With extra time and penalty kicks to be budgeted for, a 6 o'clock or 6.30pm kick-off is likely with players and committee struggling to get to Carnoustie in good time. A dull, rainy night could well see an abandonment if extra time is required. Fingers crossed, though, that it's a bright, dry warm and sunny evening.



With a place in the semi-finals of an inter-regional cup already secured, 'Port will today bid to match that achievement on a national level, although Bathgate will certainly provide more stubborn opposition.





Things are heating up as we move into the last eight weeks or so of the season, although, for some clubs, the season could extend into the middle of June. Take **Hill of Beath** for instance, only 9 league games played out of 28 in the best part of 8 months. Three teams in the **Fife** league have played exactly double that number.

That's not as bad as Auchinleck Talbot however. In the 7 team Ayrshire 1st division, where they play each other three times, they have played only 6 league games in 8 months.

Back to the **East Superleague**, though, and it's as you were on **Tayside**. **North End**, dropping three points at home to **Kirrie**, will hardly dent their hopes of a Superleague place but kind of scuppers any title aspirations they may have cherished. The win, however, may have rekindled the hopes of Kirrie who have games in hand. A win at home to **Carnoustie** today will put the Jags very much back in the running.

Tayside League boss **Jock Myles** will undoubtedly be unhappy to hear rumours circulating that several Tayside clubs will decline to join the Superleague should they finish in the top four. **Lochee United** are not one such club. The Bluebells are desperate for a Superleague place and the fact that it could be by default does not worry the Thomson Park management in the slightest. Probably in a similar frame of mind are **Violet** but they've slumped to the foot of the table and look to have left things too late.

In **Fife**, no change at the top but it will be the flurry of games at the end of the season that will decide, with the likes of **Haws**, **Kelty** and **Glens** confident that a late run will take them into the frame.

The existing **East Region** are concerned over constitutional changes planned for the new league set-up but, despite their rumblings, there seems little doubt that the SJFA will have its way. **Bathgate**, currently 3rd, look good bets to finish top five - a huge improvement on last season when relegation was avoided by a hairsbreadth. **Linlithgow** are certs and **Whitburn** will also be at short odds.





OVD SCOTTISH JUNIOR CUP QUARTER FINAL TAYPORT v BATHGATE THISTLE

Although this is Tayport's 7th OVD Cup quarter final appearance in the past 12 years, four of which have been at Tayport, this is the first replay to be staged at The Canniepairt. In this respect it must be the biggest game to be staged here to date.

Bathgate are bowling along on the crest of a wave, having now gone 13 games undefeated. Not since October have manager Willie Hill's men tasted defeat. Indeed you have to go back to September and a shock Fife & Lothians Cup defeat at Newburgh for their last defeat on the road. That's a measure of the task which faces 'Port this afternoon.

The experience in Thistle's line-up was a major factor in Bathgate's 1-0 win at Cumnock in the last round, and this was again evident in last week's game when experienced defenders Davie Smyth, Eddie Petrie and Paul Jack stood rock steady, particularly as Tayport forced the pace in the second half.

Bathgate's game plan is unlikely to vary much from that which paid dividends in Ayrshire, when a good team performance restricted their opponents so effectively that Cumnock were unable to create any clear cut chances. Striker Craig Finlay, who had three seasons at Hearts, was signed from Peterhead earlier this season to provide extra firepower and, along with top scorer Andy Roberts, will be the men manager Willie Hill will be looking to for goals.

Paul Jack and coach Peter Godfrey took in Tayport v Forfar West End two weeks ago and will have marked boss Hill's card. Godfrey, the ex-St Mirren defender, is no stranger to these parts having twice been here with Linlithgow Rose.

Manager Hill felt that his side underperformed last week and hinted that he will be making a few changes for today. Dave Baikie, too, could possibly make changes, with striker Colin McGlashan getting ever closer to fitness and Gareth Dailly available again after suspension.

It was an entertaining affair last week and the fans will be hoping for more of the same as the teams bid to join Linlithgow, Kilwinning Rangers and either Glenafton or Auchinleck in tomorrow's semifinal draw which will take place on Football First on STV and Grampian TV.

Today's game has, of course, to be played to a finish with extra time and penalty kicks if required.
