



TODAY'S GAME CHALLENGE MATCH TAYPORT v RAITH ROVERS

This is Raith Rovers first visit to the Canniepairt and we trust it will be a pleasant one for this afternoon's friendly match.

Under the management of Antonio Calderon, Rovers have been praised for the quality of the football they have produced, football which took the club to last season's Bell's Division Two title.

It's not been plain sailing so far this season, but the Stark's Park side have made a solid start to life in the First Division and have reached the semi-finals of the Challenge Cup.

There was no Bell's programme yesterday because of the International card, so Rovers kindly agreed to this match. At the time of writing, there is no indication of the line-up which Mr Calderon will field, but, on the back of two successive defeats, the Spaniard will be looking to find a winning blend before his team travels to Dumfries to meet Queen of the South next Saturday.

Two players who are likely to feature, regardless of what strength of side Rovers put out, are former Tayport players Davie Evans and Jim Henry, both of whom were Scottish Cup winners with 'Port, Henry in 1996 and Evans earlier this year. They'll both get a good reception from the Tayport fans.

Another from the Tayside Juniors who could well be in the visitors' squad is goalkeeper Richard Carroll who recently joined the Bell's SFL club on a short term contract from Elmwood. Richard is no stranger to the Canniepairt, having trained here in the past.

Calderon's right hand man and Director of Football at Starks Park, Davie Martin, is a figure well known to Tayport fans from his days at Lochee United and Arbroath SC.. Davie was the man behind the audacious attempt to bring ex-Celt Lubo Moravcik to Kirkcaldy and was behind the moves of Henry (from Carnoustie) and Evans to the lang toon.

It's bit like the United Nations at Kirkcaldy just now with players on the books from England, Spain, Macedonia, and Argentina amongst others. There's no indication who will and who won't play as this stage. Manager Calderon has stated that he is welcoming the 10 day break between games but may be tempted to keep some of his key players in action.

Tayport's line-up will be dependent on how things went at Glenrothes yesterday but definitely out are Barry McNaughton and John Elliott, both of whom are unavailable. There could be a couple of trialists and Robbie Holden and Duncan Bruce, both on loan at Kinnoull, could maybe added to the pool.

DAVIE A ROVER NOW

With headlines like "Thank Evans for Davie" and "Evans Above", Davie Evans was the Fife Herald sub-editor's dream.

Andy Sommerville signed Davie Evans for Tayport from Arbroath FC for a nominal fee in August 2000 and gave the youngster his debut that month at Jeanfield Swifts in the Herschell Trophy.

Prior to signing for Raith Rovers, after exactly three years at The Canniepairt, 'Woody' started 78 games, came on as substitute in another 55 games and scored 76 goals for Tayport.

Davie accumulated an impressive array of silverware during that period - three league championship medals, a Scottish Cup winners medal, two regional cup winners medals, five local cup winners medals and a Tayside Top Scorer award - not bad for a 21 year old.

After a couple of substitute appearances against Ayr United and Falkirk, Davie made his full Rovers debut last Tuesday at his former club, Arbroath, in the CIS Cup.

Of course the euphoria wasn't to last and the Gerries scored twice in the second half to win 4-1 on aggregate.. Bayern then went on to lift the cup, convincingly beating Bordeaux in the final.

What these episodes from Rovers' recent history do, is illustrate that, in football, dreams can sometimes come true.

In the same way as winning the Scottish Junior Cup was but a pipe dream for Tayport's committee and punters during dark episodes in the past, so too it must have been for the Rovers' fans seeing their team beating Bayern in their own backyard, albeit for 10 mins + half-time.

It's when fans have experienced the bad days, that occasions such as these taste so much sweeter.





TAYPORT IN THE FIFE AMATEUR CUP PART 10

Despite their dismal league form in a league too far. Tayport Amateurs' Fife XI were performing in sterling fashion in the 1984/85 Fife Amateur Cup.



After having accounted for Smeaton BC and Leven Rovers, Tayport's quest to reach a third Fife final and beat their jinx to bring the cup to Tayside was gathering momentum.

In February Tayport travelled to Wemyss Hearts and won by 4-1 to reach the quarter finals, thanks to goals from Jimmy Griffin (2), Davie McDonald and Stuart Davie.

It was the quarter final draw they didn't want, though, away to crack side Ballingry Rovers. On a miserable February afternoon of rain, Port went down 5-2. An own goal and Stuart Davie counted for Tayport.

In 1985/86, the season in which the 1st XI would reach the Scottish Amateur Cup Final, Tayport were back in the less arduous East Fife Amateur League and received first round bye before having a convincing 2nd round win over Louden Glenvale by 3-0, the goals coming from prolific marksman John Fernie, Alan Hart and Andy McRobbie.

Fernie was gain the marksman in a 1-1 home draw with Eastvale but the replay on a cold Burns Day afternoon saw Tayport go down 2-1. Present committee member Kenny Smith scored the Tayport goal.

There was another bye in the opening round of the 86/87 contest and a 1-0 home defeat by Victoria Rovers in round 2.

The elusive Fife Cup was looking further away than ever in 1987/88 thanks to an opening round defeat at home by Glen Snooker Club. John Fernie and Bruce Burnett were the home scorers in a 2-4 defeat. The following season, 1988/89, Tayport were again out at the first hurdle, blowing a 2-0 half-time lead at home to lose 5-2 to Leslie Hearts. It was to get worse in 1989/90. out once again out at the first time of asking, cuffed 6-0 at Glenrothes by Woodside Athletic. As the report said " outgunned by a fitter, faster and more talented side" Tayport's team that day was Ian Lyall, Neil Munro, Bert Valentine, Ian Mathers, Andy McRobbie, John Petrie, Scott Crichton, Craig Drysdale, Gary McCabe, Ian Ness and Alan Hart. Subs were Alan McDade and Roddy Davie.


