

TAYPORT v FAULDHOUSE UNITED

FAULDHOUSE PAY THEIR FIRST EVER VISIT TO CANNIEPAIRT

The East of Scotland Cup hasn't been the most successful of competitions for Tayport since they first entered three seasons ago. First season it was a shock exit at the first hurdle, beaten 1-0 by the now defunct Elmwood and last season it was elimination on penalties by eventual finalists Hill of Beath after conceding two goals in stoppage time. At least this season Tayport got past the first hurdle with a 4-1 win over Penicuik.

Fauldhouse have contested the competition since the club was founded in 1919 but their only successes in that time have been back to back wins over sixty years ago in 1945 and 1946. League success has been more recent however, with an east region title in 1993 and division two championships in 1997 & 2002.

Fauldhouse, situated just inside the West Lothian boundary with Lanarkshire, haven't yet tasted Super League football. When the leagues were revamped last season they missed out on a Premier spot by two points. The Premier Division is the target for this season and, although it is possible for United to get there if they go on a winning run, they have left themselves with a lot to do.

Fauldhouse's only meetings with a Super League club to date this season were both with Whitburn in the League Cup back in August. In the first game Whitburn won 2-1 and in the return at the end of that month finished 1-1 at Park View.

In a season in which goals have been plentiful, one of Fauldhouse's best results was at Arbroath SC in the 1st Round of this competition when the strong going SC were beaten 4-1 on their own patch. Chic Pearson (2), Ross McGeachie and Chris Dolan did the damage that day. There were another four goals last Saturday when Dunbar United were put to the sword in the League. Dolan, Mark McGarty, Scott Murphy and new signing Kieran Bryce shared the goals.

Tayport put the disappointment of the Hill of Beath defeat behind them and picked up two good wins in successive weeks at home to Linlithgow and away to Bathgate, so they will be looking to maintain that form this afternoon. Murray Urquhart is a week away from fitness but otherwise Tayport should have a full, although small, pool from which to select. Webster and McDowell, both on as substitutes last week, could find a place in the starting XI. The tie will go straight to penalty kicks if all square after 90 minutes.

You can't beat a bit of nostalgia to get the chat going and that's what happened last weekend when 'Blether with Brown' in the **Evening Telegraph** (Friday 30 March) devoted an entire page to the week in May 1978 during which Tayport and Auchterhouse met twice in a Midlands Amateur FA league decider and the Gray Trophy final.

The feature was on the back of an earlier article prompted by North American reader [on the web] Bob McMahon, a member of that season's Tayport squad. Bob emigrated to Canada not long afterwards and is now based in Winnipeg where he's Fox Soccer TV's top football pundit. Of the thirty odd guys in the pic of the Tayport squad which illustrated the article, the vast majority are still residing locally, so the long hair and kipper ties no doubt provided a few chuckles over the weekend.

Friday's **Edinburgh Evening News'** Junior preview not surprisingly featured the Linlithgow v Bo'ness Super League derby. Reporter Mark Bonthrone pointed out that Rose's defeat at Tayport the previous week was the first time they had failed to take something from a game since September. Striker Gordon Herd hoped 'Tayport is the kick up the backside that we needed'.

Saturday's **Scottish Sun** featured a lengthy interview with Bathgate skipper Graeme Love in advance of Tayport's visit to Creamery Park. Graeme compared Tayport's season with that of Bathgate, both clubs not getting off to the best of starts and having been hit with a few injuries.

Friday's **Fife Herald** had a pic of Grant Paterson being presented with a memento marking the occasion of his 800th game (somebody might have got him to wear a strip rather than a t shirt!) and also a first Herald pic of the managerial team of Messrs Conway and Gilzean presenting the Karen Dewar Garden cheque to Councillor Taylor.

Monday's **Courier** announced that former Lochee United and Montrose boss Eddie Wolecki would be joining up at Strathmore Park to 'work alongside me...and help us get over the finishing line [North Division Championship]', according to Forfar West End manager Jim Finlayson.

The Courier also pointed out a results blunder, with the Bathgate v Tayport score being sent to agencies as 1-0 to Bathgate. Radio Tay announced the wrong score and even the bingo session at Scotscraig Bowling Club was interrupted to announce the disappointing news from West Lothian. Fortunately Maggot was playing bingo and had earlier accessed the Newsline and was able to confirm that Tayport had indeed won and was therefore able to correct the caller!

The **Evening Telegraph** on Monday had a pic which captured the celebrations as Tayport's scorer v Bathgate, Derek Wemyss, was mobbed by his delighted teammates. According to the **Tele**, Carnoustie's defeat at Downfield was the shock of the day. Certainly was.

Monday's **Edinburgh Evening News** praised the 'two pieces of sublime skill' from Brian Carrigan which gave Linlithgow their 2-1 win over Bo'ness. Carrigan's performance prompted an outburst from Rose manager Jim Sinnet who was bemused by the fact that Carrigan wasn't in the Scottish Juniors' squad for Ireland later this month.

Said Sinnet of the player who cost Stockport £150,000 from Clyde not so very long ago, '....everybody knows he is good enough for Scotland Juniors, except for [Scotland manager] Jim O'Donnell, it seems. 'If he doesn't get picked before they go to Ireland, I'll certainly have a few things to say to him [O'Donnell]. We've had our arguments about this situation already and as far as I'm concerned Brian Carrigan is the best juniors player in Scotland.

FROM THE ARCHIVES 25 YEARS AGO - APRIL 1982



Exactly quarter of a century ago this weekend, Tayport FC won the Jacques Vandebosch International Tournament in Ougree, Liege, Belgium.

Tayport beat DC Cointe 2-1 (Ian Howe 2) in the 1st game, the Italians from Roana 1-0 in the 2nd game (Phil Smith) to qualify for the final which was won 4-0 (Kevin Murphy 3, Alan Harte) against the host club AC Ougree. Tayport also collected the awards for best defence, player of the tournament (Alan Harte) and young player of the tournament (Phil Smith)


And, would you believe it, we are expecting a party from the very same AC Ougree club at this afternoon's game. AC Ougree's party arrived this morning on the Rosyth ferry for a few days holiday in Scotland, based in Dundee.

The clubs first forged links in 1973 when Tayport FC accepted an invitation to play in Ougree's international tournament. In the 34 years since, Tayport have been back to Belgium many times and the Belgians have travelled to Scotland on a number of occasions, most notably to play in our own international tournaments in the 80s.

Checking the archives, we learn that the 1982 trip cost £110 per person and the party of 31 players and others left Tayport for London Heathrow by Moffat & Williamson coach at 5.30am on Friday 9 April 1982 to catch a Sabena flight to Liege. It is recalled that the return flight from Liege on the Tuesday morning to Heathrow was at 7.35am from a snow covered airfield. Certain players arrived at the airport direct from the disco where the celebrations had gone on thoughout the night!


