



THIS AFTERNOON AT THE CANNIEPAIRT **ACA Sports SUPER LEAGUE** TAYPORT V FORFAR WEST END

What a fantastic start to the season Forfar West End are experiencing. Seven wins on the bounce to reach the final of the League Cup and go top of the Super League.

Credit must go to the Forfar management for shaking off the disappointment of losing the 505050 Taxis Cup Final and blowing the league title in the last couple of weeks of the season yet managing to get the team in rude health for the challenge of the Super League.

From last season's squad, Gary Muckersie was lured to St Andrews United and Grant Lawson moved to Lochee United. Like Willie Garner, West End gaffer Jim Finlayson realised he would have to strengthen his squad to face the rigours of the top division and in came six new faces. Former 'Port striker Robbie Holden and Jamie McKenzie moved from Kinnoull and this afternoon will face three of their teammates from last season, now in Tayport colours. Finlayson raided the North Division for the other four new faces, giving the opportunity of Super League football to Gavin Anderson (Violet), Ronnie Valentine, and Andy McDonald (both North End) and Robbie Black (Downfield), brother of Tayport's David.

Apart from Lawson, all the players who started league decider back in May are still at Strathmore Park and our visitors will be absolutely determined to erase these memories. Another interesting feature today will be the fact that the West End striking force will likely see Holden paired with another ex-'Port player, Bryan Duell. Dueller was the Premier Division's top marksman last season and has already nabbed six this season including netting in each of West End's last four outings. Mark Pirie, too, has been prolific with four of his five this season coming in the past five games. In winning all seven matches this season, the West End goals have been spread over nine different players as the team has cracked in an average of nearly four goals per game.

Tayport haven't had a bad start either and were well worth their win at Kelty last week. Derek Wemyss is still suspended and David Black will again miss out through injury. A few players have been nursing knocks this week including Roberto Morris and Barry Donachie, neither of whom who finished the game at Kelty last Saturday

DUNMORE REPORTS...

Tayport's ACA Sports East Super League campaign is now underway, with two fixtures having been played. Dave Baikie's Scottish Junior Cup holders, Linlithgow Rose, visited the Canniepairt on opening day, a fortnight ago, and left with all three points.

The game, however, was marred by an unfortunate leg break, with Lithgae's veteran midfielder, Mark Bradley, the unlucky player. The 80th minute incident saw Derek Wemyss collect a red card, although it must be said that there was certainly no intent on his part to cause injury.

By that point in the match, the Rosie Posie had already scored what proved to be the winner. Substitute Mark Tyrell clipped in a long-ranger, not long after coming off the bench.

Stevie McManus had had 'Port's best chance, in the first half, but saw his shot blocked on the line. Late in the game, following the half-hour delay for Bradley's injury, Tommy Coyne had a couple of opportunities for Linlithgow, but, other than that, there was little between the sides.

So, disappointed to have lost the first league game, Tayport were quickly back in action, with a DJ Laing League Cup semi-final, against Arbroath Vics. After a frustratingly goalless first half, Barry McNaughton slammed home his first counter of the season early in the second half, to give 'Port the lead.

Despite numerous chances, a second goal proved elusive and Vics netted a shock equaliser, midway through the half. In the closing stages, substitute James Russell found the net with a fine free kick, while Robbie Henderson was also on target, as the Canniepairt men ran out 3-1 winners.

Last weekend, it was back to Super League business and 'Port recorded a fine win at Kelty Hearts. Strikers Ronnie Kenneth and Robbie Henderson were both on the scoresheet, with Henderson's clincher coming four minutes into stoppage time. The clean sheet, at a tough venue, was a further bonus for manager Willie Garner.

Today, it's Forfar West End who provide the opposition in the quest for further league points, and the visitors, who have also reached the League Cup final, will again be stern opponents.

THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS FORFAR WEST END

When Tayport FC entered the Junior scene back in 1990, Forfar West End were emerging as a force in the Tayside Juniors. Indeed in that season, 1990/91, they became top division champions for the first time in 58 years. Prior to that 1933 Forfar & District title, their three previous successes had been in 1903. 1908 and 1909.

It wasn't to be however, and as Tayport went on to dominate the local Junior game in the 1990s, West End faded somewhat and after flirting with relegation in 1995, went down the following season but quickly returned to the top division.

When the Junior game was restructured, it would be 2007 until West End staged a revival which has pretty much been maintained to this day. Champions of the North Division, West End took their place in the Premier Division and skated through that league to win promotion to the Super League as runners-up to Bo'ness United in 2008.

A superb opening to the 2008/09 campaign had West End fans dreaming of the unthinkable—winning the title. Right enough, the unthinkable did happen—West End were relegated! Even now at Strathmore Park they must be wondering how it happened.

Dropping into the Premier Division, West End were in good company in the shape of Tayport. Both were well fancied to make a quick return to the Super League and that, of course, is how it turned out, but as we all know, it didn't go according to the script.

Once again the unthinkable happened. West End led the division for virtually the entire season and when they won 1-0 at The Canniepairt in April, the race for the title looked all but over. Few could blame West End for ordering up the champagne but, just like Bathgate in the Super League in 2006, they got the jitters and Tayport stole in to take the title. Needing only a point on that last day of the league season and previously unbeaten at home during the campaign, West End succumbed, losing by 2-1.







The curse of the keeper: underpaid, and misunderstood

"If Arsene Wenger's so clever," a senior international manager once asked, "why does he never buy a proper goalkeeper?" Years later, the question remains valid. Arsenal manager Wenger, a perfectionist when recruiting for other positions, has still not filled that one spot. He doesn't seem happy with his present keeper, Manuel Almunia. Wenger has bid about 22m for Fulham's Mark Schwarzer, but Fulham rightly consider that miserly.

And so Arsenal enter another season without an ideal keeper. Crucially, though, this is not just Wenger's blind spot. Most managers undervalue goalkeepers. It's one of the main irrationalities of the market in footballers. When sports economist

Bernd Frick studied salaries in Germany's Bundesliga, he found that keepers earned less than outfield players, despite mostly being older. They also command lower transfer fees: the British record being a mere £9m, paid by Sunderland for Craig Gordon in 2007.

The main problem is managerial ignorance. Some managers understand football, but keeping is something else entirely: it seems as foreign a craft as flower-arranging. And because they barely understand what keepers do, they are reluctant to pay much for them.

some managers, moreover, don't seem to care much. Playing great football preoccupies men like Wenger. To him the keeper is just the bloke who (sometimes) stops balls. Bayern Munich manager Louis van Gaal, another connoisseur of passing football, appears to treat the keeper's job at his club as an afterthought. Johan Cruijff, when manager of Barcelona, even wrestled with the idea of putting gloves on a defender, and sticking him in goal. That way Barca could field eleven footballers. Cruijff's subordinates eventually talked him out of it.

It also baffles managers that an expensive keeper's reputation can be sunk in an afternoon. That happened to Massimo Taibi, the promising keeper Manchester United signed from Venezia in 1999. A couple of blunders quickly earned him the harsh but inspired nickname of The Blind Venetian. United sold him after just four games.

Almost all players make mistakes while adjusting to a new club. It's just that a keeper's mistakes lose matches. Yet the fact that keepers matter so much is precisely a reason

to spend heavily on them. That, plus the fact that they last longer than outfield players: Real Madrid might get twenty years from Iker Casillas. Yet managers with less able men in goal don't trust themselves to buy the right replacement, and stick with the devil they know – as Wenger has with Almunia.

The obvious solution would be to farm out the decision to experts. Keepers' coaches presumably know who the best keepers are. But they are so low in a club's hierarchy – down with the bus driver – that no manager will spend £10m on his say-

so. Managers could use the wisdom of crowds – ask ten former keepers who to sign – but managers tend to see themselves as the Messiah, until they are sacked. They rarely consult.

Wenger and Ferguson have been groping towards a solution. Initially Wenger, in particular, bought keepers much as he bought outfield players: he went for budding talent. But too many of these talents failed him. Then, in 2005, Ferguson found another solution: he signed the 34-year-old Edwin van der Sar, who remains United's keeper today. He proved the adage: old keepers don't die, they just keep getting better.

die, they just keep getting better.
Joop Hiele, Van der Sar's former keeping coach, once explained why: "Goalkeeping is registering the situation, recognizing it and finding the solution. The more often you do it, the easier it gets." An older keeper is so familiar with the structure of attacks that he has time to organise his defence. Younger keepers can't. That's why Wenger pursued the 37-year-old Schwarzer. However, he apparently hasn't pursued him with enough vigour to land him. Over time, Wenger's blind spot has probably cost him some of his ambitions. At least he's in excellent company.
