WILSON'S XI

When the name Wilson's XI came out of the hat at the OVD Scottish Junior Cup 2nd round draw at Aberdeen on 19 October, it prompted the noisiest reaction of the day in the Aberdeen East End Juniors' Social Club. Understandable, given that the North Juniors' new boys had been drawn against the cup holders.

When the news hit the pubs in Tayport a few minutes later, the reaction was also understandable - but for a different reason. Who are Wilson's XI was the general response. Again understandable because, given the parochialism of media coverage of Junior football in all but The Sun, nobody but an anorak or a keen student of the Junior game would probably know much about the uniquely titled Wilson's XI.

What do we know about Wilson's? Like ourselves, Wilson's joined the Junior ranks via amateur football in 2000, winning promotion to the Premier Division of the North Juniors in their first season.

Wilson's XI were founded 20 years ago by Bob Wilson and his son - hence the name. However Bob and son are no longer involved with the club but the name remains. It is understood, however, that the Wilsons have now started another Wilson's XI in the Aberdeen amateurs.

Wilson's XI rose steadily through the amateur ranks becoming one of the top amateur sides in the North. Indeed in the club's final season in amateur soccer, the North Of Scotland Cup and the Millennium Trophy were both won.

However, it is in the club's first 3 years in the Juniors that they have really come of age playing out of Keith Park, the North's Premier Junior Stadium.

Wilson's XI quickly found their feet, gaining promotion to the Premier and narrowly losing in the Archibald Cup Final in their first season.

As one might expect, the turnover of players during this period has been vast in order to make the huge transition from amateur to Super Premier League. Evergreen defender Scott Bruce and striker Gary Mowatt are the only survivors from the amateur days.

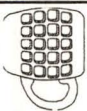
Off the pitch, however, the committee has remained firm, both in number and ambition. Indeed the club's close-knit style is proven by the fact that two past team managers remain, in General Manager Dave Ronald and Chairman Colin Cruickshank.

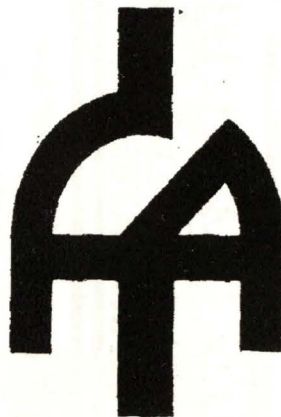

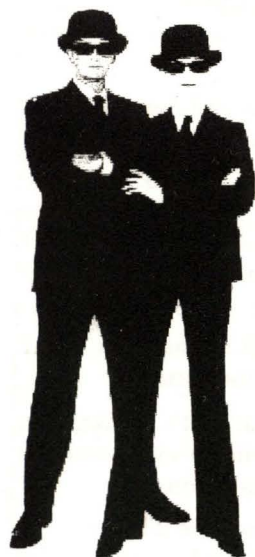
Hill of Beath's situation is becoming more critical by the week. A 4-1 defeat by Oakley saw them become anchored at the bottom.

WILSON'S LOOKING TO GO PLACES

The move to Keith Park has given Wilson's the impetus to move forward in the Junior game. Tayport fans and players will recall our recent visit to Wilson's stadium - the 2002 final of the NCR North / Tayside Cup when we demolished Sunnybank by 5-1.

The ground was the home to Bon Accord which went defunct in 1997 after 10 years in the North Juniors. A strange affair, this, considering the club had only just failed in a bid to join the Highland League in 1994. After winning two trophies and finishing the 1996/97 season third in the Premier Division, club chairman Martin Keith decided, because of business commitments, he could not carry on (whether the income from Bon Accord Glass would not be continuing either, is not documented). The Committee held a meeting, as committees do in moments of crisis, and decided that they could not carry on either and so the club went defunct.

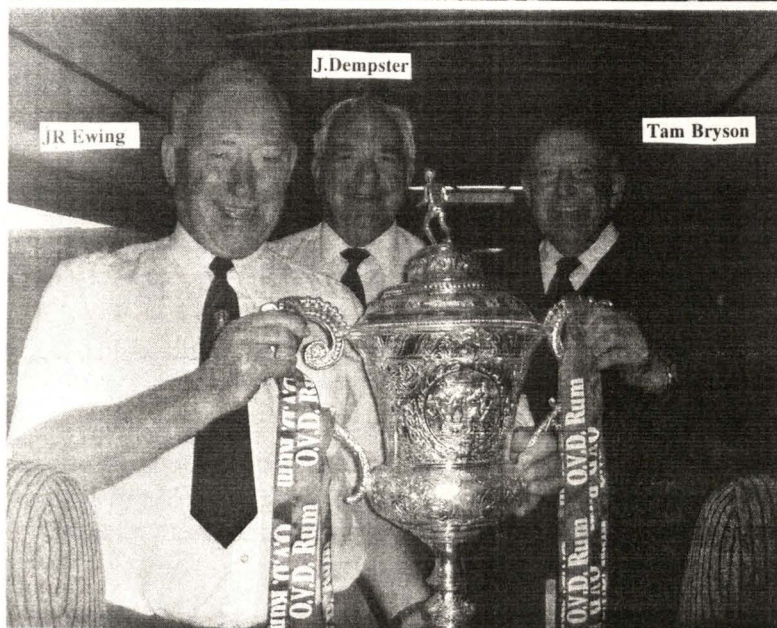
This was not long after Keith Park had been improved at the cost of £680,000 giving access to multi-sports facilities, a medical centre and a 263 seater stand. Wilson's eventually filled the gap and now rent Keith Park from Bon Accord Estates.

This prime venue has helped fulfil their ambitions and has been an important factor in recruiting management and players.

The recently appointed management team have a wealth of experience. Co-managers Kenny Taylor is ex-Cove Rangers, Banks o' Dee, Inverurie Locos and Mike Barclay was formerly with Locos, Peterhead, and Buckie Thistle. They are joined by coach Gary Giles, ex -Banks o' Dee. Playing experience has been added to the squad in goalie Mark Kerr ex-Forfar Athletic, Willie Watt ex-Ross County, Ritchie Clark ex-Inverurie Locos, Craig Leyden ex-Peterhead, Ally Brebner ex -Keith and Darren Lewis, also ex-Keith.

In addition, the club has a clutch of emerging youngsters such as Gordon Pirie and Steve Morrison, so the future looks rosy for a club who are quietly confident that they will continue to climb the ranks and compete within the top echelons of junior football.

The Scottish Junior Cup is one of the most prestigious trophies in this country, across all sports.

Things do seem to be moving towards that but, agonisingly slowly. We live in hope.

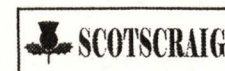

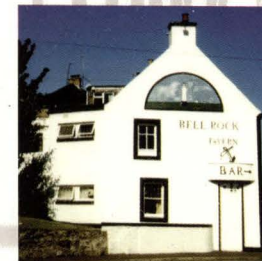
