TODAY'S GAME

It's the first meeting of the season between ourselves and Lochee Harp. Indeed it's our first meeting in the league since 1994/95 when we triumphed 8-1 on the Canniepairt, the highlight of which was four goals from the legendary Hamish Mackay. A similar result would do this afternoon but there is no way Harp are likely to allow that. They may be at the foot of the table but they will be looking to overhaul St Josephs and Elmwood thanks to seven and nine games in hand respectively and then set their sights on Forfar West End.

However with an average of only one goal a game, scoring goals has been a Harp problem this season. The loss of Ian McLeod to Brechin City during the close season has meant that Stevie Higgins has often had to plough a lone furrow up front.

Graeme Allan, Stevie Fotheringham and Jimmy Dunn are three of the youngsters on whom Harp have had to rely and the first division has been a steep learning curve for them.

The accent has had to be on defence, where the experience of the likes of keeper Kenny MacLeod and Mike Kelly has pulled the team through on several occasions already this season. It would be fair to say that the supporters are unlikely to see all out attacking play from Harp today.

This is another big game for Tayport who require to collect six points from their last five games to regain the League Championship last won in '96 - although a defeat for North End at Lochee United today would mean three points would be sufficient. A win today would give next Saturday's league game at home to Violet great significance.

From having a full squad a couple of weeks ago, Tayport's pool has been diminished somewhat by injury. John Young's comeback has been halted by an another injury, Mark Spalding, unlucky with injury this season, is out with a broken toe and Allan Ramsay, who has had to come off these past two games, is also out of the picture today. Grant Buist, out with a broken nose, was on the bench last week and he'll be looking for a taste of the action today. Grant Miller is now fully recovered from injury and, having appeared as substitute in the last three games, is also raring to go.

A relatively unfamiliar face in charge today is Mr Stewart McAulay from Glenrothes. Tayside secretary Big Jock Myles was short of referees this week but he has been bailed out by the Fife Association who readily made their officials available. Mr McAulay's assistants are also from the Fife Juniors, and like the referee, will no doubt have been at the Canniepairt on some previous occasion.

HARP STILL LOOKING FOR FIRST WIN OVER 'PORT

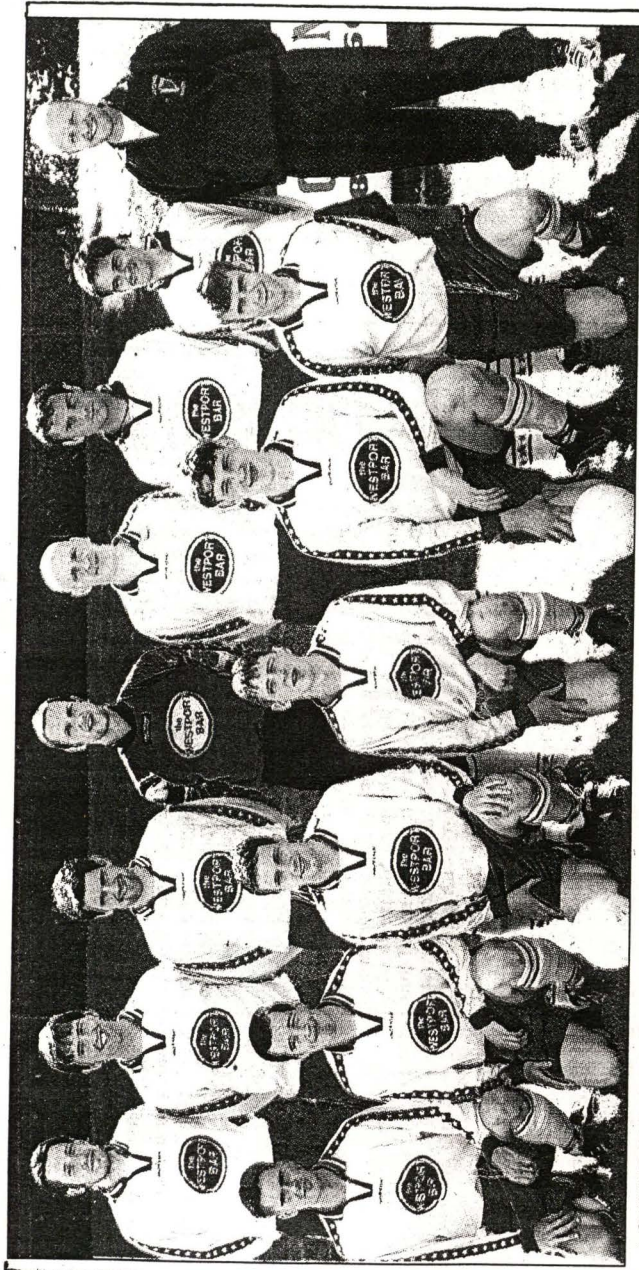
Although Tayport have met Lochee Harp only twice since season 1995/96, the teams have faced each other on a total of sixteen occasions, eight here and eight at Beechwood.

Tayport's record is played 16 won 16 scoring 60 goals for the loss of 9. Billy Coventry got the sequence underway in 1990 with the only goal of the game in a second division encounter on the Canniepairt. More than half the goals since then, however, have been shared between two players, Dave Reilly with 15 goals and Hamish Mackay with 19. Hamish, ironically, is a former Harp player. DR has netted in ten of the sixteen games and will be looking to add to that tally today.
