

Today's Game



Armadale Thistle haven't been frequent visitors to the Canniepairt, indeed this is only the third visit. In all our meetings, home and away, they have proved doughty opponents and today will no doubt be no exception. This characteristic has shone through in their games this season with no fewer than 21 of their 28 games having been drawn or decided by the odd goal.

In an extremely tight competition, Armadale find themselves battling to avoid relegation. One reason they are in this situation is their disappointing start to the campaign which saw them go four league games before scoring a goal. Thistle's form on the road in the autumn was good with only one defeat in seven games but this form dipped and their sequence of games away from home without a win was stretched to seven with last Saturday's 2-1 loss at Newtongrange Star.

The loss at Newtongrange was hard to take. Armadale led at the break and retained this lead until seven minutes from the end when Star forced an equaliser. With four minutes of the allotted five minutes of added-on-time at the end of the 90 minutes, already having elapsed, the home side were awarded a penalty which was converted to leave Armadale pointless. A stushie over the award saw Thistle's Calum Rarity, Martin Jack and substitute Jamie Valentine shown red cards.

Armadale have been missing the injured Brian Roberts, Paddy Donnelly and Scott Brown but have been able to secure the services of some young Hamilton Accies loanees, including Ciaran Johnstone, to boost their squad.

Last Saturday at Downfield, Tayport were without the unavailable Ryan Welsh and the injured Mark Whatley. Ryan is available again but Mark is a wee bit away from being ready to return. Neal Ferrie made a timely return from his loan spell at Carnoustie Panmure when he got a late call to go between the sticks after Ian Ross was ordered off. Neal is unavailable this week, however, due to work commitments. Otherwise Tayport have a full squad from which to select.

Armadale are desperate for points to avoid a return to the South Division from whence they came as champions in 2009. Tayport need to win all their games to retain a glimmer of hope of promotion, so a keen contest should be on the cards

THE MANAGER WRITES





I'd like to extend a very warm welcome to Jim Henderson, his coaching staff, players and all those associated with Armadale Thistle, as they arrive at the Canniepairt for the return fixture between the sides.

Since the turn of the year, Armadale have put in some very good performances and, in many ways, are in a false position, in what is a very tight East Premier League.

We're coming towards the end of the campaign and I've told my players not to look too far ahead. Personally, I'm not trying to plot a course through to the end of the season. The best policy is to take one game at a time and see how far that takes us. I think today's match may prove pivotal for both teams, as we move into the final few fixtures.

Last week's victory against Downfield was pleasing, as they were the form team going into the game, with three wins out of four. So, to win 3-2 and show good battling qualities was very satisfying.

It is strange, though, that we would score eight and concede five in our last four matches. Previously, we had a watertight defence and something of a shot-shy forward line. I'm delighted to now see us scoring goals, but I'm obviously less happy about the uncharacteristic way in which goals have been conceded. However, we've had a chat with a couple of key players in the back-line and, hopefully, normal service can be resumed today.

I should also mention the situation with Neal Ferrie and Kevin Milne. The swap loan deal with Carnoustie was planned to last until the end of the season, but it turned out to be best for all parties to cancel the arrangement. Kevin's work commitments in Aberdeen didn't fit in well with his football, while Neal wasn't playing at Carnoustie.

In a way, fate gave us a helping hand last week, as Neal was able to come on, when Iain Ross was sent off. Small things like that do make a difference, as I am a believer that an element of luck is needed in every game. We hadn't really had the rub of the green this season and that does tend to even itself out, in my opinion. So, hopefully, that was the start of one or two things going in our favour.

Hopefully, we can play well today, get that wee bit of luck, and go on to record a victory.

FROM THE ARCHIVES 2½ YEARS AGO 10 OCTOBER 2009 Sweeping changes for both clubs in only 30 months

There was a time when Tayport's line-ups - and probably Armadale's too - hardly changed from one season to the next, but that's not the case now as we can see from this flashback to the occasion on which the sides last met on the Canniepairt. Only two of the Tayport starting line-up remain at the club whilst Thistle still retain three of their starting team that afternoon

The match was played out as follows

" A Ronnie Kenneth header sent Thistle home frustrated and empty handed as the visitors tempers boiled over at The Canniepairt.

A Ferguson free kick from deep after 65 minutes was played back across goal by McNaughton and Kenneth showed typical predator instinct to net from close range with goalkeeper Wood stranded.

Boss Willie Garner, although surely pleased with the result, will be wondering why his side failed to win a, game they dominated from start to finish with more conviction.

Garner was handed some good news prior to kick off - Stuart Ferguson declared himself fit to play, and Adam O'Connor and Derek Wemyss both took a place on the bench after lengthy absences.

Tayport created the first chance of the game after 10 minutes, but despite rising well above his marker, Scott Hunter couldn't keep his header below the crossbar after Darren Scott's corner had picked him out.

Barry McNaughton was next to try his luck, again Scott the provider, but despite doing well to control his volley, Wood saved comfortably. Scott appeared to be enjoying the freedom Armadale were allowing him, and after breaking through the offside trap, he might feel he could have done better when his square ball found no red jerseys in the box

Despite having the lion's share of possession, Tayport found their opponents resilient, and nearly paid the price for missed chances just before half time. Mauchline found himself with time and space 12 yards from goal, but Fitzpatrick was equal to his effort, parrying the ball to safety.

The game was turned on it's head on the hour mark when 'Dale's Johnstone was sent off after picking up two yellow cards - both being for dissent. The midfielder will no doubt be disappointed in himself after being spoken to by the referee numerous times in between the cautions re his persistent criticism of decisions.

Tayport continued to control the game without making too many clear cut chances, but that changed minutes after the red card when Kenneth grabbed his first goal of the season.

The majority of action however was saved for the final few minutes of the game. First Kenneth latched onto a Ferguson through ball and there were screams for a penalty when he was felled as he pulled the trigger. Referee Duncan however decided rightly the foul had taken place outside the area, and McNaughton's well placed free kick did not have enough power to beat the visiting 'keeper.

Armadale's frustration from chasing shadows was evident, and despite winning a foul in a promising position, Cunningham was then shown his second yellow card of the game for kicking out at Joe Pepper (who came on minutes earlier after fellow substitute Gray had to be carried off) and McCulloch followed him into the showers for protesting the decision too strongly."

DUNMORE REPORTS

The last three fixtures have brought as mixed a set of results as is possible: a draw, a loss and a win, in that order. There was a disastrous four minute spell after the interval and John McGlashan's men suddenly found themselves 3-1 down. Paul Tosh pulled one back, from the penalty spot, after Simon Murray had been fouled and Tosh was unlucky to see a late header cleared off the line. However, over the piece, 'Port had been second

Last week, at Downfield Park, the 3-2 scoreline went in Tayport's favour. Fraser Milligan's energetic pressing of the ball led to him opening the scoring, as early as the fifth minute. Mark Ferrie equalised for the Spiders, with 'Port again conceding from a corner.

Towards half-time, Fraser Milligan was penalised for hand-ball in the box, and Andy Payne netted the penalty. Undaunted, the Canniepairt outfit quickly levelled, courtesy of a sublime lob by Paul Tosh.

A fine break upfield, early in the second half, ended with Tosh netting his second of the afternoon. That counter proved to be the winner, although there remained plenty of time for the game to be reduced to ten-aside. Downfield's Deuchars was the first to see red, while Iain Ross collected his second caution, in injurytime, after his involvement in an old-fashioned goalmouth stramash.



SNIFFING AROUND WITH THE SNOUT

It looks like another famous Junior name will disappear. Bellshill Athletic sold their original ground at Brandon Park which was subsequently developed for housing. They moved to New Brandon Park but have been without a ground since 2009 when they were forced out of the now disused New Brandon Park by its former owner. The current Bellshill Athletic club president, Paul Fox, has blamed the local Council for pushing the club to the brink of closure after pulling the plug on at least three different ground lease proposals. Mr Fox confirmed the 115 year old club would fold within the next few weeks once what little money they have runs out. Tayport played Bellshill on two occasions back in 1997, drawing 1-1 at Bellshill and winning the replay 6-0 on the Canniepairt.

It looks like Scone Thistle will return next season. A series of committee meetings has been very positive and the club looks set to re-join the East Region's North Division next season. They look likely to be joined there by Forfar West End who pulled out of the Super League earlier this season. West End's withdrawal means, of course, that only one team is relegated from the Super League this season.

Tayport travel to Ballingry Rovers on April 14th for their penultimate away fixture in this season's Premier Division. Legendary ex Tayport boss Dave Baikie now holds the reins at Ore Park and he has achieved his first target. Said Baikie, "Our first target here was to steer the club free from relegation and I think we've achieved that..."

The film crews, actors and actresses roll into Tayport next week to film Blue Iris Films' latest production. The crews will be based at the Canniepairt but most of the actual filming will be in other parts of the town, so if you are not careful you could well become an 'extra'! Martyn Robertson, a Port Supporter since the early nineties, is one of those behind the movie.

To take up the slack caused by most clubs rapidly running out of fixtures, it's understood a round robin form of cup competition may be introduced. There are certainly plenty of cups gathering dust in the Association's vaults. Lack of sponsors is very often cited as a reason for withdrawing a cup, but in the circumstances, the lack of a sponsor shouldn't prove too much of an impediment to keeping clubs in action for a few more weeks.

Apparently nobody knows who owns Armadale's Volunteer Park. The ground seems to have been owned most recently by Armadale Thistle FC Ltd, a limited company which was dissolved a few years ago. In these circumstances, it's thought that the ownership could have fallen to the Queen's and Lord Treasurer's Remembrancer, effectively the Crown. West Lothian Council is actively investigating the background and there seems to be a move afoot to bring the ground into community ownership. There seems little doubt that Thistle will remain at Volunteer Park as the Council leader has spoken publicly of the value of such an asset i.e. the ground and its football club, to the community.

Still on the subject of Grounds, our old friends Crook Town FC of the Northern League in England. Already in receipt of £50,000 gift from the late Sir Tom Cowie, former chairman of the Arriva Group and Sunderland FC. The gift allowed Crook Town to take a 125 year lease of their Millfield Park ground from the local County Council. The club has now signed a deal with a developer which will allow supermarkets to make a pitch for their town centre site. Three supermarket chains have expressed an interest and part of the deal will be an ongoing yaer by year sponsorship of the club. Not bad!
