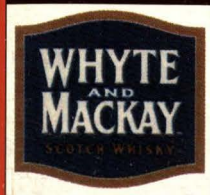

WHYTE and MACKAY SUPERLEAGUE

TAYPORT v BONNYRIGG ROSE ATHLETIC

After a break for cup action, there's a full Whyte & Mackay Super League card this afternoon and we welcome Bonnyrigg Rose for only their second visit to Tayport.

Neither team's squad varies hugely from those who fought out two close contests last season. Tayport have brought in Sean Christie, John Elliott, Ben Honeyman and Kevin Heenan whilst Rose have Mark Lockhart, from Camelon, striker Colin Campbell, versatile youngster Colin Bonner and Paul Riley, signed from Brechin City, as their new faces.

Riley who, last season scored Brechin City's solitary Tennent's Scottish Cup goal (v Stenhousemuir), missed his only game of the season, to date, last Saturday and his absence coincided with Rose's worst performance of the season, a 1-0 cup defeat from Harthill Royal, currently bottom of the East Division One.

It's a fairly settled side which Bonnyrigg have been putting out this season, with international goalkeeper Steve Ellison one of something like five ever-presents in their line-up. Three players, Steve Laidlaw (5), Sean Grady (3) and Lee Bailey (2) have shared all this season's goals between them. Goals, however, haven't been easy to come by this season and this is a factor of some concern for manager Pat Glynn. After opening the season with three wins in four games, his side have failed to find the mark in six of the seven which followed.

Despite this paucity of goals, manager Glynn, although possibly pondering over starting Colin Bonner up front, is likely to stick by his proven scorers. There could be places in the line-up, however for Ally Reid and Craig McCartney who were both on the bench last week.

In the corresponding game at Tayport last season, Mark Craib (retired), Jon Mitchell (East Fife), Robbie Holden (Kinnoull), Mike Hankinson (Montrose) and Davie Evans (Raith Rovers) all featured in the home squad and it was substitute Evans who grabbed the vital injury time goal in 'Port's dramatic 1-0 win.

Their five replacements from the pool that day, Wemyss, Hunter, Elliott, Honeyman and Heenan all had a taste of the action against Kirrie last week. Heenan and Gareth Dailly had to be replaced at half-time, Kevin through sickness and Gareth through injury.

Dave Baikie put his players through their paces in a midweek bounce game and, if Allan Ramsay comes through this test unscathed, he could be in line for his first game of the season.

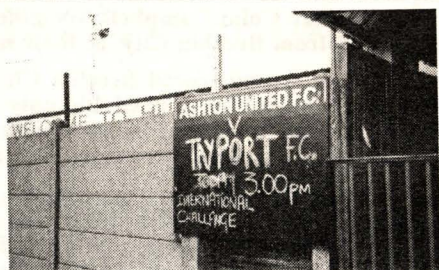

A couple of FA Cup results last Saturday would have been of interest to 'Port supporters. Two of the sides we have played on pre-season tours were in 4th qualifying round action, attempting to get into the 1st round proper. Lancaster City, whom we defeated 6-0 in 1993, won 1-0 at Dunston and pulled a plum 1st round tie at home v Cambridge United at the Giant Axe ground.



Ashton United whom we defeated in 1996 to win the Tameside International Challenge Cup, missed out on an attractive tie at home to Leyton Orient when they went down 2-1 to Grantham.

Port Supporter Andy Robertson (of Andy and Sandy fame) had an e.mail from a friend in Detroit, Steve Barnett. The e.mail was brief and to the point. "I'm coming over from Nov. 17 to Dec 3rd. Are the Juniors home any of these weekends?" Looks like it could mean a trip to Aberdeen for Steve.

It's understood that the colour element in the Port Prog could soon be coming to an end. Escalating costs have meant that the programme will return to a black and white issue.

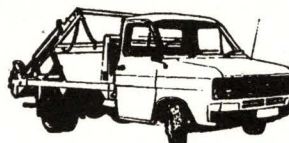
Participating clubs have been canvassed by the SJFA on their opinions with regard to the Super Cup, its format, timing etc.

THE BAIKER'S BIT

Last week's victory over Kirrie Thistle sees us advance to the last sixteen of the Fife / Tayside Redwood Leisure Trophy. What I'm attempting to get over is the fact that we were extremely fortunate to gain six points last term against a very good side in Bonnyrigg and that won't change today. I believe this game and a positive result can be of massive significance to our aspirations for the season. I believe we can achieve that victory, given we produce the attitude and workrate which our players know is required.

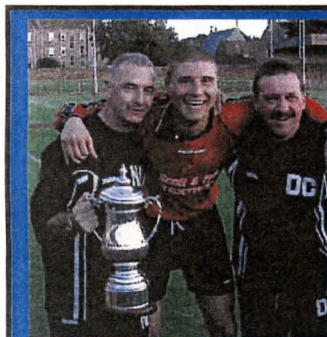

WHYTE and MACKAY SUPERLEAGUE PREVIEW

Lochee United will be hoping for a good attendance as they look to continue their good early season form with a win over inconsistent Bo'ness at Thomson Park.

It's a very tight league, although a glance at the league table shows that North End, Glenrothes and Hill of Beath cannot afford the current gap of six points between third bottom and safety at fourth bottom, to be extended.

That age shortchanged Davie, however, because the Reverend Bob told a packed assembly at the Crem that Davie had been born in 1914. 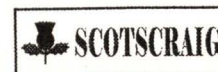

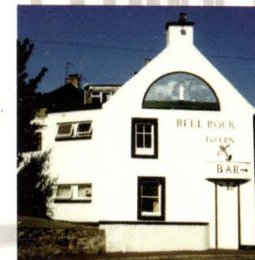
