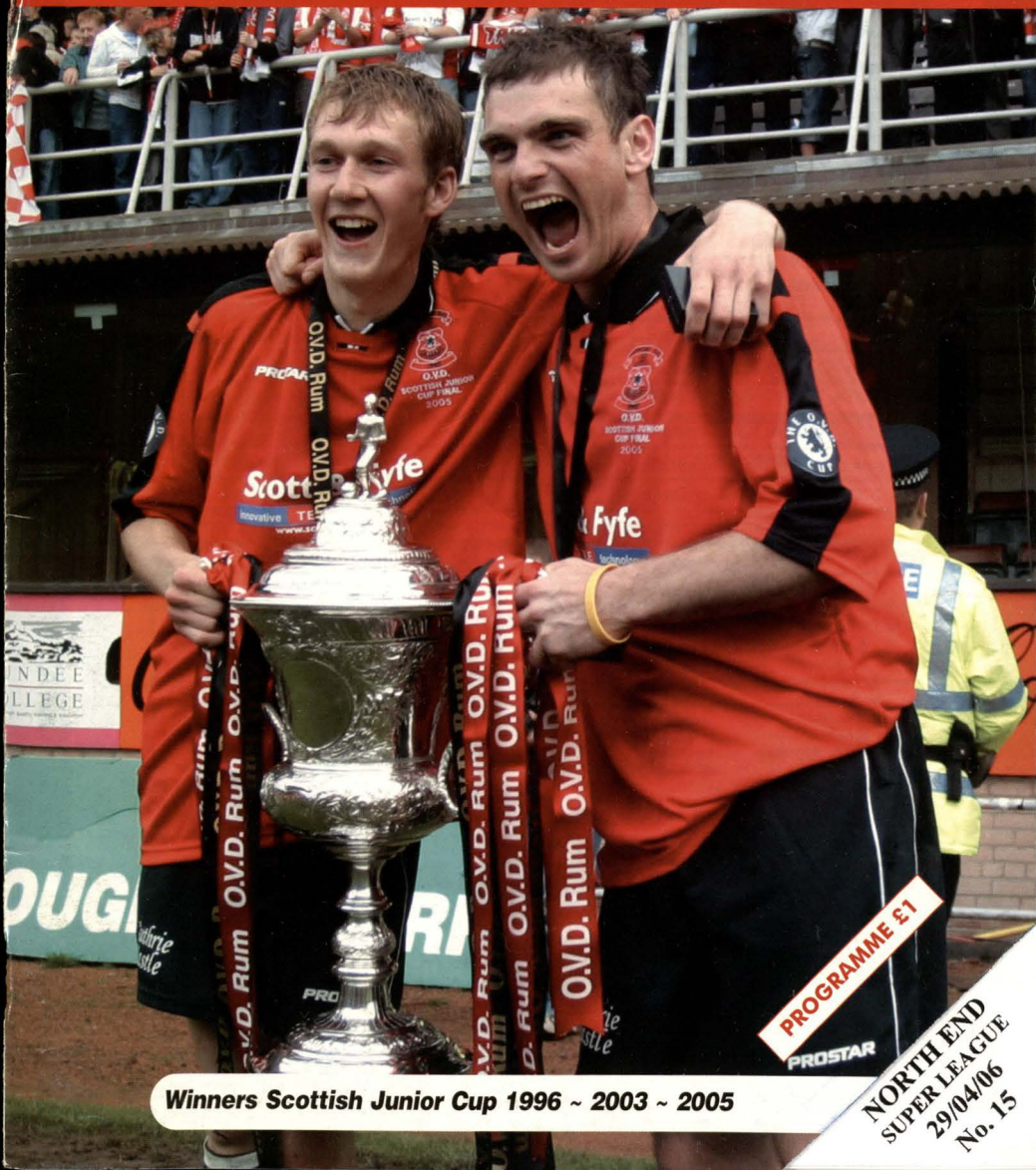

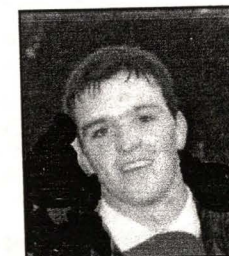
TAYPORT v DUNDEE NORTH END

With a mere nine goals and only three wins from their home programme in the Super League, it's astonishing to note that Tayport have topped the table for the past six months or so. Or maybe it's a measure of just how tight this championship has been once again. Only one issue has been decided and that's North End's relegation.

The Dokens finish their league programme today and can concentrate thereafter on their efforts to salvage something from their season with a Findlay Cup quarter final against Carnoustie or Blairgowrie. One thing is clear, however, and that's the fact that, despite their disappointing season, North End players' heads haven't gone down.

North End went down 2-0 to Scottish Cup finalists Bathgate at Creamery Park last Saturday but team boss Rab 'the legend' McLaren was chuffed to bits with his lads' performance - even in defeat and was quoted in the press as saying that it was the best his team has played all season.

So, it looks like it will be Tayport who will have to lift their spirit to get the points which would keep their title hopes flickering. There were a few aching hearts after last Friday and the measure of the players - and management - will be how the players respond to what must



have been a massive disappointment at Firhill last Friday. The fans, too, will have to stand up and be counted as their favourites kick off the rest of their season with three cups and the league title still on the horizon.

There's plenty of interest for 'Port fans in the North End camp with three of Tayport's Scottish Cup winning side of 1996 in the opposition party for today's game. Keeper Fraser Mann is the Dokens' goalie coach while cup winning skipper Sean Wilkie (pictured) and the man who set up the second goal in that final, Jim Henry (pictured right), are still pulling on a jersey.

We welcome match officials from the west this afternoon. Man in the middle is Scott Jamieson from Carlisle and he's assisted by Kenny Lowe from Wishaw and Jim Myles from Airdrie.

Keith Burgess writes.....

Good afternoon and a very warm welcome to both sets of supporters to today's important superleague match against Dundee North End.

Firstly can I say a huge thank you to all the Tayport supporters who made the long trip to Firhill last Friday night, and secondly can I apologise on behalf of the management, team and all the players for a very disappointing performance in the Scottish Cup semi final. We feel like we have let everyone down after getting off to the best possible start with Robbie Henderson scoring after 3 minutes of the game, then having a couple of near misses, but that was as good as it got. For some strange reason we looked a bit nervous and never really got into our stride for the rest of the match. Too many players had an off night and this aligned with the injuries that we sustained in the first half, made it an uphill struggle.

We are not making excuses, but when you take into account the injury list, Scott Peters - achilles problem; Brian Livie - deep head wound and concussion; Steven Stewart - bruised ribs; Allan Ramsay - severe tight hamstrings; Ross Gunnion - broken nose and Robbie Henderson's groin strain, all inflicted before half time, then maybe we can have a bit sympathy for our team's performance.



Sometimes in football your team can have an off day and that's exactly what happened to Tayport on Friday. Let's not forget all the fantastic results we had to reach the semi. And how well the team performed against Sauchie, Renfrew, and that great afternoon down at Arthurlie, which will go down as one of the best results in our history.

So let's just lick our wounds, roll up our sleeves, and get on with the rest of the season, as there is still plenty to play for, the league title and three other cups.

Today is the first of three remaining league matches, all of which I think that we must win to have any chance of lifting the title. Dundee North End will come to the Canniepairt with one thing on their minds and that will be to put one over on us this afternoon as they have nothing to lose and will be keen to rack up as many points as they can as the season comes to a close.

Stewart, Derek, Norrie and myself must make sure the team approach this game positively and have a desire to play well and forget about Friday, as we look to take all 3 points to keep us at the top of the league.

There will be a few changes to our line up, due to injuries, but make no mistake, the guys who come in will be out to show how hungry we still are for success in all our remaining games.

Your support is vital to us today and the weeks to follow, so let's all pull together and show that Tayport FC and their fans are still the best in Scotland.

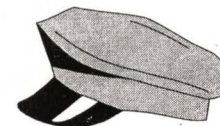

The Whyte & Mackay Super League Championship is moving rapidly to its conclusion as the effect of midweek games starts to alter the standings on an increasingly regular basis.

Basically Bathgate, with six games remaining, can only lose the title. If Tayport can win today, then the pressure is still on Bathgate to deliver victories in the run in. The league and cup double is in their sights and it's hard to see them slipping up.

The Scottish Cup finalists have Arniston at Gorebridge today and, whereas Thistle will have something left in the tank for the title run-in, there's no such luxury for Rangers, whose Super League future will be decidedly rocky if they can't pick up the points today. In fact, anything less than full points this afternoon and the Arnie coffin lid is pretty well nailed down.

Lochee United took a major step to a respectable league placing, given that they are defending champions, with a 2-0 win over Carnoustie on Wednesday past, a result which is likely to see the Gowfers finish their season just above the relegation zone.

At Thomson Park this afternoon, Lochee entertain Bo'ness and a win there would guarantee Bo'ness's top league status. Bo'ness, who have just appointed former Sauchie and Camelon boss Willie Irvine as their new manager, is a club currently in some turmoil. As if the registration issue which cost them their Scottish Cup chance wasn't enough, the committee have been unable to rid themselves of the hooligan element which follows then to high profile games.

The committee, at their wits end, called a public meeting in Bo'ness Academy this week and were greatly heartened by a turnout of 250 townspeople, all determined to find a solution to rid the club of this unwanted baggage. We wish them well.

Both these clubs will be looking for the result from Glenrothes, where the home side are scrapping for their survival against an underperforming Linlithgow Rose. A defeat for Glens and a few clubs can breathe a little easier.

A win for Hill of Beath, at home to Bonnyrigg Rose, depending on results elsewhere, could see the Keir's Park club top the table tonight.

The pain of defeat is what makes the joy of victory all the sweeter, although there was still no escaping the feelings of disappointment last Friday night. For all connected with the club, the despondency lasted several days, but now is the time to bounce back and today's match against North End represents an opportunity to do just that.

The players will certainly be keen to get the events of Firhill out of their system. Ironically, it had started so well. Robbie Henderson's close-range finish, after Steven Stewart had flicked on a Ross Gunnion throw, gave 'Port a fourth minute lead and more half-chances would follow.

Unfortunately, there would be no second goal for the relatively small band of Tayport fans to cheer. Robbie came close with a couple of efforts, one a diving header, then he also had a decent shout for a penalty.

At the other end, Auchinleck hit the bar with a piledriver from distance, but, otherwise, didn't really threaten. Perhaps due to the dreadful condition of the playing surface, neither team could claim to be at the top of their game, yet 'Port were in a promising position going into the break.

Best not to dwell on it, but not much went right after the interval and 'Bot deserved their 70th minute equaliser. Thereafter, the Ayrshire men sensed victory and veteran Stevie Mallan notched the winner during the first period of extra-time.

So, that's the end of Tayport's OVD Cup adventure. Their Scottish Junior Cup story, however, has many more chapters still to write. This season's league campaign isn't over either. Scott Peters popped up with a last-ditch header at Creamery Park a few weeks ago, which keeps 'Port in the title hunt. Two up through Barry McNaughton and Peters's first strike of the afternoon, the Canniepairt outfit seemed to be cruising to the points, only for Bathgate's two substitutes to draw them level. The character in the Tayport ranks shone through, though, and, as a result, there remains more than a glimmer of hope.

Another recent fixture was the Redwood Leisure quarter-final tie at Laing Park. Bryan Duell was gifted an early opener, Carnoustie veteran Ralph Brand equalised in the second half, then Steven Stewart edged Tayport back into the lead. The icing on the cake was the goal for Ronnie Kenneth, who came off the bench to score with a deft touch, a goal which the hitman must have really enjoyed.

Hopefully, the whole squad can enjoy the winning feeling again this afternoon and a favourable result from Gorebridge wouldn't go amiss. Let's hope things go Tayport's way this weekend.

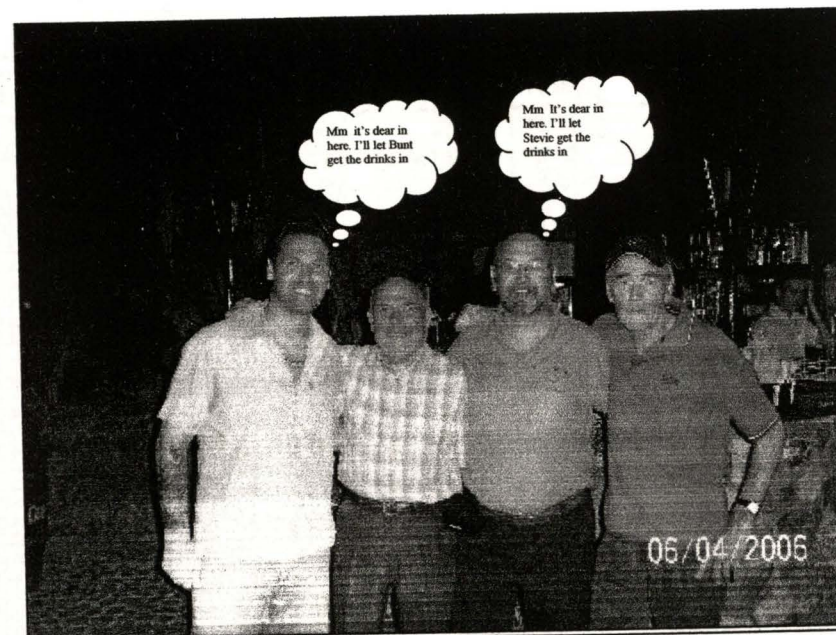

Did You Know ?

Tayport FC has played matches in all the Senior grounds in Tayside and Fife -with the exception of East End Park Dunfermline. That's ten in total. Firhill, scene of last Friday's semi-final is one of 7 other Senior grounds on which we've played as a Junior club. Can you name them?

Friday's defeat at Firhill was Tayport's first in 34 Scottish Junior Cup ties stretching back exactly five years.

In 16 years of competition, in 112 ties, Tayport has played against 58 of the 164 of the SJFA's member clubs. The biggest defeat remains 4-1 by Pollok in our first season.

The team we've played most? Cumnock, on five occasions, one of which was replay. Four wins, then, v Cumnock and three v Linlithgow, Arniston, Renfrew, Arthurlie, Forfar Albion. Only teams we have not beaten? Shotts, Armadale, Whitburn and Glenafton, although we did eliminate them on penalties on one occasion

The Firhill playing surface came in for some criticism on Friday. Not real surprise that it wasn't in pristine condition when you consider the amount of games played on it in nine days. To celebrate the occasion there's a reunion in the Tayport Arms on Saturday 13th May 2006 at 7.30pm. Guests providing tributes at a fairly informal gathering will be Referee John Rowbotham, Former East Region FA secretary Jock Myles and Dave Baikie.

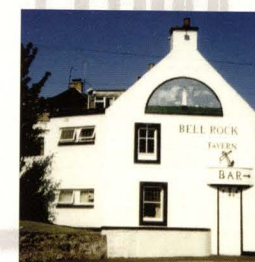
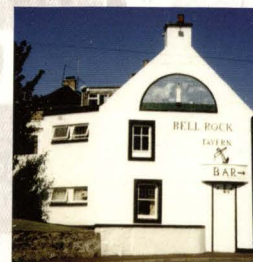

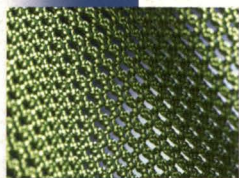
