TONIGHT'S GAME

It's a big game for the 'Port tonight with a draw sufficient to give us an uncatchable lead at the top of the NCR Premier Division and an eighth title in ten years. It's just the sort of game which will bring out the best in what many observers consider is an underachieving Carnoustie team. In common with all sides arriving at the Canniepairt, the Gowfers will relish being cast in the role of party poopers.

An added incentive, of course, is the fact that as many as six of the visitors likely to play this evening have played at the Canniepairt in a Tayport jersey.

It's clear then that Tayport will have their work cut out but they've been over the course before and can handle the occasion. Keeper Ryan Sochanik, gallivanting on the continent this weekend, will be an absentee but Steven Stewart will return to the pool after his stint with the international side. Stevie Ross, whose run of scoring in five consecutive games came to an end when he had to be replaced at half-time last Saturday is an injury doubt. In that event there could be a place on the bench for young Australian trialist Andy Lawson who has been training with the squad these past few weeks. Andy most recently played in the West Australian Premier Division with Perth's Western Knights FC, the same league in which Dundee FC's recent signing Chris Coyne played.

Carnoustie disappointed in the Concept Trophy semi-final at Westfield a couple of weeks ago but showed in our first meeting of the season, a 1-1 draw that they have what it takes. There's obviously no hangover from the semi-final defeat with a win over Kirrie last Saturday and a 7-1 thrashing of Montrose Roselea on Monday evening. Barrie Gray got the only goal v Kirrie and fans here know that, on his game, nobody can touch the enigmatic Barrie. The former Dundee, United & Scotland player Jim McInally will be well settled into the Junior game by now and will surely be an influential figure for his team.

Carnoustie got some unfortunate press last week over the Gary Mearns disciplinary case [he received a 3 years suspension for an ordering off incident] but he has appealed against that decision and will therefore be available to play until the appeal is heard by the SJFA. Wayne Morrison, however, will be unavailable. Wayne was suspended at the same meeting but has not appealed.

FROM THE ARCHIVES APRIL 1982

Eighteen years ago in April 1982, Tayport Amateurs were poised to win their one and only Midlands Championship but on this corresponding Thursday, 22 April, Tayport were at East End Park for the semi-final tie in the North of Tay Cup against Harris FP. It was to be the first of two semi-final defeats inside 48 hours for Tayport.

Gus Malone, of course, will be turning out for Carnoustie this evening after a career which has spanned half a dozen clubs, Senior and Junior, in between. Gus played in 35 out of Tayport's 39 games that season and was second top scorer with 19 goals. Jim Bissett, an ex Panmure man had 31 games and 7 goals.

Top scorer with 21 goals from 37 games was Ian Howe who was one of four of the above side who was in action for Tayport Veterans' XI on Monday past, losing 0-2 to Guardbridge United. The others were Alan Hart, Jim Downie and Alan Gray.

Alan Gray is still playing for Tayport Amateurs and was in action last Saturday. Phil Smith is playing for Dundee College while Kevin Murphy is playing Sunday Football. Alan Hart, or 'auld Harty', as he was known to avoid confusion with 'young Harty' (no relation) is in European action this weekend, 'leading (and playing!) the Amateurs squad playing in the annual tournamaent in Liege. The others still turn out in the occasional friendly with the exception of Kenny Smith who is on the committee here at the Canniepairt.

It's surprising to note that, eighteen years on, all still live locally. Although four of the squad now stay in Tayport, with the exception of Allan Harte, the entire squad that evening hailed from outwith the town.

Of the 28 players who turned out that season, apart from the ones mentioned above, only four Bruce Burnett, Neil Downie, Ian Lyall and Colin Gray still play.

The club had just returned from Belgium earlier that week after lifting the Jaques Vandebosch Trophy with wins over a Belgian side and an Italian side on Sunday to reach the final and record a 4-0 victory over the Belgian hosts on the Monday afternoon to spark off an orgy of Jupiler consumption.
