

### **DUNMORE REPORTS...**

#### "Kelty Hearts, will provided sterner opposition, especially with Keith Burgess at the helm"

A James Russell free kick and a second half header from Brian Livie earned three Super League points the last time Tayport were on the Canniepairt, when Newtongrange Star provided the opposition, in early October.

Since then, 'Port have been on the road. The following weekend, there was a trip to Carmuirs Park, to meet Camelon, again in the Super League. James Russell again netted a free kick, but the Mariners raced into a 3-1 lead. Grant Manzie's late goal was a consolation in a match in which skipper Roberto Morris was ordered off.

Next up was the DJ Laing League Cup final. A depleted team competed well against the robust Forfar West End, but there would be a disappointing outcome. Ex-'Port man, Bryan Duell, headed West End ahead, but Robbie Henderson equalised at the start of the second half. To nobody's great surprise, the Strathmore Parkers later won a penalty. Up stepped Duell, and Tayport were again trailing. A deliberate handball by Martin Black, at the other end gave the Canniepairt outfit a spot kick of their own. James Russell converted and the cup would be decided on penalties, with West End triumphing.

Scottish Junior Cup action got underway the next week. Seven different scorers enabled 'Port to cruise to a 9-0 win at Harthill. Lee Bryce and Grant Manzie notched two apiece. Stevie McManus began the rout, from the spot, while Barry Donachie, Robbie Henderson, Stefan Elvin and James Russell were also on target. Russell's individual goal was perhaps the pick of the bunch.

The Super League fixture at Bathgate was postponed, so, after an idle Saturday, Tayport were back in business last weekend, at Haddington, in the East of Scotland Cup. The Hi Hi took a shock lead, from the spot, but Robbie Henderson soon equalised. A Stevie McManus penalty saw Willie Garner's men lead at the break. A Robbie Henderson header extended the advantage, while free kick specialist James Russell yet again demonstrated his tremendous shooting ability to make the final score 4-1 in Tayport's favour.

So, the goals have flowed of late, but today's opponents, Kelty Hearts, will provided sterner opposition, especially with Keith Burgess at the helm. Let's hope for a cracking contest.

# ACA SPORTS SUPER LEAGUE TAYPORT V KELTY HEARTS

Kelty Hearts are enjoying a revival. A cracking start to the season with a 100% record and not a goal conceded in their league cup section proved to be something of a false dawn to the season. The gulf between the Premier & District League and the Super League was exposed and, as league defeat followed league defeat, the pressure was mounting on the Hearts' committee. Having suffered five defeats from their opening six league fixtures and defeat to Glenrothes in the opening round of the Emirates Scottish Cup, the committee did what committees of Super League clubs do in such circumstances—they parted company with their manager, in this case the long serving Steve Leighton.

As is the case in such circumstances, the rumour mill slipped into gear and the mill was still whirring when former Tayport boss and current Junior Scotland boss Keith Burgess had been offered and accepted the post, bringing with him his assistant at Tayport, Stewart Williamson. Keith had been out of club management since leaving Tayport in 2007 with Scottish Cup and Super League successes added to his managerial CV.

It's been an excellent start for Keith, Stewart and coach Billy McPhee, with a league win over Camelon sandwiched between convincing cup wins over Arniston Rangers in the Fife & Lothians Cup and Carnoustie Panmure in the East of Scotland Cup.

Keith has basically been relying on the players he inherited, although Gary Leighton, son of the previous manager, is not in the picture and is available for transfer. Into the squad comes former Dundee United youngster Kris Irvine.

If the evidence from our earlier meeting this season with Kelty is anything to go by, there was plenty to suggest that the new manager has plenty to work with and another keen contest is anticipated today. There's loads of experience in the Kelty line-up and, with 15 goals to his credit already this season, Craig Morrison is bang in form in front of goal.

Willie Garner has had to utilise his playing pool fully over the last few weeks with injuries meaning six players have been regularly watching from the side-lines. Full back Alister Devine was fixed up on short term loan from Forfar but the former Hearts defender has been recalled by the Station Park club. The loss of Alistair has been tempered somewhat by the return of Derek Wemyss last week and both Roberto Morris and Brian Livie this week.

Having comfortably accounted for Harthill and Haddington in their past two games, Tayport will find Kelty a trifle more testing, to say the least.

### THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS KELTY HEARTS

As long as a football has been kicked around, there's been a team or teams in Kelty but Kelty Hearts, the team of the current generation, was only founded in 1975 as an amateur club. However, since acquiring Junior status in 1980, Hearts have been a significant force in Fife Junior football.

Kelty Hearts home ground is Central Park in Bath Street which attracted its record attendance in the club's fledgling years, 1,650 v Benburb in a 1980/81 Scottish Junior Cup tie. Over the years Central Park has undergone a number of improvements, most recently on the social side with the construction of a social club in the ground. It's the committee's intention to continue to upgrade their ground, but in so doing, balancing off the field with on field expenditure. Every manager's nightmare scenario!

One of Kelty's most famous sons, Jim Leishman, was one of the club's first managers before he moved on to greater things. Although on the scene for thirty five years, it was only relatively recently that Kelty Hearts' name gained national prominence, through reaching the Scottish Junior Cup Final on two occasions.

Their first appearance was in 1998 -1999 when they lost 1-0 to Kilwinning Rangers at Firhill Stadium in Glasgow. Their second final appearance was in 2006 - 2007 when they played Linlithgow Rose at East End Park, Dunfermline. The choice of East End Park as the final venue was fully vindicated when the biggest Junior Cup final attendance for many years, officially 9,304 but probably more, rolled up. It was the first Junior Cup Final in 30 years not to be televised and this probably helped swell the attendance. A tremendous Kelty support, went home disappointed, however, after suffering a 2-1 defeat.

Although they have two cup final appearances to look back on, Kelty Hearts have yet to make a significant impact on the new Super League structure. The committee clearly hope that this step can be taken under the stewardship of new manager Keith Burgess who previously tasted Scottish Cup and Super League success with Tayport.







NOVEMBER 2003

KELTY HEARTS' FIRST LEAGUE VISIT TO THE CANNIEPAIRT

Season 2002/03 had seen Kelty crowned Fife District Champions and consequently they were promoted to the Super League for the first time. It was to be a tough baptism in the top division and the Central Park side made a quick return to the District Leagues, along with Hill of Beath and Dundee North End.

Although Kelty had started the season promisingly and finished with the Super League's second best defence, conceding only 22 goals, one fewer that Tayport, who were champions, they only scored 14 and it was this paucity of goals, particularly away from home when only 5 were scored in the entire campaign, which ultimately cost them dearly.

The visit to the Canniepairt on 29th November seven years ago, their first ever on league business, was fairly typical of Kelty's season, a 0-1 defeat. The only goal came from Ralph Hunter, netting for a previously unprecedented (for Ralph!) fourth game in succession.

Six of today's Tayport squad lined up for 'the home side that afternoon and coincidentally, six of today's pool were also in the Kelty squad that day. Attendance was 184
