ACA SUPER LEAGUE TAYPORT v LOCHEE UNITED

Tayport's recent games have variously been described as 'crucial', 'vital', 'must-win', 'six pointers' and the like. If the first of these games was so described, then the importance of today's game cannot be understated.

Tayport, without a win this year, only 2 points from seven games, five goals scored. Indeed we are in the midst of the club's worst run of results...ever. Damning statistics which have seen us plummet into a drop spot.

Fourteen goals lost in seven games isn't too damning a statistic, but it is, when one considers many of those goals lost have been cheaply conceded. That's maybe part of the problem. Cheaply conceded goals have been giving us too many mountains to climb and this, allied to missing chances has put us in a perilous position.

Positives? There have been a few. Bar the dreadful performance in the Camelon game, the displays have generally been spirited and on several occasions have probably deserved greater reward. The unlucky breaks, not getting the rub of the green etc usually balance themselves out, therefore we may be due a change of fortune in that respect. This would certainly help, as would the avoidance of totally unnecessary yellow cards issued for dissent, thus putting us at greater risk of finishing a game a man short.

In a Super League which is still wide open and could well go to the wire at both ends of the table, Lochee have quietly emerged as championship dark horses and potentially are only two points off the top of the table. There is, therefore, plenty incentive for today's visitors. Lochee's form was a bit chequered earlier in the season but Paul Ritchie, Ray McKinnon's successor as manager, now seems to have put his own mark on the team. Most recent acquisition is defender Phil McGuire (31), who played over 200 games for Aberdeen prior to moving to Doncaster Rovers and Dunfermline Athletic amongst others.

His trialist replacement had a splendid game on Wednesday but Neil Ferrie will be back in the Tayport goal, Ross Gunnion, fit again, is likely to be amongst the changes in the Tayport line-up and there is also the possibility that Derek Wemyss could be back in action.

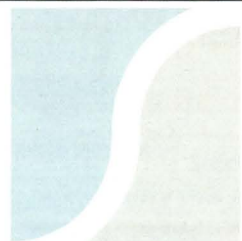

Lochee United's Tayport connections

Thomson Park and Canniepairt are only seven miles apart, therefore it's not surprising that there are current players and management with links to both clubs.

Lochee's Assistant Manager **Frank Conway** had a spell as joint-manager at Tayport with Ian Gilzean, the current Carnoustie boss.

Gary Middleton, whilst at Tayport, hit one of the goals which ended Lochee United's Scottish Cup dream at Tannadice in 2005. Gary is currently up for transfer but there have been no takers for the striker's signature, probably frightened off by the price tag as he's still under contract at Thomson Park

Full back **Joe Pepper** was a popular player with the Tayport fans during his spell at the Canniepairt, playing 37 games between 2008 and 2010 before moving to Lochee during last close season

Andy Bell, the veteran physio who celebrates his 77th birthday next week, had a number of years as Tayport physio during the 1990s

Central defender **Jon Thompson** appeared as a trialist for Tayport in the Super Cup v Linlithgow back in July 2003.

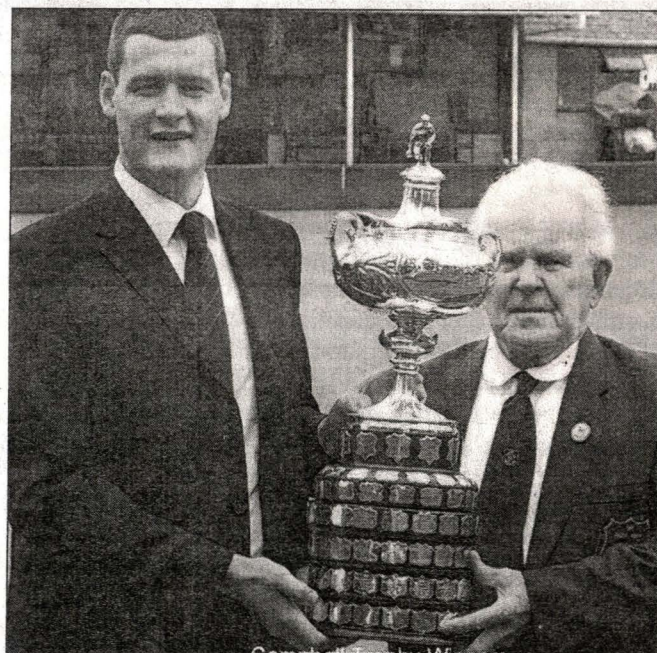
Midfielder **Jayson Alexander** also appeared as a trialist for Port in a pre season friendly in 2009/10 after moving to study in Dundee

Lochee United have certainly had their share of the headlines this year thanks to helping out sanction hit Dundee FC. The Dark Blues' situation necessitated the use of trialists and the Im Bru SFL side turned to Lochee's Craig Robertson and the Lochee man's impressive performances for the Dens Park club did the image of the Junior game no harm at all.

Then came the somewhat bizarre case of Jake Hyde who arrived in Dundee having most recently played in the English Conference with Hayes & Yeading FC. International transfer rules prevented Hyde from signing for Dundee FC but the ruling was circumvented by the player signing for Lochee United and then going on loan to Dundee. After his permitted three trialist games with Dundee, he would have reverted to Lochee but in stepped Dunfermline Athletic to sign him as an amateur until the end of the season. So, no Jake Hyde in the Lochee squad this afternoon. In theory all this could have happened without Hyde ever having set foot in Lochee, never mind Thomson Park. Funny game, football

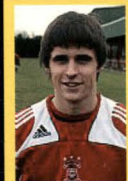
