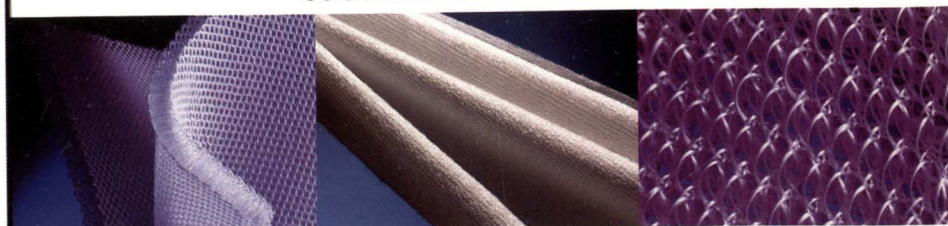

# TODAY'S GAME

*Citylink* SCOTTISH CUP

**TAYPORT v CARNOUSTIE PANMURE**

Tayport and the Gowfers have been regular sparring partners for the past eighteen years and during this time, of the many contests, four have stuck out as top of the bill events.

The 5th round Scottish Cup meeting on the Canniepairt in 1995 which Tayport won 1-0, as they embarked on a ten year spell during which the club dominated the Junior game; the deciding game to determine which club would win the last ever Tayside League title. Tayport won 3-0; the Scottish Cup Final of 2004 which Carnoustie won in a penalty shoot-out after a 0-0 draw; The fourth is this afternoon's 3rd round replayed tie.

The last two weeks have effectively been a warm-up for today's deciding event. Both clubs will reckon they could have won it last week. Tayport edged the possession and the chances but at 2-0 up with 20 mins to go and dusk rapidly gathering, few could have blamed the Angus team if they were already looking forward to the 4th round draw.

Football being the game it is, and the fat lady not having sung, the tie wasn't over and two late goals earned Tayport another chance.

Both defences were culpable at the loss of the goals, but with injuries restricting selection opportunities in both camps, there are unlikely to be many changes in that department. Last Saturday's line-ups, compared with the previous week, showed only one change in either squad. Carnoustie had veteran Dougie Craig on the bench in place of Daryn Smith, while Tayport preferred Kevin Kelly to Brian Livie to start in left midfield.

Carnoustie could have some of their absentees back in contention for a place if Ian Flaherty and George O'Boyle decide to freshen up the starting line-up. Tayport will still be without Dean Rennie, Chris Webster and Steven McAllister but talisman Derek Wemyss was looking good in training this week and a surprise return to action for the defender could be on the cards.

If the sides are level at 90 minutes, it's straight into a penalty shoot-out.

There's a change of referee and assistants this weeks with Craig Marshall replacing Neil Watters as the man in the middle.

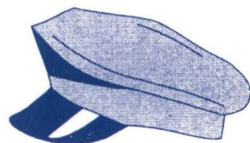

Ultimately it will be a case of third time lucky for one team this afternoon, as, after two successive draws between Tayport and Carnoustie, a winner will emerge and one team will have exited the Citylink Scottish Junior Cup.

Probably best that that winner does not come via the lottery of a penalty shoot-out, but, given events of the last two Saturdays the prospect of spot kicks is looming. When the pair met a fortnight ago, it was on East Super League duty. The Gowfers drew first blood, courtesy of a Jon Voigt header, on 38 minutes.

'Port were playing reasonably well, though, and should have equalised ten minutes into the second half. Although Martin Maher found the net, after pouncing on slackness in the home defence, an intervening touch from Brian Craik saw the linesman raise the offside flag. Moments later, however, Craik unleashed a screaming shot from a considerable distance and, out of the blue, Tayport were level. Both outfits had chances to win the game, but honours ended even.

So, back to Laing Park last weekend, for the Scottish Cup tie. Again, Carnoustie were first on the scoresheet, albeit after a promising start from their visitors. Goals in each half, from Gary Bollan and Jim Collier, compounded by a missed penalty from Roberto Morris, had Tayport staring at defeat.

With around quarter of an hour remaining, 'Port launched a determined comeback and Kevin Kelly, followed by Brian Craik, notched the all-important goals, setting up today's third round replay. Perhaps Frank Conway's charges can net first, this time out, and test Carnoustie's resolve.

Tayport did score first when last on the Canniepairt, Ronnie Kenneth steering home what proved to be the winner, when Hill o'Beath visited on league business. Recalling anything else from that fixture is not easy, as, since then, Carnoustie have dominated the thoughts of the 'Port camp.

In fact, it will be strange to see different opposition next Saturday. Mind you, the Gowfers haven't yet been to the Canniepairt for the Super League match!

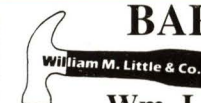

## FROM THE MANAGEMENT

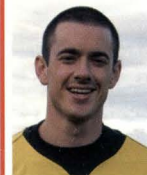

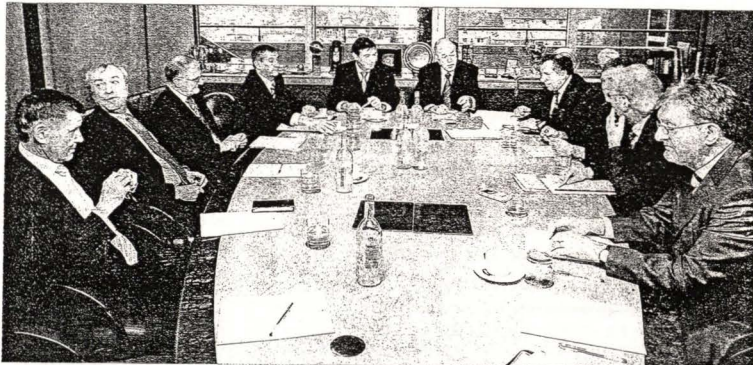

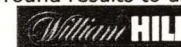

# 'PORT IN QUARTER FINALS

Tayport's bid for Scottish Cup glory continues after claiming a place in the quarter finals at the expense of local rivals, Carnoustie.

For the second round in succession, Tayport finished the tie with 10 men — losing Miller five minutes after the interval for a second bookable offence.

Carnoustie played out the last three minutes of the match in a similar depleted manner after Richardson picked up a second caution in a match that was never over-physical.

From early in the match, Tayport always looked the most likely to find the net, and after a jittery opening spell Mackay, returning after several weeks' absence through injury, was first to have a go with a shot on the turn which flew inches past.

Visiting 'keeper, Anderson, made an early impression, blocking from Mackay and then diving to punch clear a tempting Stewart cross.

Carnoustie replied with a cross into the danger area by Craik which Nicolson cleared only as far as Ramsay, whose dipping effort wasn't far over.

Tayport ended the first half still seeking the elusive opening goal and Stewart wasn't far away with a shot just past the junction of post and bar

that Devine, clear through, fired straight into Anderson's arms.

Before Miller's 50th minute dismissal, after an exchange with Richardson, Paterson had Anderson back in action as he dived to clutch the full back's effort. As Tayport re-shuffled to compensate for the absence of Miller, Carnoustie sought to make the extra man count but, in quick succession, Robertson scooped the ball high from a good position and then striker Kelly set up his fullback namesake whose effort was well wide of the target.

Tayport then settled to enjoy their best spell of the match. An incisive run down the left by Paterson resulted in a ball inside to Hunter and his superbly struck shot brought out a flying save from Anderson. From the corner, Mackay's header was only inches over.

Stewart then pushed the ball forward to Mackay and once more Anderson was equal to a well-struck shot.

In 72 minutes the home support erupted as 'Port went ahead. Devine carried the ball deep into the 18-yard box and as he was dispossessed, the ball broke and Stewart was first to it to beat Anderson from close in.

MacKay almost put the icing on the cake when, in the dying minutes, his 25 yard drive flashed narrowly past.

Tomorrow, Tayport return to league duties when Kirrie Thistle are visitors to the Canniepairt in an A.T. and T. League Division One match, kick-off 2.30pm.

While Tayport were on cup duty last week, championship rivals St Joseph's were dropping two points in a league match at Glenesk Park, so 'Port will be keen to maintain their lead at the top with a convincing victory over relegation-haunted Thistle.

The draw for the quarter-finals of the OVD Scottish Cup is scheduled for Sunday afternoon on ITV's Scotsport.

## Football fans run amok in Tayport

A TAYPORT publican claimed this week that football supporters "ran amok" through the town before and after Saturday's Scottish Junior Cup tie.

Violence erupted in Jim Rogers' Tayport Arms pub as rival football fans fought with each other following Carnoustie Panmure's 1-0 defeat at the hands of Tayport Juniors in the fifth round of the cup.

Tumblers were broken and the pub's windows were smashed as fans clashed.

As a result, two Tayport men had to be taken to Dundee Royal Infirmary for treatment to facial injuries,

although both were later discharged.

However, Mr Rogers said trouble had been brewing throughout the day: "They were kicking and climbing on top of cars in Nelson Street before the match and even tried to overturn a milk van. They just ran amok through the town."

Fife Police said this week that apart from the disturbance at the Tayport Arms, no other incidents relative to the match had been reported to them.

Tayport Juniors' Secretary, Albert Oswald, said that police had been notified in advance that the match was taking place and two police-

men were present at the ground.

He added that he had only heard of the disturbance at the Tayport Arms, following which around 40 Carnoustie supporters were stopped at the Tay Road Bridge tolls and escorted to police headquarters in West Bell Street, Dundee.

Enquiries were carried out on board the bus regarding the disturbance in Tayport, but no arrests were made and the bus was allowed to continue its journey back to Carnoustie.

A police spokesman confirmed that enquiries were continuing in the Carnoustie area.

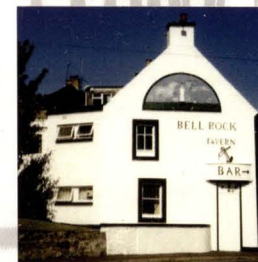
