Their last match - 20 November - saw 'Port record an excellent Super League win against Kelty Hearts, netting four without reply on a rain-soaked Canniepairt. It was not the return to his old stomping ground that former Tayport boss, Keith Burgess, would have been hoping for.

To be fair to Burgess, he did suffer an early blow, when skipper and Scottish Junior internationalist, Tam Courts, had to be replaced, after only six minutes.

Tayport's first goal came at a good time, just before the break. Grant Manzie did well to fire in a cross, which Robbie Henderson turned home at the near post. The pair combined again early in the second half, with Manzie this time the scorer, thanks to a composed, low finish.

A James Russell penalty increased the advantage, midway through the second half, effectively sealing the points. Then, in the latter stages, Russell's unerring free kick from the left found Robbie Henderson ghosting in at the far post, to head in the fourth goal.

While Kelty did have a couple of late opportunities, once testing Neal Ferrie, it was very much Tayport's day. The players put in a tremendous shift and thoroughly deserved to post all three points.

Hopefully, despite the weather enforced break, that form can be maintained today, as 'Port face a difficult fixture in the 'Scottish', against a club with a formidable pedigree when it comes to the national competition. In addition to their impressive history, Petershill, who managed to fit in a rearranged league game with Cumnock a week past last Saturday, currently ply their trade in the top flight of the West Region, so a close encounter looks likely.

EMIRATES SCOTTISH JUNIOR CUP 3rd ROUND TAYPORT V PETERSHILL

The Canniepairt took something of a hammering on 20th November as rain poured down incessantly for the entire 90 minutes v Kelty and left the surface looking in a sorry state. Not something that Petershill will be too familiar with these days, now that they are playing on an artificial surface at home. After a ten week break during which it's been ravaged by the weather, the pitch, which has in turn resembled a snowfield, an ice rink and a loch, might not be much better today

Although the contrast in surfaces from week to week will probably be fairly significant at times, it would appear to make little difference to Petershill who take the issue in their stride and have recorded as good—and bad—performances away as they have done at home.

This column for the game when it was first set to be played on 27 November said "The mud early in the week gave way to a smattering of snow in midweek but it got a quick shift and hopefully, no further snowfall and no significant frost will allow this tie to go ahead as scheduled." Well, how wrong were we?

In reaching this stage in the competition, neither team has been tested. Both received byes in the first round and had comfortable wins over sides from the same division in round 2. Petershill won 3-1 at home to Dalkeith Thistle, whilst Tayport won 9-0 at Harthill Royal.

Petershill will miss the influence of man of many clubs, Ryan Jordan, currently in his second spell at Peasy. Jordan was ordered off in Petershill's last game before the enforced break v Pollok and he will miss out today. Although Petershill played a league game two weeks ago - 0-0 v Cumnock - the SJFA decreed that his suspension should be the tie v Tayport. Ironically, Jordan is probably the only Petershill player who has played at The Canniepairt, playing here for Linlithgow in a 0-0 draw in 2005.

Several players in the visitors' squad have had Senior connections, two with Dundee United. Chris Gentile was at Tannadice from 1998 to 2000, while Kieran McAleenan was there from 2003 to 2005. Petershill have a new face in their ranks, having signed midfielder Jordan Mutch from Texas based DFW Tornados during the break. Previously with Clyde and Stranraer, the 22 year old had 1 goal in 5 games for the USL Premier Development League this past season before coming back across the Atlantic to sign for Petershill.

Despite the long break, Tayport are again handicapped through being unable to select from a full pool. In this respect, however, the situation is probably better than it was a couple of weeks ago. Still not quite ready is David Black, who had a cartilage operation on Hogmanay and Barry McNaughton missed training this week through illness. Stuart Ferguson hasn't played since a hernia operation but will return to the squad today as should Barry Donachie, who sustained an injury at training. Ronnie Kenneth is back after a holiday in the Antipodes. Striker Ross Lunan was transferred last week to Dundee Violet.

Today's referee, Mr David McGeachie, is from Cupar.



HISTORY (Courtesy of www.petershillfc.co.uk)

Petershill Football and Athletic Club were formed on Friday 4th June 1897 at a meeting in Thomson's Coffee house, Castle Street in the Townhead district of Glasgow. At a meeting in the same venue three weeks earlier, St. Mungo's Juniors were disbanded after a disastrous season in the Glasgow Junior League. At the end of the meeting, it was stated that anyone interested in forming a new club on a wider scale, to represent the Springburn and Townhead area, should sign their name on a sheet of paper as they left the meeting. Over twenty signatures were obtained and the "Peasy" were born.

The club were elected to the Glasgow Junior League for season 1898-99 and finished second bottom of the 10 teams. The Peasy won their first trophies in 1903, beating Maryhill 5-1 at Saracen Park to win the North Eastern Cup, then beating them again by 1-0 at Meadowside to win the Glasgow Charity Cup. The Scottish Junior Cup was won for the first time in 1912, with a then record 5-0 over Denny Hibs in the final played at Firhill. The "Holy Grail" of the Scottish Junior Cup was won again in 1916 with a 2-0 win over Parkhead. In 1918 Petershill were awarded the Scottish Cup without playing the final. Both the other semi finalists, Parkhead and Renfrew, were disqualified for refusing to play the 2nd replay of the semi on the Wednesday before the final.

The post war years were a real "boomtime" for junior football, but Petershill in particular had their own peak in the 1950's, with 21 honours being won. The club had lost out to Auchinleck Talbot in the 1949 Scottish Junior Cup final, but they won their 4th Junior Cup in 1951, in front of a record Hampden crowd of 77,560 when they beat Irvine Meadow XI 1-0. Petershill then won their only League Championship and Scottish Cup double in 1956, with Lugar Boswell beaten 4-1 in front of another huge Hampden crowd, and the league Championship won with a 4-0 win over Parkhead. The silverware has kept on coming over the years, and the Club won its 100th Trophy in 2004, beating Maryhill 2-0 in the Central League Cup Final.

GROUNDS: After beginning at Arrol Park, Petershill moved to Atlas Park in September 1903, then onto Hawthon Park in 1919, where they remained until Petershill Park was opened on Tuesday 20th August 1935, with a 20,000 crowd present to see Rangers take on Celtic. Petershill moved into the new Petershill Park complex at the start of the 2007-2008 season.

FAMOUS PLAYERS: Many great players have played for Petershill over the years, with the club having 38 players capped for Scotland at Junior level, with Bert McNab setting a record of 13 caps during his time with the club. Many players have played for the club then stepped up senior, including Alex Massie, Torry Gillick and Johnny McKenzie, all of whom were capped for Scotland at Senior level. Gillick joined the club as a 16 year old year old schoolboy in October 1933 and finished the season as top scorer with 30 goals. He then joined Rangers at the end of the season and went on to win 5 senior caps and play for Everton before returning to Rangers.



From the Archives 40 Years Ago 21 November 1970

Tayport FC ran two teams 40 years ago and both played in the Midlands Amateur FA.

The 1st XI was in the Midlands Division One which was the top tier, there being no Premier or Super divisions in those days. The Alliance XI was in the top tier of the Alliance or Reserve Leagues.

The weather must have been bad in the winter of 1970 as the Midlands team went from 21 November to 19 December without a game. On 21 November 1970 they played away to Springfield in the Fife Cup, winning 6-1.

Team was Derek White, Frank Leslie, Eddie Stewart, Jim Scott, Jim Mathers, Richard Redpath, George Ritchie, Ronnie Laing, George Bryson, Douglas Henderson, Ian Paterson. Sub. was Abby Oswald. Goalscorers were Scott (2), Bryson (2), Laing and Redpath. The influence of the Tay Road Bridge which opened four years earlier was kicking in and this would be one of the last seasons a Tayport 1st XI comprised entirely of locals.

Tayport would go no further in the Fife Cup that year, losing 6-1 at home to Leven Hibs in the next round.

On 21 November 1970 the Alliance XI were going down 2-3 at home to Y M Anchorage XI in a Lunan Trophy tie. Tayport lined up John Porter, Walter Kemp, Kenny Gorham, Graham Welsh, Tony Gillespie, Maurice Flynn, Davie Ayre, Jimmy Lindsay, Alan Davie, Jim Downie, Eddie Gilmour. Sub was Clarke Mitchell. Downie and Lindsay got the goals.

All were Tayport guys apart from Tony Gillespie who was at Art College in Dundee and was know to cycle from Edinburgh on occasion for games.
