

ASK THE MANAGER

Following his appointment John McGlashan has invited questions from the 'Port Support. Here are a couple of questions and answers so far:

Scott Ferguson - Since the departure of Brian Craik many moons ago Tayport have missed his presence and goal scoring ability up front. Will the new management address this problem which has been evident this season where they have failed to hold the ball up front and score goals. It is clear that in midfield for many seasons Tayport have also missed a central midfielder who has the ability to win balls, make simple passes and do the dirty side of the game. The team also requires an out and out centre half who does the basics, wins headers, clear the lines and can read the game. There you have it the backbone of the team, a straight line from back to front from which the team is structured around. Three players which are required and have been needed for sometime. Clearly a new manager looks to bring in his own players when possible but does John agree and Paul will certainly know what I am meaning having played with Tayport when they had all of the above?

JMcG - Thanks for your question Scott. The first priority for any incoming manager is to assess the present squad and then look to improve the areas that need strengthening. If you look at any successful team they do indeed, as you suggest, have a strong spine running throughout the team.

However, before dissecting the present squad it is worth remembering that we were only promoted last season and it's a steep learning curve in the Super league especially for some of the younger players. If we manage to avoid relegation then I can guarantee that next season these young players will be better equipped and less naive and some of the narrow defeats experienced this season will be draws and draws may well end up as victories.

Of course, it would be folly to suggest that I have no plans to bring in some new players for the next season. However, the players here at the moment are in pole position to impress me. I have no interest in how they played before I arrived, so the ball is firmly in their court. So far, to a man, they have responded in the right manner and Paul and I have been delighted with their enthusiasm to train hard and their steely determination to stay in this league.

Tayport must always be in the market to attract the better players from our region and I will work tirelessly to ensure that players who I believe will improve our squad are approached and spoken to. No stone will be left unturned. However, and this is something that I will never compromise on, any player who is motivated by money will never be part of any team I am part of.

Don't get me wrong, I believe in rewarding success and building in incentives that can be be achieved but I cannot work with a player who touts himself only to the highest bidder. It's a slightly different matter if football is your full time occupation and your earning potential is limited to a small period in your adult life but not when it's on a part time basis. So, rest assured, any player who I sign for Tayport will not be motivated by earning an extra 'few bob' but rather by a desire to be a better football player come the end of their contract. Period. If that means I miss out on a few players along the way then so be it.

So Scott, I will give it my best shot to attract the better players to Tayport but it will be based on a set of principles that has stood me well in the past and hopefully well into the future.

Row Nicoll - What are your immediate priorities for the playing style and what are your thoughts on the current playing squad?

JMcG - Thanks for your questions Ron. On the immediate priorities for the playing style bear in mind I have only just arrived and we do not have many games left to make wholesale changes. Saying that, I am a great believer in playing whatever style is suited to the players at my disposal. Additionally the quality of the opposition, underfoot and overhead conditions are all factors that I take into account.

I once made the mistake of picking my team on the Wednesday before a vital game on the Saturday. We worked on a variety of routines and pattern of plays which I assumed would suit the players I had selected for the game. On the Saturday we turned up at the stadium and the pitch was in a terrible state. Heavy overnight rain and a poor drainage system rendered the pitch just about unplayable. On top of that, there was a near gale force wind. I had not appreciated the underfoot and overhead conditions and my game plan, which was based on building up play from the back proved to be utterly useless. Every time the full back tried to pass into the midfield the ball took an age to reach the player due to the saturated ground. Our midfielders tried their best to retain possession but ultimately they were doomed to fall. I never had a plan B. By half time we were 2 -0 down and the opposition had rarely passed the ball. They appreciated that the conditions demanded the ball had to be played from back to front quickly and a passing style was not the best tactics to win the game. From that day onwards I adopted a 'horses for courses policy.'

Thankfully or should that be hopefully, the better weather is here to stay and I firmly believe that our current pool of players will revel in playing football in more benign conditions. I am somewhat fortunate that Willie had assembled a very talented group of players who are all comfortable on the ball and I think this will auger well for the remainder of the campaign.

Pre season will give us more time to set out a playing system that will hopefully continue the Tayport tradition of winning with a bit of style.

Cammy Little - What are your immediate priorities to maintain our Super League status? Given our recent situation and regardless of our league status, what areas of the squad do you think need strengthened? In my opinion we need a target man up front similar to Brian Craik/Hamish Mackay, who can hold the ball up and score goals plus another quality centre half. How will you coach/prepare the players during training to prepare them for the remaining vital league games?

JMcG - Hi Cammy. Thanks for your questions. Hopefully the answer given to Scott covers your first two points and I can address your third one regarding preparation for games and training.

I am a stickler for players training in the same way as they play on a Saturday. I can only speak for myself but I preferred to train at a high tempo and got nothing out of training at half pace or without any competitive edge. You always run the risk of injury but it is my belief that the risk always outweighs the cost.

A typical training session lasts between one and a half and two hours and during that time I would expect the players to be working flat out for up to 50% of the time.

There is no hiding place on the training pitch. Players have to remember that I know every trick in the book so it's pointless trying to ghost through a session without me noticing! Anyway, all they achieve at best is a place on the bench and at worse a transfer to another club.

As the players get to know me they will realise that playing well on a Saturday is no guarantee that they will start the following game. I demand a high level of commitment to training and if there are a couple of players vying for one position I will base my decision on who shows more desire during the training session leading up to the game. Training, after all, is the opportunity for a player to catch my eye.

If a player is not involved on the Saturday there is no point moping around on the Monday at training. Far better he arrives sharp, works harder than the rest and goes home in the knowledge that he could do no more to convince me I was wrong to leave him out in the first place.

Finally, I am lucky that Grant and Steven decided to remain at the club at least until the end of the season. Both are Tayport through and through and their advice and opinions are very much appreciated. My assistant, Paul Reilly is a talented coach in his own right and his contribution to training is invaluable. We are on the same wave length and its uncanny how often he calls out a coaching point just as I am about to mention it. As an ex Tayport player I know Paul is extremely proud to be part of the management team here.

With regards to preparation before a match I think it's very important to know your opposition. So where ever possible I try to see as many of our opponents games home and away and if that is not possible then a trusted scout will be sent to watch them. All our players will then have a reasonable idea of the opposition's main strengths and weaknesses.

John McGlashan, the new Manager at The Canniepairt

Tayport's new manager John McGlashan takes charge of his first home match this afternoon, after successive away games at Forfar and Newtongrange, following his appointment on 17 April. John succeeds Willie Garner who resigned on the back of a run which hadn't seen a victory in eleven matches.

Dundonian born and bred, John (43) had a lengthy and varied playing career after signing for **Montrose FC** from **Dundee Violet** in 1989. The following year it was off to London after **Millwall** paid £50,000 for midfielder John's signature. Loan spells with **Fulham** and **Cambridge United** fol-



lowed before a £75,000 transfer to Peterborough United.

Then it was a move to Yorkshire and three seasons at **Rotherham United** before returning to his home town to sign for **Dundee FC** from 1997 to 1999. Loan spells at **Arbroath** and **Ross County** followed before a permanent transfer to Dingwall for a season.

It was then back to Gayfield where he completed a Senior career of some 358 appearances, scoring 59 goals.

A short time was spent with Dundee Violet before Arbroath came calling and John made a quick return to the Red Lichties, this time as manager, taking them to promotion in 2007 and thereafter consolidating their place in the Scottish Second Division during a successful four year spell at Gayfield.

John took a spell away from the game and Tayport were delighted when he decided it was time to get back into the game. John's assistant at Tayport is Paul Reilly. Paul or 'Junior' as he was known during a nine year spell here as a player during the 1990s, needs no introduction to the locals. Paul was also Assistant to John at Arbroath.

WHO'S GOING UP.....WHO'S GOING DOWN?







FROM THE ARCHIVES

Congratulations to Musselburgh Athletic on reaching the final of the Emirates Scottish Junior Cup, a feat Tayport achieved six times. Musselburgh face Auchinleck Talbot in the Final on 29th May at Rugby Park, Kilmarnock and are rank outsiders, as Tayport were in their first ever semi-final back on Friday 30th April in 1993. Tayport were also faced with Auchinleck in that semi final played at Partick Thistle's Firhill Stadium when 'Port stunned the Junior world with a 3-0 win.

It was a match in which **Hamish Mackay** carved himself into the history books with an amazing hat-trick. Sadly, however, Hamish missed the final through injury when Tayport lost 1-0 to Glenafton Athletic.

Tayport manager in 1993, Dave Baikie, had been over the ground before, losing a semi-final twice as a player in the 1980s and was concerned that his Tayport players would bottle it at the penultimate stage as he and his teammates had done previously.

To counteract this 'semifinalitis' the committee, at Baikie's request, brought Sports Psychologist Jack Black down to The Canniepairt to take away the fear of losing and replace it with the joy of winning.

It would be fair to say the committee were a bit apprehensive over shelling out a four figure fee. But the committee backed their manager and the gamble paid off handsomely with a fantastic 3-0 win.

In the semi-final Tayport survived an early Auchinleck bombardment when the Ayrshire club hit the bar, hit the post and had an effort cleared off the line but once Hamish had notched his first after ten minutes, Tayport gradually assumed control and by the second period were well in command with big Hambo notching another two goals to complete a famous hat-trick.

Tayport's team that night was Fraser Mann, Paul Reilly, Grant Paterson (Gary Lamont), Mark Spalding, Andy Sommerville, Jimmy Hunter, Sean Wilkie, Billy Coventry (Grant Cushnie), Hamish Mackay, Dave Reilly and Jackie Devine.

Baikie's backroom team was Ronnie Robb, Graeme Irons, Ged Reilly and physio was George Hill.
