

# OVD SCOTTISH JUNIOR CUP 4th ROUND REPLAY TAYPORT v POLLOK

Pollok pay their third visit to the Canniepairt this afternoon. Their last visits have seen them record a win and a draw, so hopefully they will complete the set today! This will actually be the seventh meeting between the sides, all but one - a friendly at Newlandsfield - have been in the Scottish Cup and that's perhaps a measure of how well the respective clubs have fared in the competition over the past dozen or so years. It's been four draws and two defeats for 'Port who are looking to record a first victory today.

The name of Pollok is perhaps synonomous with all that's good in junior football and our visit to Glasgow last Saturday confirmed that - nice ground, good atmosphere, big, friendly, knowledgeable crowd and excellent hospitality.

The game, quite rightly, was hailed as a superb advert for the junior game. No goals but plenty goalmouth action kept Pollok's biggest crowd of the season on their toes to the end. It's probably too much to ask that we get another cracker today.

Whilst Pollok were without the services of probably their most influential player, John Hendry, they showed that in Phil Cannie and Drew McMaster that they have the players who can cause headaches for any defence. At the back Kevin O'Neil's experience was a telling factor for the Central League club and Danny Hanley's first half save from John Ward's header showed the quality Pollok have between the sticks.

Tayport, already without their goalscoring defender Derek Wemyss through suspension, had to strap up both Allan Ramsay and Steven Stewart to make the starting line-up but both failed to last the ninety minutes. Scott Peters was another in the wars but he soldiered on as did Grant Paterson who took a heavy first half knock. The treatment room at Canniepairt on Monday night resembled A&E at Holby General. Some, if not all could be absentees today.

'Port supporters were heartened by the appearance on the sub's bench at Newlandsfield of last season's 58 goal striker Ronnie Kenneth, out of action since 30 minutes and one goal into the new season on August 15th. Manager Dave Baikie was understood to be suitably impressed by the player's full training session on Monday evening where he was said to be 'banging in goals from all over the place'. So, who knows, Ronado could be set to make a surprise comeback.

Also in line for a place up front will be Colin McGlashan, Tayport's midweek signing from Elgin City.





Tayport became striker Colin McGlashan's tenth club - but his first junior club - in a career which started with Dundee and a debut at home to Aberdeen in December 1982 when he came on as substitute for Bobby Glennie. Since then Dibble's clubs have been Dunfermline, Cowdenbeath, Clyde, Partick Thistle, Ayr United, Montrose, Arbroath and most recently Elgin City from where he moved to the Canniepairt on Thursday past. The 37 year old has notched up 245 league goals on his travels and will be looking to add to that total at Tayport.




