new player by the name of 'Sime'! Both *The Sporting Post* and *The Sunday Post* reported that Sime had netted Tayport's opener at East Craigie. Craigie's reporter got his No.11's mixed up. Sime was their No.11 but it was our No. 11, Ian Greig, who scored, and a fine goal it was, too.

THE *Evening Telegraph* seems determined to have North End to win the Tayside championship. Yet another banner headline on Wednesday evening telling us that 'Dokens step up title bid'.

Although Kinnoull and Tayport have both been in Division One since season 1991/92, this will be only the sides' eighth meeting on the Canniepairt - 6 league games and a 1st round Perthshire Advertiser Cup 1st round match in 1993 were the previous encounters. The league games have always gone Tayport's way but 'Noull almost pulled off a shock in that cup tie, drawing 1-1 after extra time, and only going out of the cup on penalties.

Kinnoull will have to pull off the Houdini act of all time if they are to escape relegation. They'll not be throwing in the towel yet, however, and they will see a result this afternoon as a springboard for an escape act.

Kinnoull collected one of their two points with a creditable 0-0 draw at Violet and it won't have escaped Tayport's notice that their away defeats have all been narrow affairs. Injuries have been a problem for the Tulloch Park team and ordering offs haven't helped either. Three players had early showers in the corresponding game against ourselves at Perth the other week, including keeper Mike Whyte who also got his marching orders a couple of weeks prior to that in his team's Scottish Cup defeat at Harthill.

Sergei Baltacha, son of the Ukranian internationalist of the same name is listed in the Kinnoull pool but injuries have limited his appearances. One to watch up front is youngster Robert Ogilvy who came close to finding the net early on in our 7-0 win at Tulloch Park in November.

Tayport will have to reshuffle the pack in the absence of skipper Sean Wilkie, paying for his sins against St Josephs with a two game ban, and may have to leave out Mark Spalding who took a knock in training. Martin Wilkinson took a bad one against East Craigie last Saturday and looks certain to miss out.

Tayport had a good workout in midweek against Lochee Harp when Dave Reilly, Stevie Ross and Barry Gardiner were amongst the goals in a 6-1 win at a rain and windswept Gussie Park.

Regardless of their managerial upheavals, injuries, suspensions etc experienced in a fairly traumatic season so far, Kinnoull took a point from a 2-2 draw with Elmwood last week and will travel to north Fife heartened by that wee change of fortune.

It's the last home game of the year, so let's hope it's entertaining fare. Once again, thank you to our match sponsor and a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year to everybody.

SHAKE UP OF THE JUNIOR GAME IMMINENT?

Junior Football's Independent Review Committee has spelt out its proposals to take the game into the 21st century.

Reproduced below are the recommendations and future objectives as set out by the review committee which were the subject of a special meeting of the Tayside JFA earlier this week. It would be fair to say that, although some of the recommendations and objectives didn't meet with favour, the mood of the meeting was positive towards change. The proposals are to be discussed by the clubs who will report back to their association at a meeting in February.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- * Reduce the number of regions from six to two.
- * Introduction of Northern and Southern Premier Leagues. (this would initially comprise 4 Tayside, 4 North and 4 Fife)
- * Present regional leagues to be retained as feeder leagues.
- * Local cup competitions to remain.
- * Introduction of a Champions League competition.
- * Establish an SJFA marketing and PR department.
- * Establish closer links with the administrators of the Senior game.
- * Establish a structured fixture list covering the entire season.
- * Standardisation of kick-off times.
- * Semi-finalists of Scottish Junior Cup to enter the Senior equivalent via the existing North and South Qualifying Cups.

FURTHER OBJECTIVES

- * Introduce legislation to limit the number of players over 21 reinstated from Senior Football.
- * Replace the term 'Junior' with a descriptor which adequately reflects the level of football played.
- * Review of 'S' Form procedures to make younger players more accessible.
- * Raise accommodation standards at Junior grounds.
- * Introduce a March - December season.
- * Schedule more Sunday fixtures.
- * Revise and standardise disciplinary codes.
- * All knock-out cup ties to be played to a finish over one match except in the Scottish Junior Cup.

It must be emphasised that these are just proposals and they are reproduced here without further comment to allow supporters the opportunity to provide feedback to the club over the next couple of months.

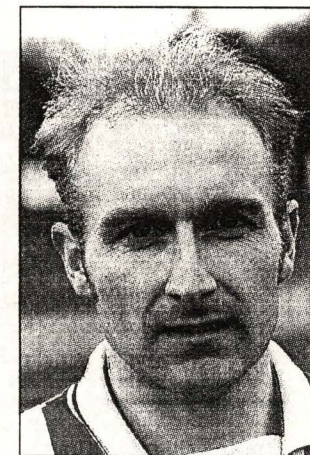
