Played 25, Won 18, Drawn 4, Lost 3 is the record of the Bo'ness United side we welcome to the Canniepairt this afternoon. It's a very impressive record which the defending Super League Champions bring with them and they are still very much in contention on four fronts, Emirates, East of Scotland and Fife & Lothians Cups and the Super League.

Had we not slipped up at Petershill, this could well have been an Emirates 5th round tie we are watching here today between the same contestants The 5th round ties are scheduled for today and, had there been a winner at Dunbar last week, the successful side would have been hosting Bo'ness today.

Tayport lost out in the Emirates replay at Petershill in what was a very disappointing display but there was a big improvement at Bathgate last week, so this afternoon will be a real test. Bo'ness had suffered only one league defeat before last week's loss at Linlithgow Rose but, in what's another potentially tight championship, they will still have aspirations of repeating last season's title success.

Manager Willie Newbigging reckoned his side played well and could easily have picked up the three points, an opinion shared by Rose gaffer Dave Baikie whose side once again scraped through to stay in pole position at the top of the table in what was a sixth league win by the odd goal.

Bo'ness have strengthened their pool with the recent signings of Grant Plenderleith, a young midfielder from Stenhousemuir, and striker Graeme McLaren from Bathgate. Plenderleith debuted v Linlithgow last Saturday and McLaren, who was a spectator at our match with Bathgate last week, is expected to make his debut here this afternoon.

Brian Livie and Ronnie Kenneth, who were both unavailable last week, return to the Tayport pool. David Black was on the bench at Bathgate, so is a step closer to a return but not included in the squad is Stevie McManus, who is available for transfer.



## THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS BO'NESS UNITED

A warm welcome to the players, committee and supporters of Bo'ness United. Bo'ness can genuinely be described as one of Scotland's bigger Junior clubs with good 'gates' and one of the best travelling supports. Pre-second world war, Bo'ness had a team in the Scottish League but have been members of the Juniors since 1945.

Like Tayport, Bo'ness have appeared in six Scottish Junior Cup Finals with a 50% success rate. The successes were in 1948, 1975 and 1984 with disappointment in 1947, 1979 and 1983.

Tayport's Super League successes came in 2003 and 2006 but it wasn't until last season that the BUs ended a 41 year wait without a top league title, to lift a first Super League championship.

The league success permitted entry to the Scottish [Senior] Cup and earlier this season wins over Selkirk and Queen's Park had the Newton Park faithful dreaming of a possible tie against an SPL side but the Highland League's Buckie Thistle ended the dream at the 3rd round stage.

Former Tayport boss Dave Baikie had a spell in charge of Bo'ness in 2006 before returning to the Seniors with East Fife. Baiker's short spell in charge at Newton Park looked as if his love affair with the Scottish Junior Cup would continue but Bo'ness, looking very much like tournament favourites at the time, were unceremoniously thrown out over the tournament when registration problems were discovered.

In charge these days is Willie Newbigging whose previous visits to Tayport have mainly been as the manager and player/manager of Oakley United, who always provided stuffy opposition. Key member of the current Bo'ness side is skipper Roger Duffin who was with Willie at Oakley.

## SAUCHIE WILL BE A CHALLENGE

Tayport have been drawn away to Sauchie in the 3rd round of the East of Scotland Cup. 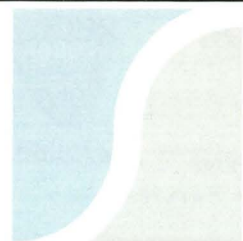

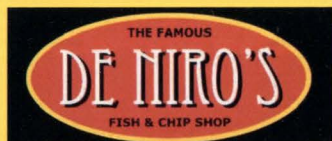
