TAYPORT v HILL OF BEATH

Although, Kelty, Glenrothes and Oakley have had their successes, it's the two sides here this afternoon who have dominated Junior football in the Kingdom in modern times.

Games between Haws and 'Port have invariably been closely fought encounters, with the notable exception of Tayport's 5-0 win at Keir's Park in the inaugural Super League season. Tayport's hero that afternoon was hat trickster Barry McNaughton and the midfielder is likely to be in the line-up today as the home team looks to keep some space between themselves and Haws, as both sides desperately try to keep in touch with the top of the table.

So tight is the league at the moment, that defeat for any club in the league, bar Bonnyrigg, brings the danger of being drawn into the relegation zone. Hill of Beath will know a win by a single goal margin today would see them draw level with Tayport both on points and goal difference with, crucially, three games in hand. When the clubs met earlier this season, a goal from Michael Stuart, who played under Willie Garner and Jim Moffat at Forfar Athletic last season, was sufficient to keep the points at Keir's Park.

Hill of Beath are the form team in the league at present, unbeaten in their last four Super League matches. Although managing only five goals at home, they have found their opponents' net in all but one of their league games on the road. Tayport's good run since the turn of the year came unstuck against Glenrothes here two weeks ago and the players will be desperate to atone for that disappointment.

It will be a much changed squad who turn out for Haws today, with six players in the sixteen that day having moved on. Kenny Martin went to Fauldhouse, Callum Bissett to Dundonald, Graham Baird to Broxburn, Gavin Gray and Colin Mullen have been released and Alan Creer, signed in January from Kilsyth Rangers, has replaced Joe Houston in goal and has yet to be on a losing side. Back in Haws colours, however, is striker Andy Roberts from Whitburn and the experienced striker was on the mark last Saturday at Forfar WE. Returning to the Canniepairt for the first time since his close season transfer to this afternoon's visitors, is left back Andy Lawson.

Tayport will still be without the suspended Ronnie Kenneth and also broken foot victim Chris Webster who is unlikely to play again this season. Brian Livie and Derek Wemyss were late withdrawals last week but both should be back in action today. New signing Dean Wallace got 15 mins at Linlithgow last week but is again likely to start on the bench.

DUNMORE'S ANGLE

A fortnight to forget for Tayport

The last two matches have brought disappointing outcomes for Tayport. After a sequence of very encouraging results around the turn of the year, 'Port have now slipped to two consecutive East Super League defeats.

Fife rivals Glenrothes visited the Canniepairt a fortnight ago and left with all three points, much to the frustration of the home side. The concession of a free kick, after quarter of an hour, was the first mistake, with Chris Burt expertly curling the ball into the net to give the Glens the advantage.

Midway through the half, Ronnie Kenneth became embroiled in an off-the-ball incident, earning him a red card and a two-match ban. In the short-term, his team was left to battle the numerical disadvantage and this they did, admirably.

Indeed, 'Port equalised on 36 minutes, when Murray Urquhart headed home a Stefan Elvin cross. In the second half, Glenrothes probably had the better of the chances, but, just when it looked like the hosts would escape with a draw, a poor back-header let substitute Sam Buchan in to score and seal victory for the Glens.

Then, last weekend, Willie Garner's men travelled to Linlithgow, minus two central defenders in Brian Livie and Derek Wemyss, and also without the suspended Kenneth. The Rosie Posie, on the other hand, seemed in fine fettle. They had had a dreadful run of results, but with senior players in temporary charge of proceedings, there was a buzz around Prestonfield.

A cracking goal from full-back Craig McEwan, on the stroke of half-time, further lifted their spirits and, after the interval, Rose netted twice more. Tommy Coyne jnr, son of the former Dundee United, Dundee and Celtic striker, did the damage on both occasions, his first being a particularly impressive finish.

So, a fortnight to forget and an opportunity now for Tayport to get back on track, against Hill of Beath, this afternoon. As ever, the Haws will be stubborn opponents and an intriguing afternoon is in prospect.

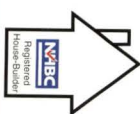

FROM THE ARCHIVES - 40 YEARS AGO

This afternoon we look at the players who represented the club in March 1969. It was the year in which man - Neil Armstrong - first walked on the moon, although the then Tayport Provost, Jim Pow, at the opening of President Grant Place in the town, infamously pointed out that Tayport had an Armstrong who has been out of this world for years, in reference to local soldier of fortune, Jocky Armstrong. It was also the month in which the Kray Brothers received life sentences for gangland murder, Concorde made its maiden flight, the film 'Krakatoa, East of Java' was released and 'Bad Moon Rising' by Creedence Clearwater Revival was heading for the top of the charts.

Tayport FC, a wholly amateur club at that time, was running two teams, both playing on the East Common where the changing room, rented from the Town Council, was a primitive wooden hut, with gas light and a multi purpose Belfast sink. The 1st XI was heading for the Midlands Second Division championship while the 2nd XI was middle of the table Alliance Division 2.

The 1st XI's line-up (2-3-5) on 8 March 1969 was Derek White; Walter Kemp and Eddie Stewart; Ronnie Laing, Jim Mathers and Richard Redpath; Abby Oswald, Andy Johnstone, Ian White, George Ritchie and Doug Henderson. Ian Bell was substitute. Tayport won 7-0 at home v Tay Valley FC with goals from Johnstone (3), Oswald (2), Redpath and I. White). 40 years on, maybe, but four of that line-up were amongst the Port Support at Linlithgow last week.

The 1st XI had no game on 15 March 1969, but the Alliance XI was at home that day to RMS Condor, winning 3-2. Line-up (2-3-5) was Andy Horan; Ian Mathers and Jimmy Foulis; Ronnie Redpath, Freddie Janssen and Derek McRobbie; George Bryson, Davie Ure, Andy 'Acker' Fraser, Maurice Flynn and Raymond White; Stan Cowe was substitute. White (2) and Fraser scored the goals.

That season in the Juniors, Cambuslang Rangers beat Kirkintilloch Rob Roy 1-0 at Hampden before a crowd of 32,524 to lift the Scottish Junior Cup.
