Today's Game Emirates Scottish Cup 2nd round TAYPORT V ARBROATH VICTORIA

This is the first time Tayport and Vics have been drawn together in the Scottish Junior Cup, Indeed, although both clubs have been members of the same local association for some 22 seasons, this afternoon's game will be only the clubs' ninth competitive meeting, and only the fifth on cup business, the most recent being only last season in the semi final of the League Cup.

As three times winners of the Scottish Cup, Tayport are aware they are considered a prize scalp for any club visiting the Canniepairt and Arbroath Vics will be no different. Tayport, therefore, will have to be on their guard against a team which has turned in some decent performances this season and in former Forfar West End striker, Ryan Owbridge, have a player who knows the road to goal with eight to his credit in only ten starts this season. Mark Fotheringham has six and these two players will likely pose the biggest threat to the home side.

Vics ended Lochee Harp's 100% home league record with a 6-1 win last Saturday and by all accounts it could have been more. Craig Watson, starting his first game of the season up front, hit a double and will be looking for a starting jersey today.

Jake Ferrier, Vics experienced manager, will no doubt have a game plan which is set to contain Tayport and look to punish any slackness in the home defence. He will be mindful of Tayport's home record which has been pretty disappointing, with the away teams leaving victorious on three out of five occasions to date this season.

The Tayport support hasn't had much to shout about at home and John McGlashan will no doubt have emphasised to his players of the need to turn territorial advantage into goals. Last week's win at Penicuik took Tayport to the top of the Premier Division table in what was a good team performance. The confidence should flow from this third league win on the bounce without conceding a goal.

Mark Whately is the only home player who has started all eleven games this season and changes again will be made for today's game. Brian Livie is out but Derek Wemyss returns and although Ronnie Kenneth should also be available after missing two games through holidays but a place on the bench is probably all he can expect. Robert Smith missed out last week through injury but could return today. There is the possibility that last week's trialist, Robbie Raeside, could be signed and included in the squad

The first of only three visits to Tayport by Arbroath Vics was way back in 1990 when the visitors were one of the few teams to win at the Canniepairt as Tayport headed for the division 2 championship. It was to be Vics only win over 'Port to date. Let's hope there is no repeat.

TODAY'S VISITORS ARBROATH VICTORIA FC

A warm welcome to the Canniepairt this afternoon to Arbroath Vics, one of Scotland's oldest football clubs having been founded in 1882. In their Centenary Year, 1982, Vics somehow managed to sign George Best for the day and he turned out in their celebratory match v

Arbroath FC at Gayfield (see George in pic elsewhere in programme, 4th from right in front row). What a coup!

For the best part of a century, Vics played in the local Angus Junior League until the Tayside amalgamation in the early 1970s and subsequently in the new East Region on its formation thirty years later.

On reorganisation Vics had a place in the Tayside Premier League but since then have languished in the North League, the Association's third tier.

There are signs, though, that better times are round the corner for Arbroath Vics and with a long and chequered history, there are few who would grudge the Ogilvy Park club some time in the limelight.

THE Scottish Cup is of interest to Junior Football followers as never before since the three Super League winners and Scottish Junior Cup winners gained automatic entry to the Country's national competition. Of course, it came too late for Tayport who would have been invited to participate in the competition on four different occasions within the last ten years and once during the previous decade. Ironically, Tayport FC had pushed for this change for many, many years prior to it actually happening. C'est la vie.

The biggest shock in the second round wasn't provided by a Junior club, however, it was the 4-0 thrashing of Berwick Rangers by Highland League Deveronvale in Banff. Eyebrows might also have been raised a tad by Montrose beating Clyde and Cove going down at Innerleithen. Auchinleck's 8-1 win over Threave emphasised the gulf between the South of Scotland League and Junior Super League level while Irvine Meadow and Bo'ness United both turned in gutsy performances to edge out East of Scotland clubs Edinburgh City and Whitehill Welfare respectively.

The North Super League is generally accepted as being the weakest of the three Super Leagues and the home defeat of Culter by Spartans ended North Junior interest in the competition. This result has been appealed, however, as Culter have claimed that Spartans played an ineligible player. There's a bumper home tie with Partick Thistle awaiting the winner of the appeal.

The three Junior sides missed out on a potentially decent pay day when they weren't drawn against Dundee FC at Dens but all got home draws in the third round. Gary Bollan's Livingston will be favourites at Irvine Meadow as will be currently flying high Cowdenbeath at Bo'ness but there's a great chance of Junior representation when the big boys enter the competition at its next stage, as Auchinleck Talbot will be favourites to account for Vale of Leithen.

League Cup Final

The ACA Central League Cup Final between Hill of Beath and Dundonald Bluebell at Lochgelly was postponed last Sunday when Gardiners Park was declared unplayable following overnight rain. Such are the perils of scheduling Cup Finals as winter approaches.

FROM THE ARCHIVES



AUGUST 1982



1982 was just another year as far as Tayport FC was concerned but it was a big year for Arbroath Vics who were celebrating their Centenary year. To mark this occasion Vics played a match v Arbroath FC at Gayfield Park. Pretty run of the mill stuff, one might think. On the contrary. It turned out to be a memorable match, not just for the fact that Vics beat their Senior neighbours by 4-3, but for the appearance of the legendary George Best in an Arbroath Vics jersey. The Manchester United and Northern Ireland superstar was 36 but still managed 90 minutes and turned in a virtuoso performance.



There was a Tayport connection to the day. In the Vics' line-up above are two players who went on to give Tayport FC sterling service, reaching 'Port's first Scottish Junior Cup final twelve years later.

Indeed the players, Andy Sommerville and Jimmy Hunter, were Tayport's first purchases, when signed from Downfield during season 1990/91. Manager Baikie realised by mid season, if Tayport were to go up, then the team needed strengthening and Andy and Jimmy were identified as that strength and negotiations were opened to bring them to the Canniepairt.

The then 22 year old Jimmy is second from the right in the front row and 21 year old Andy is third from right in the back row.

Meanwhile in Tayport that August, Tayport FC, a mere 35 years old, and the previous season's Midlands Amateur champions, were losing 6-0 at home to Harris FP in the first game in defence of their title. Playing for 'Port that afternoon was Gus Malone, later also to wear the colours of Arbroath Vics.

DUNMORE REPORTS.....

Over the course of the last couple of matches, Tayport have moved to the top of the East Premier League, courtesy of narrow wins against Ballingry and Penicuik.

Against Ballingry, a fortnight ago, it was an early James Russell goal which won the points. Having earned a second minute free kick, Russell stepped up to sweep the set-piece into the corner of the net, to give Tayport an ideal start.

Unfortunately, 'Port could not add to the tally, with visiting 'keeper Jamie Roberts making a couple of notable stops to deny Jamie Mackie and also Russell, whose 21st minute penalty kick was kept out by the Ballingry custodian.

There were other opportunities for Tayport, but it was not their day in front of goal. The same looked like happening last week, at Penicuik. In that match, it was a late Jamie Mackie counter which won the points. With 80 minutes on the clock, Mackie, who had come off the bench, latched onto a Paul Tosh flick to send a first-time finish into the back of the net for what proved to be the winner.

Cuikie had probably edged the first half and missed a golden chance to open the scoring, before half-time. Top scorer Johnny Harvey found himself through on goal, but, rather than shoot, he elected to attempt to take the ball around Iain Ross. That was Harvey's mistake. Ross managed to get down and push the ball clear, keeping his goal intact.

Tayport had the better of the second period, going close on a few occasions before Mackie struck. Perhaps 'Port have not been making the most of their opportunities during matches, but the whole team deserves great praise for what is a formidable defensive record. All of the players seem to be taking a pride in shutting the opposition out and that has been the foundation on which the recent wins have been built.

John McGlashan's men will be tested again today, by an Arbroath Vics side which scored six goals last weekend. An intriguing match is in prospect, as is usually the case on Scottish Junior Cup day.

SNIFFING AROUND WITH THE SNOUT

As expected, Forfar West End calamitous season was confirmed last week when the East Region FA accepted the Strathmore Park club's request to go into abeyance. All their players now automatically become free agents and the club will have to start at the bottom, playing in next season's North Division. All results to date involving Forfar in this season's Super League have been expunged and only one club will be relegated. It's perhaps a sign of the times that West End is the third former Tayside club to withdraw from the East Region this season following Scone Thistle and Arbroath SC. Since we joined the Juniors just over 20 years ago, in addition to the three mentioned, Elmwood, St Josephs, Stobswell, and Balbeggie have disappeared.

In this time Fife has lost five - Tulliallan, Leven, Jubilee Athletic, Halbeath and Clackmannan. During this time only Bonnybridge have gone from the original East Region. Preston and Ormiston moved to the East of Scotland Senior League. It's a worrying trend for Junior Football on Tayside.

There is much unhappiness in clubs in the East Region's third tier, particularly the South Division over the fact that only one team is promoted. from a league which now has 15 clubs. The North Division has 11 clubs and the Central Division has 13 clubs. It's a situation which the clubs, understandably, find unsatisfactory and a further re-structure of the East Region is on the agenda.

Tayport received a bye into the last 16 of the East of Scotland Cup. The situation came about through Forfar West End's withdrawal from the Association. West End had made the 2nd round with a 1st round win over Rosyth on penalties after a 2-2 draw. The first name out of the hat received a bye and Tayport's name was first out.

It is with some regret that Tayport FC will not be staging their annual bonfire and firework display on Guy Fawkes Night this year. The Canniepairt event has been a fixture for the past 30 years but a combination of circumstances this year, not least of which is the increasingly significant impact of the free counter attractions over the Tay Bridge at Lochee Park and Baxter Park in Dundee, led the committee to take this decision.

Some Penicuik fans didn't half get their knickers in a twist after last week's game. They were quickly on the Pie & Bovril website with all the reasons why they didn't take something from the game. The referee got pelters. They claimed that Penicuik gifted Tayport possession. That Tayport were guilty of time wasting. All Tayport did was lump the ball up the park. Big time Charlies. These were some of the comments. Needless to say some contributors with Tayport sympathies took a different view. As a Penicuik poster finally said 'forget about the game, whether it was 1-0 or 10-0 we still lost.'

Junior clubs participation in the Scottish Senior Cup could well be placed in jeopardy with word from the SFA that in future, clubs will likely require to be licensed. A ground would require to meet certain criteria before it could be licensed and ties would only be permitted on licensed grounds. There is little doubt that obtaining a licence will be a very costly exercise for the vast majority of Junior clubs
