TODAY'S MATCH

A visit to the Canniepairt is seen as a test by most clubs. Probably because not too many have won here. Bankfoot are an exception. Tayport holds no fears for the Perthshire club after their shock win here in 1994/95. Tayport won the title that season and didn't lose a game in the process but Bankfoot, then in Division Two, eliminated us from the Perthshire Advertiser Cup. They packed their goal for a goalless draw that day and took the tie on penalty kicks.



Bankfoot have a 100% record away from home this season and are unlikely to employ such defensive tactics today. They have shown that they can live with the Premier League sides and, having netted in every outing this season (apart from the Herschell game), they possess the strike power to test the best of defences.

Forget the Herschell Trophy match at the start of the season which Tayport won by 3-0. By their own admission Bankfoot treated that game as a warm up match for the season proper.

Good wins, however, have been tempered with sloppy performances against Elmwood (1-4), North End (1-5) and Violet (3-6) but last week's result against the North Region's league leaders Longside will have done the confidence no harm.

Injuries have caused one or two worries with Steve McDougall and Gary Sweeney missing a number of games and striker Alan Keddie the latest doubt with an ankle injury. However, with the biggest player pool in Tayside, Bankies are unlikely to be chapping doors.

Tayport will be struggling, however. Long term absentees Sean Wilkie and Allan Ramsay have been joined by Mark Spalding. Two others have also been receiving treatment but Grant Buist is back from his nuptials in America, and played half a game at Fochabers before nipping back to welcome guests at his wedding reception in Dundee.

The league's top four meet each other today, so the stakes are high for all clubs. North End's game at Kirrie sees them only one game off the halfway mark of the league season.

TODAY'S VISITORS

Bankfoot are our visitors this afternoon and they will arrive at the Canniepairt in buoyant mood having disposed of North Region Premier League leaders Longside FC by 3-2 in the opening round of the OVD Scottish Cup last Saturday. This was a notable victory for the Bankies whose achievement didn't get the recognition in the press that it perhaps deserved.

Striker Alan Keddie, the club's top scorer, notched all three goals and he has been a constant threat since signing from Inverness Clachnacudden. It was his second hat-trick of the season. Another threat up front is Barry Ward who had a brief spell with Hill of Beath Hawthorn last season.

Veteran keeper Rab Aitken was to have hung up his boots after helping the team to the second division championship last season but when his replacement Scott Walker was injured, Rab answered the call. Unfortunately Aitken received red card in the league game against Forfar West End two weeks ago.

Big defender John Gilmartin took over in goal that afternoon and played a big part in helping Athletic secure the three points. Gilmartin was a rock for Bankfoot in the 1-1 draw with Tayport last season and whether playing at the back or in midfield today, his accurate passing will be one of the visitors' strengths.

Adding class to the Bankfoot midfield is Montrose FC target Gareth Dailly, who joined up only three weeks ago after successfully appealing against his retention by Forfar Albion.

In Alan Cameron, Bankfoot have a Scottish Internationalist. However it's playing Futsal as opposed to football that Alan represents his country. That's the game played indoors with a heavy type of ball.

Bankfoot, currently the top side in Perthshire have surprised a few with their form over the last couple of seasons. They are a well organised and well coached side and their current fourth top spot is merited. Three points behind ourselves, with a game in hand, Bankies will see this as an opportunity to stake a claim in the league championship race.

The first round has come and almost gone with few surprises. Among the few was CARNOUSTIE failing to beat Ayrshire Division Two side ARDEER THISTLE who have yet to win a league game this season. A 4-1 defeat at home by BANKS O' DEE was a crushing blow for ST ANDREWS UNITED whose Manager Pete Hutton was looking for a good run from his new look young team. However Fife's GLEN-ROTHES after a nervy start took ELMWOOD to bits, winning 6-0 in Dundee. Old boy here at the Canniepairt, Steve Hutcheon, scorer of four goals in Glens' 4-2 cup final win over Kelty Hearts the other Sunday, got another two here.

Just along the road from us at Keith, Fochabers' near neighbours ISLAVALLE were ensuring that the long journey home to south Ayrshire would be miserable for MUIRKIRK who went down by the only goal of the game.

ARBROATH VICS haven't had the best of starts to the season but would be cheered up with a 2-1 home win over BANCHORY.

Big guns out are BONNYRIGG ROSE, 2-1 losers at ARTHURLIE and, in the other first round crowd puller, LINLITHGOW ROSE exited at MARYHILL. A bad day for the roses as Elvis Costello might have said.

MONTROSE were held at home by Forfar West End in last year's fifth round. This time it was FORFAR ALBION who shared two goals to earn a replay. Roselea won the replay last season. I wouldn't bank on them repeating that today.

Draw for the second round is tomorrow. Catch the Newslane from the back of 2pm for Tayport's fate.

would still leave scope for lesser teams to possibly shock the big guns, while perhaps humiliating scorelines which do not serve

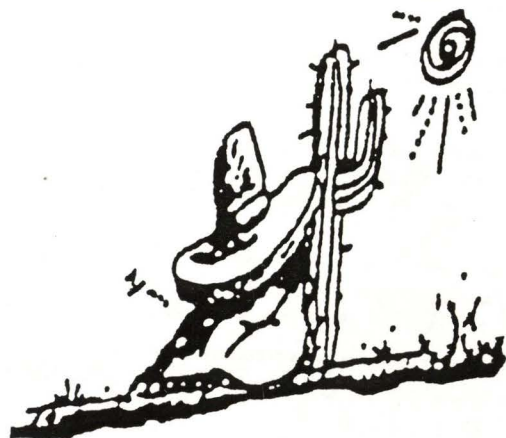
