

# THIS AFTERNOON AT THE CANNIEPAIRT John Walker East of Scotland Cup 1st round TAYPORT v ST ANDREWS UNITED

After three league games the East Region clubs take a break for some cup action today with a full programme of East of Scotland Cup ties. In terms of entries and prestige, it's second only to the Scottish Junior Cup itself and has been contested annually since 1896/97. However, only in the past six seasons have clubs outwith the Lothians been eligible for entry.

In these six years St Andrews, although they have never been in the region's top tier, have fared far better than their opponents today in the East of Scotland Cup, 19 ties compared to Tayport's 12. Twice St Andrews have reached the semi final, losing to Linlithgow Rose in 2005 and to Lochee United in 2009. Tayport's best is three appearances at the third round stage.

Contests between Tayport and St Andrews stretch back 20 years and although there have been previous meetings in the Scottish and Fife/Tayside Cups and in the League last season, this is the first meeting in the East of Scotland competition.

St Andrews, according to reports, were in splendid form last week, winning 1-0 at Ballingry Rovers in the Premier League, their first success after an opening day draw with Armadale Thistle and a single goal defeat at Broxburn. The artificial pitch got the blame for that one.

Both clubs have made a number of changes during the close season and only six of the Saints starting XI when the clubs met here back at the end of May, are likely to feature today. Tayport will probably have eight of their starting line up that evening in the squad this afternoon.

As was the case when Tayport and Saints met back in May, the fans were again treated to plenty drama last Saturday. There was some splendid football in the first half, warmly appreciated by the supporters but the second half was a bit of a let down. Nevertheless, there was no shortage of talking points...

St Andrews report a full strength squad and there will probably be starting places for striker Gary Sutherland, the club's top scorer in each of the last five seasons, and new signing from Arbroath FC, Ryan Suttie, both of whom started on the bench last week. Tayport will be without the injured David Black and Barry Donachie and the unavailable Barry McNaughton but Derek Wemyss returns. Manager Willie Garner will also be absent today.

If level after 90 minutes, the tie will be settled by penalties, the method by which six of Saints nineteen previous ties in this competition have been settled.



#### From the Archives

Speaking at our Footballers' Supper this evening is John McKelvie, west coast based raconteur. It's not John's first visit to Tayport, however. That was in January 1978 as a member of the Parkside team which met Tayport in the 5th round of the Scottish Amateur Cup.

It was an epic cup battle which stretched to three games, Tayport eventually losing to a very late penalty which Ian Mathers, to this day, is adamant was a not a foul.

Tayport were drawn with home advantage and led at half time through Jim Downie but conceded the equaliser necessitating a trip to wildest Lanarkshire. It was a pretty bad winter and the replay was postponed on two occasions but finally got underway on 28 January.

The part of Uddingston where the game was played wasn't the sort of place you'd choose for a holiday, nor indeed to venture out after dark! Level 2-2 at half time, the sides couldn't be separated and after 90 minutes it was 3-3. Thirty minutes extra time still had the teams locked together at 4-4. Ian Howe (2), Peter Wilson and George Ritchie were the scorers but Jim Downie revelled in the heavy going and was accorded man of the match status. Tayport lost the toss and were back a week later.

Conditions for the second replay were horrendous. It was freezing and the pitch, having taken a hammering the previous week, was now a badly flooded mud heap. Same for both sides declared the ref! Level at half time thanks to a Gordon Hughes goal, Tayport, without the injured Jim Downie this week, succumbed to that disputed second half penalty.

Playing all three games were Bobby Nicoll; Bobby McMahon, Ian Mathers, Ronnie Fleming, Doug Henderson, Peter Wilson, Mike Clerihew, George Ritchie, Ian Howe and Gordon Hughes. Ian Dobie was replaced in the 13 by St Andrean Terry Scanlon for the two replays, Stuart Davie replaced Steve Braid in the 13 for both replays and Ian Brown was added to the squad in place of the injured Downie for the third game. The players were so cold in the spartan dressing room accommodation that they couldn't untie their boot laces and the laces had to be cut off.

Thirty two years on, Henderson, Ritchie, Mathers, Howe and Davie are current season tickets holders here at the Canniepairt. Further a field, though, is Bobby McMahon, who emigrated to Canada the following season where he has become a top media personality with his own football show on Fox Sports.

### A Penalty Clause in Finlayson's Tactics?

In the absence of any senior football in Dundee last week, I took myself off to watch my 'other' team, for what was a thoroughly exciting game between The Port and rivals Forfar West End.

Much of the talk during the game, especially during the first half, was regarding Jim Finlayson, the West End boss, and someone who is never usually far away from controversy. Most people familiar with junior football in the area will be aware of his unusual tactic of standing beside the assistant referee towards whichever goal his team may be attacking. This, I am assured, is not illegal, and he would be treated like any other manager should he step out of line. The theorists in the game may infer that this is a tactic to manipulate decisions, and whilst I am not suggesting this is what his aim may be, nor indeed implying experienced officials may be fickle enough to be intimidated, the result appear to speak from themselves.

Jim himself will tell you that after a long spell coaching in the juniors, his passion for the game sometimes brought trouble with the SJFA beaks leading to him being banned from entering his own dugout. And from that point of view it would appear sensible for him to abstain from the technical area during the 90 minutes, allowing his players to carry out his pre-match instructions under the guidance of his coaching team.

But when 3 of his side's last 4 goals have come from penalty kicks, and ex Tayport forward Bryan Duell claimed 19 goals from the same spot last season, you have to wonder if he really is keeping out of trouble, or have his menacing ways reached a new (incredible, effective and innovative) level?

 ${\mathfrak A}$ nother manager who hit the headlines close to home was Falkirk's Steven

Pressley. Having lost 2-0 at Dens Park, the former Scotland defender intimated that Dundee's substitute goalkeeper Scott Fox, brought on after Robert Douglas was red carded after an hour, wasted time, and therefore restricted his teams chances.

Whilst this remains a pet hate of most people in the game, his opposite number of the day for me summed up what many people think of big 'Elvis' these days.

"If he (Pressley) is not talking about pulling pitches in or about body language he's going on about other people's teams. He should stick to looking at his own team instead of trying to deflect by picking on one of my boys. We played well and deserved to win the game and sometimes as a manager you've got to put your hands up and admit the far better team won"

Well said, Mr Chisholm!






