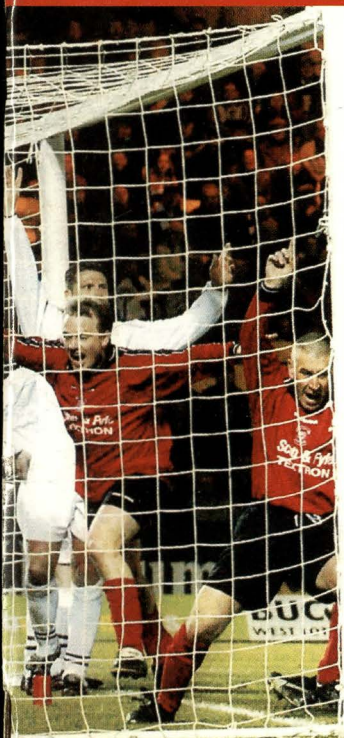

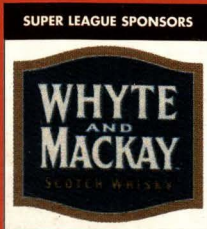
Tayport's OVD Semi-Final Goal v Linlithgow Rose

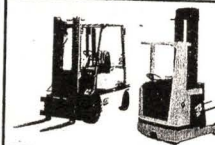

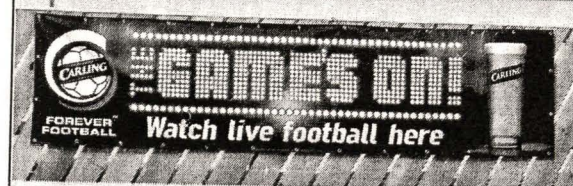

TAYPORT v DUNDEE VIOLET

All Super League games have been keenly contested to date and today's encounter with Dundee Violet is unlikely to be an exception.

The ingredients all are here for an enthralling game. Tayport are striving hard to maintain a top of the table presence whilst Violet are battling hard to put behind them a sticky start to the campaign.

It's a very tight league, and with 25% of the clubs to be relegated at the end of the season, plenty pressure is being piled on those at the bottom end of the table.

Violet are in that position at present but an upsurge in their form has seen them target several of the clubs above them as being eminently catchable. It's against that background that today's game takes place.

There's added spice, of course that the Pansies' management used to occupy the same berth at the Canniepairt. There's nothing a manager likes better than putting one over his former club. It's the same with players and both Kenny Jones and Brian Harris will be up for the game today.

After opening the season with five Super League defeats on the trot, the recent Violet improvement has seen them win three of their last four games. Despite their mixed results, goalscoring has never been much of a problem for the Glenesk side, with an average of over two goals a game. Before last Saturday's game, this was a better scoring average than Tayport.

Violet have only failed to score once in their eleven competitive games this season, but in these games have only once kept a clean sheet and that was against Carnoustie the other week.

Jonathan McKeith, who hit a double at Lochgelly last week, has been finding the net regularly and he will be an obvious threat to Tayport.

Tayport shuffled the pack last week and, with a seven goal win, Dave Baikie will have plenty to ponder over before making his starting selection. Unavailable, however, will be Roberto Morris who will be serving the first game of a three game suspension.

A...B...C... a Tayport Football Club A -Z

G is for **Goalscorers**. Every club has had its share of goalscoring heroes and Tayport FC is no exception. Unfortunately there are no documented records pre-mid 60s, so one has to depend on anecdotal evidence for the goalscoring exploits of players from that period and often time has embellished the achievements, so we'll restrict our mentions to a few 70s + strikers. Anybody who wants to remind us of pre-70s legends, please get in touch. Ian White, now president of Cupar Hearts, had the goalden touch in the late sixties but the player who dominated the 1970s was Ian Howe. Six times the club's top scorer in that era Ian's best was 35 in 1978. Bruce Burnett was top scorer 4 times in the 80s, hitting 45 in '86. Bruce also topped the second string's list twice in the same period. In Junior days Dave Reilly was undisputed king but memories of Hamish Mackay, Kenny Cameron and Ronnie Kenneth's exploits will also be recalled when Tayport's goalkings are discussed in future.

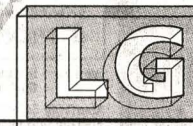
H is for **Hackers** Like all other clubs, Tayport has had its hackers as well its goalscoring legends. However, records aren't kept of cynical fouls, so we have to rely on anecdotal evidence. It's also a somewhat fond term to describe players who weren't blessed with the greatest of skill and had to resort to hacking to halt the opposition when an attacking onslaught prevailed. These lads were often in the Alliance team and could be best described as honest hackers. As some of these hackers are still about the club, it's best that we don't go into this too much for fear of reprisals! There are others, too, because of their build, who were looked upon by opponents as players to fear in Tayport teams. This was often a trifle unfair because this type of player often also possessed many skilful attributes. However when the occasion demanded, they could look after themselves..... and their more petit teammates also. Who was your favourite honest hacker, cynical hacker and skilful hacker?

I is for **ICE**. Ice? We've got to get our supply for use by the physio from the pub because despite all the paraphernalia carried by the modern day physio, ice still appears to do the business. Ice is something, from a weather point of view, that is probably less of a problem than at Tayport than at some clubs. It's perhaps the situation of the Canniepairt, a hefty goalkeeper's punt from the Tay and within sight of the North Sea, that allows games to go on here when many others are postponed through icy underfoot conditions. And that's been a decided bonus to a club which often plays far more than the average number of games in a season. It's not all good, though, what about that icy wind that blows right in from Iceland from time to time? Brrr....

TODAY'S VISITORS DUNDEE VIOLET

Tayport vs. Dundee Violet is the nearest we're ever going to have to a derby match in the Super League set-up. Separated merely by the width of the Tay, Violet's home at Glenesk Park nestles under the Law, so they are our nearest neighbours.

Violet can be described as perennial under achievers as, although they have enjoyed top league status for the best part of quarter of a century, their trophy cabinet is bare with a Currie Cup win in 1982 their most recent success.

This is a disappointing return for a club which is a major player in local junior football and in particular Mr Violet, aka Norrie Farquhar, and his committee who have ploughed a lot of energy and resources into their club.

The recruitment of John Holt from Dundee United as chief coach a few years ago stabilised the playing side off things at Glenesk, but tangible success still proved elusive and Holt gave way to the present incumbents Andy Sommerville and Dave Tosney.

Andy and Dave, of course, are extremely well known and respected here at the Canniepairt, having given sterling service both in playing and management. Indeed Andy achieved something of legendary status as team captain during the early nineties when we got to the Scottish Junior Cup final. The duo have been used to success and the Violet committee have pinned their hopes on Andy and Dave delivering the goods to Glenesk.

Injuries and suspensions hampered Violet's start to the Whyte & Mackay Super League campaign, but these are now largely problems of the past and the Pansies are nobody's soft touch.

Many of the faces are familiar to the 'port support and none more so than central defender Kenny Jones and midfielder Brian Harris, both of whom tasted both team and individual success here at Canniepairt.

Left wingback Tony McAuley faced us on many an occasion for Violet as did Mike Clark for Downfield. Giant central defender Mark Gorgon was recruited from St Andrews amateur football and there are a number of younger players who started off their adult soccer careers in the Senior game, such as Andy Sommerville Jnr at Arbroath and Chris Devine, Jon McKeith and Gary Middleton at Dundee United.

Violet secretary Lyall Murdoch is the current president of the new East Region.

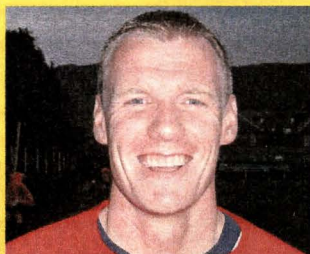

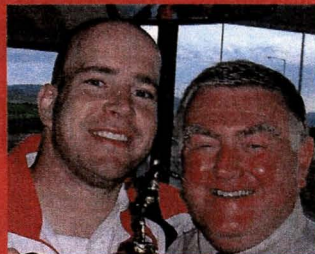

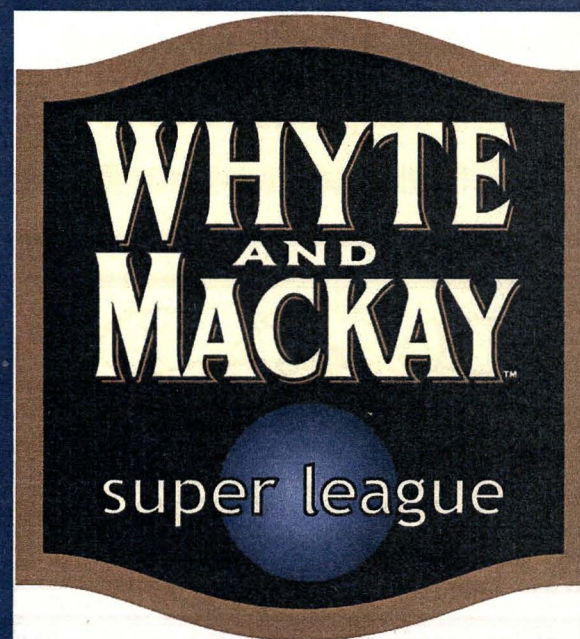
One goal a-piece, from both Gareth Dailly and Jonathan Mitchell took the final total to seven without reply, and a more than comfortable passage into the second round of the competition.

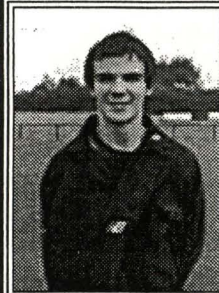

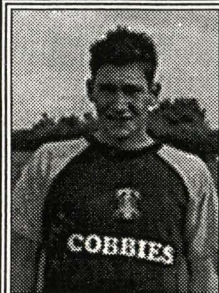

MEDIA WATCH

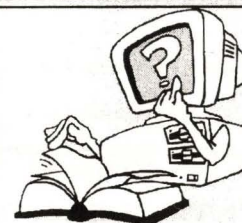
The *Edinburgh Evening News*, praised for its coverage in the last Port Prog, isn't so hot on its attention to detail in their Friday preview. It described Arbroath SC as struggling in the Super League whilst pre-viewing their tie at with St Andrews United. Sometimes one gets the impression that some correspondents and officials are still coming to terms with the new set-up and are still somewhat parochial in their outlook, hence the reason they don't pay enough attention to what's happening outside their own backyard.

It was a similar story in last Saturday's *Courier* - at least the Dundee edition - where the correspondent obviously hadn't done his or her homework in a pretty insipid column which previewed the Redwood Leisure ties. Newburgh, for example, who were away to Lochee United, were described as 'off-form'. This comment despite them going into the tie on the back of two wins and at draw, their most recent result ending Kirkcaldy YM's run of five successive victories. If that's Newburgh off-form, they should be pretty sensational when on-form!

One opened Saturday's *Sun*, hardly expecting to be featured in 'The Juniors by Scott Campbell' column but, surprise, surprise there was an entire column devoted to 'port with a photo supporting an interview with Dave Baikie along the lines of 'our season so far'.

Although, the *Fife Herald* report got top-of-the-page billing, it was an inside page again, rather than the back page on which we were featured for a while.

On Sunday, the *Sunday Mail* had a better offering last week - at least the edition they sell in Tayport - devoting a very reasonable bit of space to a column which covered a selection of games in the North, through Tayside and Fife to the Lothians although it failed to name the competition in which the Tayside and Fife based clubs were playing. Always a way to confuse the casual reader.

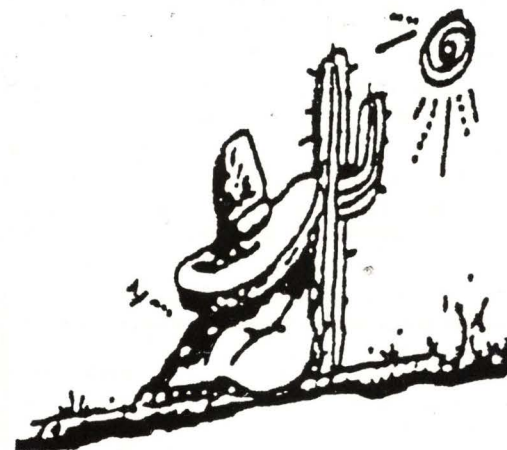

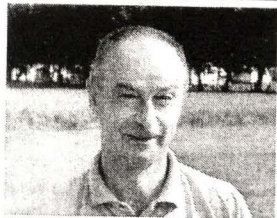

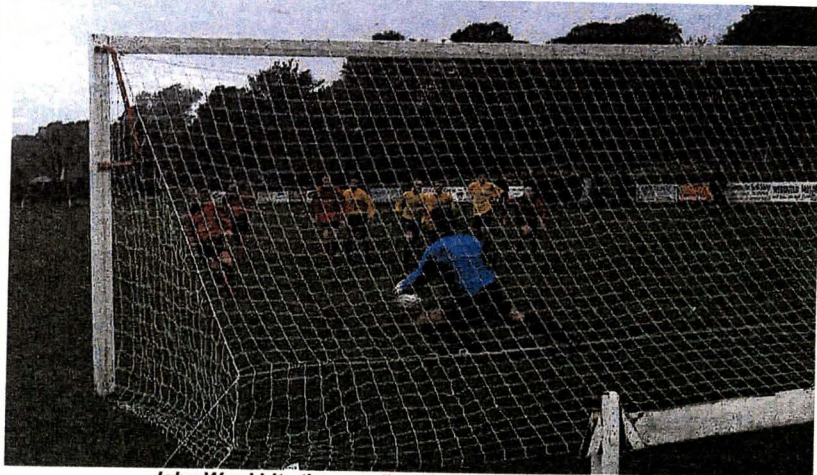
