



TODAY'S VISITORS NEWTONGRANGE STAR

Today we welcome the players, officials and supporters of Newtongrange Star to the Canniepairt for an ACA Sports East Super League match.

This is the first time that we have played Nitten in the Super League as their promotion from the Premier League at the end of the 2008/9 season coincided with Tayport dropping down to the Premier League. Saying that we did, of course, meet in the Fifth Round of the Scottish Cup last season when we won with the only goal of the game thanks to a goal from the penalty spot by Stefan Elvin.

Formed in 1890 Nitten won the Scottish Junior Cup in 1929/30 and were runners-up in 1970/71 and 1990/91. Success over the seasons appears to have been on a boom and bust basis. The 1920s through to the early 1930s was a very successful spell for Nitten as were the 1950s and early 1990s. Their last top league success was in 1991/92 when they won the old East 'A' Division. They gained promotion from the East South League in 2006/07 and two years later were promoted to the Super League as runners up to Musselburgh Athletic.

Other major successes include winning the East of Scotland Cup on eleven occasions - the last being in 1996/97 and the Fife & Lothians Cup four times - most recently in 1990/91. They have recorded over 70 other cup successes over the years.

Last season was meant to be a year of consolidation for the Star in the Super League and their good start saw them finishing a very credible fourth in the table with 33 points.

In the current season Nitten started off in a six team section in the South League Cup. They only lost one match - to the group winners Linlithgow Rose and failed to qualify. Rose went on to win the cup.

It has been poor start in the Super League for Nitten - one point from six matches. Saying that all five defeats have been by a single goal margin and the home defeat last week by Forfar West End perhaps sums up their season to date. A late, late goal by Bryan Duell stealing all three points for the Angus side.

Aaron Sommerville scored his first league goal of the current campaign last Saturday keeping up the spread of goalscorers. There have now been eight different scorers of the Star's league tally of ten. Gareth Hutchison and Stuart Roseburgh have two each.

DUNMORE REPORTS

The last month has been a mixed one for the club. When local rivals St. Andrews United visited the Canniepairt, they were defeated by two goals to nil, in an East of Scotland Cup tie. To be honest, it was not a match which will live long in the memory, but at least the hosts progressed to the next round of the inter-regional competition.

Grant Manzie was the star man, notching both of Tayport's goals, with one in each half. The first came early on, after Manzie was fouled by Kyle Dammer. The Saints man was red-carded and, when the 'keeper saved Chris Anton's free kick, the 'Port striker was on hand to knock in the opener. Unfortunately, Ross Lunan was also dismissed during the first half, but a second half counter from Manzie sealed the derby win.

A much more impressive performance saw off Hill o'Beath at Keirs Park, three weeks ago. In a Super League encounter, James Russell broke the deadlock on half-time, with a stunning free kick. Barry McNaughton extended the lead with a close-range effort, following a corner. A penalty from James Russell, after a foul on Grant Manzie, rounded off a fine afternoon.

A fortnight ago, Port looked set to continue their winning run when at Thomson Park. Another Super League goal from Barry McNaughton gave the Canniepairt men an interval lead, but Lochee came back to clinch the points. Johnny Thompson and Phil Hagan, both familiar faces, scored for the Bluebells.

Disappointed by that result, worse was to follow last weekend. In a game which Port should really have won, Bonnyrigg Rose grabbed a late winner on the Canniepairt, to leave Tayport empty-handed again. Numerous chances had been passed up before the avoidable 87th minute sucker-punch. It was definitely not Tayport's day.

Let's hope for better fortune this afternoon. Newtongrange may well have only point thus far, but, like Tayport, any defeats have been by the odd goal. So, a tight match may well be in prospect.


"Where are you off tae," he asked.




