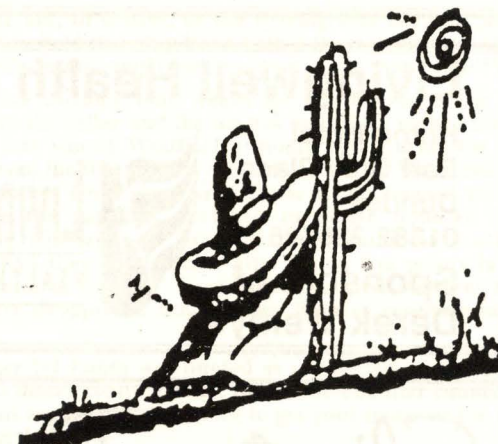

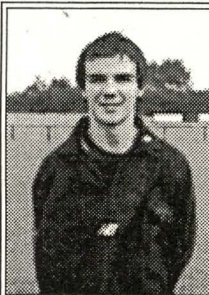

TODAY'S GAME

Incredibly, after 21 league games it's all down to this afternoon's game, a game which brings the curtain down on the Tayside Junior FA after 33 years. A climax such as this for the last ever Tayside fixture couldn't have been scripted! Carnoustie need only a draw to win their first Tayside championship since 1981, while, for Tayport, only a win will suffice if they are to complete a remarkable comeback, having trailed their opponents by 19 points at one point, to lift a ninth championship in eleven years

Carnoustie are, of course, in the driving seat because, as things stand at present, they hold the whip hand with a three point lead, the goal difference in Tayport's favour only being an issue in the event of a 'Port victory.

It's been an anxious four weeks for the Gowfers. The champagne was returned to the cellar and the ice has long since melted following Tayport's dramatic late win at Westfield a month ago. Carnoustie were a mere ten minutes from the title on that occasion. Then, on Wednesday past, they were twenty minutes from glory until Davie Evans bagged the winner v North End. Now the gap has stretched to ninety minutes. As anyone from Carnoustie will tell you, however, they would have settled for today's situation had they been asked, after losing five points in their first three league games in August. Seventeen successive victories followed but five points were dropped in the last two fixtures resulting in this afternoon's scenario.

Club owner DJ Laing was quoted as saying last week's game (the Findlay Cup final) didn't really matter, this is the one that counts. I don't suppose anyone will argue with that. (nice to get your name on the cup for a seventh time, nevertheless)

Today's tactics will be interesting. In requiring only a draw, will Carnoustie shut up shop and go for a no scoring draw, whilst at the same time hoping to snatch a goal? Or will it be a yoicks tally ho approach in an effort to sweep 'Port away? With tactical guru/director of football/head coach Kenny Cameron walking out on the club in what appeared somewhat bizarre circumstances, it will be left to player coach Gary Ogilvie with assistance, no doubt, from veteran defender Gus Malone and coach Grant Clark to formulate the tactics, probably with some input from the likes of the experienced Bobby Geddes and Dougie Craig or even DJ himself.

Tayport will still be without the holidaying David Fisher but, barring any injury reaction from Wednesday past, will rely on the sixteen on duty then. Carnoustie aren't likely to show many changes from last week's pool. Defenders Keith Galbraith and Scott Kopel are long term injury victims and will miss out but the influential Gary Buick could be back. Kenny Cameron jnr., only seven goals this season, the most recent in December, seems to have disappeared from the picture leaving the ever-dangerous Darren Bonella as the main attacking threat.

Drafted in to referee this afternoon is Gordon Hunter, who has spent the last couple of seasons or so as an assistant referee in the Bank of Scotland SPL. He will be assisted by Graeme Curr and Terry Brunton.

END OF AN ERA
TAYSIDE JUNIOR FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION
1969/70 - 2001/02

The Tayside Junior FA will be no more after this season. A lot of balls have hit the back of the various nets in that time and John Brown's page in Friday's *Tele* could no doubt be filled for months and months with anecdotes from the Juniors during the past three decades. We'll just have a quick summary here.

If successes were tallied up Tayport, despite featuring in only the last dozen years in terms of cup and league wins, would be top of the premier division (see below)

In 33 seasons 28 different clubs have won honours in 19 different competitions. The Cinderella club is Coupar Angus. Despite entering 275 competitions in this period, Coupar failed to get their name engraved on a trophy.

Nine cups which were contested at some point during the life of the Tayside Juniors are no longer played for - Courier Cup, Telegraph Cup, Kiddie Cup, PA Cup, Cream of the Barley Trophy, SRS Cup, Dryburgh Cup, Tayside Region League Cup, Winter Cup. Where are they all now we wonder?

A number of clubs which formerly graced the Tayside scene went defunct during this period including St Josephs, Balbeggie, Hydro Dynamo, Crieff Earngrove, Aylth United, Stobswell, Dundee Osborne, Forfar East End and Forfar Celtic

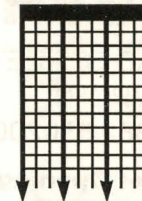

Obviously the dismissals of Bonella then Wayne Morrison, reduced Panmure's hopes of a salvage operation, although the Gowfers were not without their chances.

Following today's crunch encounter, Tayside's top two will meet again on Tuesday evening in the final of the North End Challenge Cup, with 'Port booking their place by virtue of a narrow 2-1 win against Downfield (29/5) when Gareth Dailly and Brian Craik, were again on target.

That cup final will mark the end of a long, long season, giving Tayport an opportunity to finish on a high but will they be going for a fourth or fifth trophy success?

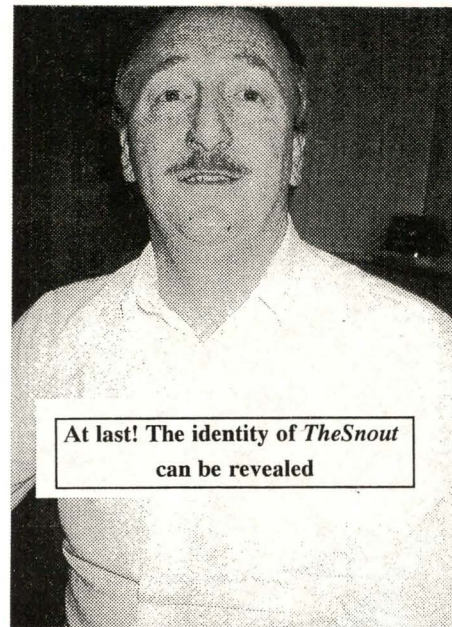

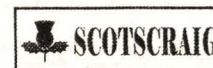

Exclusive! - World Cup Guidelines for the BBC Commentary Team

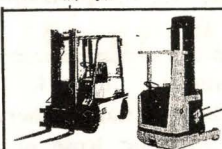

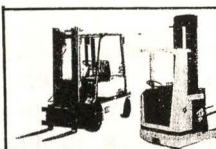

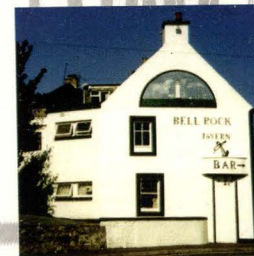
