



THIS AFTERNOON AT THE CANNIEPAIRT ACA SUPER LEAGUE TAYPORT V CAMELON

Today's game has a significant role to play in the emerging fortunes of both teams as the season heads towards a conclusion. With neither team retaining any cup interest, all attention will be focused on the League. The Super League is so competitive again this season that a run of three wins can send a side soaring towards the top or plummeting into relegation trouble. Today's combatants should be acutely aware of the position in which they find themselves. For both, a win is vital. We should, therefore, expect a cracking match.

Of the two teams today, Camelon had the stickier start to the season and it wasn't until their seventh game that they tasted their first success, a 3-2 win over Tayport at Carmuirs Park in what was a hugely disappointing afternoon for the Fifers. Since that day in October Tayport have had only three games, a win, a draw and a defeat, the most recent being the 0-4 humbling by Bo'ness in our last home game. Unhindered by cup tie action, Camelon have played nine games since then, six of which have been since the turn of the year, but no wins in the last four.

By all accounts, however, manager Danny Smith, the former Linlithgow Rose midfielder, has recently injected a bit of fire in the Camelon bellies. The Mariners came back from two goals down late in the game to salvage a point v Forfar West End and last week at Musselburgh, they had by far the better of the game before an unexpected collapse late in the first half cost four goals and ultimately a 5-2 defeat.

Smith has brought in a couple of new faces to bolster his squad, one of whom, Jon Mitchell, will not require an introduction. Mitchell, it will be recalled, played here in 2002/03 and won a Scottish Cup winners medal for 'Port v Linlithgow. Also new to the Camelon squad is Callan Kerr who was signed from Stenhousemuir U 19s.



David Black, whose failure to make a quick recovery from cartilage surgery is giving some concern, should be the only absentee. Tayport will have coaches Steven Stewart and Grant Paterson controlling things from the dugout in the absence of manager Willie Garner who is abroad.

Let's hope that Willie Garner's men can turn the corner this afternoon, in the bid for crucial East Super League points.







The International Football Association Board held its Annual meeting at the Celtic Manor Hotel in Newport, Wales on Saturday 5th March.

SNOODS NO MORE

At the meeting, the Board decided to prohibit, with immediate effect, the wearing of snoods (or neck scarves) by players. It was considered that such items did not constitute part of the basic equipment of players as set out in Law 4 – Players' Equipment, and that, moreover, they could constitute a danger to the wearer in the event that an opponent chose to pull the snood.

I would ask you therefore to inform your technical and playing staffs of this decision to ensure that such garments are not worn by players.

Please note that this letter is being copied to the referee movement.

The full decisions of the International Football Association Board will be communicated to you once they are made available by FIFA.

THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS CAMELON

Camelon Juniors - a brief history

[adapted from Camelon Juniors' website www.cjfc.co.uk]

Camelon JFC was founded in 1920 and for a team that comes from deep in the central belt of Scotland their nickname, "The Mariners", perhaps requires explanation. The Forth and Clyde Canal runs past their ground and it is generally accepted that the nickname goes back to the time when Camelon was a thriving shipping port on the Canal at the point where it is linked to the Union Canal.

Success in the early days was limited with one appearance in the Scottish Cup Final in 1952 when Camelon were beaten 1-0 by Kilbirnie Ladeside. The mid 1990s saw the club's most successful spell, winning the OVD Scottish Cup in 1995 when they beat Whitburn 2-0 in the final. The following year they again reached the final only to be beaten in extra time by Tayport (see photo collage upstairs in Tayport's pavilion) During this period they also won the East of Scotland League; The Skol League Cup and the East of Scotland Cup.

Carmuirs Park

In 1920 Camelon had no recognised ground of their own. Their home games were played as far afield as Stirling and Bo'ness. Tired of being the nomad club, Camelon's committee was forced to take stock of themselves and seek the means to secure the future of the Club.

They approached a local farmer who had extensive land on the north side of the Forth and Clyde Canal. When the farmer heard that all but two of Camelon's players had been in the Army he offered the club a field on the north bank of the canal which the committee turned into a football ground. The ground took its name from the farm on which it stood and Carmuirs Park was born.

Since then there have been several improvements. The erection of the pavilion and the enclosure, the levelling of the playing surface and the creation of the terracing made Carmuirs Park one of the best stadiums in Scottish Junior Football with a reputation as having one of the finest playing surfaces in the game, the envy of many senior clubs. The erection of a covered enclosure in front of the pavilion in the 1990s, with the help of a grant from The Football Trust, has added to the attraction of the Stadium. If the original and hardworking committee members could see their Carmuirs Park now, they'd be well pleased with their foresight.

The top quality playing surface was widely commented on by Tayport's players and officials on the club's first ever visit to Carmuirs Park in 1993 for a Scottish Cup tie and this was reckoned to be a factor in a thrilling 3-3 draw.

Tayside fury at Scotland boss's snub

THE TAYSIDE Region Junior Football Association are up in arms because Scotland boss Dick Brock has completely ignored their players for next week's international trial.

Despite the improving Tayside scene, boasting at least two OVD Scottish Junior Cup quarter-finalists, Brock has failed to pick a single representative from the Tayside Leagues for Monday night's trial match against Airdrie at Linlithgow from which the side to face Northern Ireland at Auchinleck on March 27 will be drawn.

The 17-strong squad selected by Brock, who watched Tayport put Shettleston out of the cup last weekend, comprises seven players from Ayrshire, five from East, four from Central and Kelty Hearts striker Andrew Tod.

And to rub salt in the wounds, two of his choices play for Shettleston.

Tayside clubs are furious over what they regard as a major snub. Tayside secretary Jock Myles has sent a letter of complaint on behalf of the association to the Scottish Junior Football Association, and SJFA president James Ferguson and secretary Joe Black can expect to have their ears bent tomorrow when they visit Dundee for the St Joseph's-Arthurlie fifth-round replay.

"There is a feeling of anger and disgust over the complete absence of Tayside players from the trial," said Myles.

The omission of Downfield pair Derek Mitchell and Grant Clark, both of whom have been capped previously, is a particular slap in the face. Mitchell scored a hat-trick as Downfield bundled Bellshill out of the national tournament and Clark is generally reckoned to be the best goalkeeper in the country.

"Earlier this season, after Downfield had beaten Hill O' Beath in the Scottish, I telephoned Dick Brock to recommend Grant Clark and he told me that 30 minutes earlier he'd had the Hill O' Beath manager on to him raving about Clark," revealed Myles.

Brock yesterday refused to comment on his choice, though he confirmed he alone is responsible for selecting players for international duty.

The media is sure to be out in force for the Military Funeral at Tayport Parish Church on Tuesday.

Latest feature in Dundee FC's matchday programme, *The Dee*, is 'Blether with Bomber', a page of mutterings on the lines of Bomber's contribution to the *Port Prog* before his defection to Dens. He'll need to get a copy checker, though! As readers of the TFC Website Forum will have observed, Bomber maintains a keen interest in the fortunes of Tayport and isn't slow to say his piece.





Tayport, the town that is, is in line for an award. The award is made to the town which can boast (?) the roadworks which have waited longest to be carried out.
