ACA Sports Premier Division TAYPORT v DOWNFIELD

We've waited a long time to meet Downfield in a league fixture. Almost ten years in fact, back in May 2002 when the sides drew 0-0 in a Tayside League game, the corresponding fixture at Kirkton ending in a 4-1 win for Port the previous August. Although the sides have met on four occasions since, that 2001 meeting was the last occasion on which Tayport played at Downfield Park.

The last meeting, though, was here in May 2007 when Tayport won 3-1 in a Challenge Cup tie. The Spiders have three survivors from that day, Kris Rollo, Andy Payne and John Holt. Tayport, too, have only three players in the current squad from that day. Of the three, it's likely only Roberto Morris will start. Ronnie Kenneth, suffering from a post holiday virus, will likely be on the bench and the other, Brian Livie is unavailable.

Manager Scott Lindsay worked hard on a tight budget to achieve promotion last season and despite their current league placing, there is much evidence that his side is adjusting quickly to life in the second tier. Apart from the opening day 3-0 defeat at Newtongrange Star, the other three defeats have been by the odd goal. It all came together in their most recent league outing, however, with a 3-0 win over Armadale at Downfield Park.

The Spiders' have a safe keeper in Gary Thain and up front there is no shortage of firepower with Kit Bremner and Simon Murray regularly amongst the goals. It won't have escaped Tayport manager John McGlashan's attention either that Downfield were responsible for the 1st round exit of Super League Carnoustie from the East of Scotland Cup, twice coming from behind to draw level then hold their nerve to win the shoot-out.

Tayport look like being without new signing Robbie Raeside who was injured in training but Robert Smith who missed last week through injury could be back in contention. Jamie Mackie was on Norrie's treatment table during the week but the former Raith Rover should be available.

TODAY'S VISITORS DOWNFIELD FC

A warm welcome to the Canniepairt this afternoon to our old adversaries with whom we have had many a keen contest over the years but this is the first in the league since reconstruction.

Downfield FC was founded in 1912 so next year is a big year for The Spiders, with a centenary to celebrate. The early years were lean, very lean indeed with little to cheer about, the records showing that a Dundee Junior League Division 2 championship in 1925, a Telegraph Cup win in 1934 and a Barrie Consolation Cup win in 1934 was all there was to show for their first 50 years existence.

All was to change in 1963/64 though when the Spiders picked up five trophies in a season - the Courier Cup, the Telegraph Cup, the Forfarshire Junior Cup, the Laing Cup and the Dundee Junior League Championship.

Another fairly lean period ensued and it wasn't until the late eighties that Downfield again became a club with which to be reckoned with a hat-trick of Tayside titles from 1988 - 90 and Scottish Cup runs which brought the club's name to the fore across the country.

Downfield ran out of steam during the 1990s and failed to make the Super League in 2002. They slipped into the third tier a couple of times but under manager Scott Lindsay they've clawed their way out of the North Division as champions last season, edging out North End by the most slender of margins and are looking to establish themselves in the Premier Division.

There have been Tayport/Downfield connections ever since Tayport joined the Juniors. Tayport's first manager, Dave Baikie was recruited from Downfield where he had been player/coach under the Grier brothers. Baikie brought striker Kevin Thoms from Downfield and during his first season persuaded the Tayport committee to dig into their coffers to sign a further two players, Jimmy Hunter and Andy Sommerville, who were to become key acquisitions for Tayport on their road to success.

Off the field, too, there are Tayport/Spiders connections. Alex Duncan, the Spiders' hard working chairman, spent some time at Tayport in a coaching capacity during the club's amateur days and Spiders' secretary Phil Hart's brother Alan served Tayport for many years as a player and committee member.



The Tayport v Downfield Scottish Cup Epic

Nineteen years ago next Spring is the anniversary of one of the most memorable Junior cup ties of modern times when Tayport and Downfield were drawn together in the quarter final of the Scottish Junior Cup. It was a tie which captivated the local football public and attracted 6,829 fans to the three games spread over four weeks.

Downfield, under the shrewd management of the Grier brothers, had been set to dominate the Junior game locally but a fast emerging Tayport, under the management of Dave Baikie, a former Downfield player/coach under the Griers, put paid to any such aspirations which the Spiders may have cherished.

Tayport were first out of the hat and the tie went ahead on 3rd April 1993 at the Canniepairt. The tie finished goalless and the archive records "Quite an occasion although game never reached the heights. Dearth of goalmouth action. All records broken. Attendance - 2,150"

through Montgomery (2) home side three minutes and Archer.

TAYPORT — O DOWNFIELD — O NERVES played a big part in making this derby one to forget. With both teams desperate for a semi-final spot, players were reluctant to risk making a mistake. In blustery conditions, Tayport were first on the attack and Downfield keeper Clark stopped Sommerville's header. Downfield's Cargill looked hevy and a snapshot went just wide of the post, then an inswinging shot from Tayport's Devine was again well hold by Clark.

After the break, Tayport looked the more dangerous side and Sommerville seat another shot over the bar.

Tayport forced three late corners, but Downfield held firm to earn a replay.

The replay at Downfield Park scheduled for the following week, 10th April, was postponed be-

cause of a waterlogged pitch and went ahead on 17 April. Dave Reilly gave Tayport a 19 minute lead but John Young equalised from a penalty kick in 36mins.

Archive records "Moral victory for Tayport, perhaps, after Andy [Sommerville] sent off for second booking on hour mark. Tayport were the better side, though and should be through. [Tayport] secretary and [Tayport] treasurer (AO & RR) didn't see much of game as had to do a gate and help count all gate receipts. Attendance - 1,909. Tayport's cut £1,115. No Tayside league games played today"

TAYPORT Clinched a semi-final place after this marathon Cup tic.
This was their third meeting and both sides had their chances, although layport were more than their chances, although layport were to minutes when Downfield defender Price and keeper Clark got into a taugle and Dave Reilly sipped in to slide the ball home and set up a meeting with Auchinleck.

And, so, on to a third game. The very last time a Scottish Junior Cup tie would go to a second replay. North End Park was the venue with 2,770 crammed into the Dokens' ground. Tayport finally made to the semifinal thanks to Dave Reilly's 56th minute goal and subsequently recorded their memorable win over Auchinleck to reach the final. The Archive records "Tayport were always the better side. This was a bit more open game with both sides missing chances"

Postscript

Keeper Clark is of course Tayport's current goalkeeping coach Grant Clark who served the Spiders with distinction for many years.

DUNMORE REPORTS

Early on, James Russell settled any nerves with a trademark free kick, after Jamie Mackie had pressured the 'keeper into handling outside his area. The crucial second counter was scored by Paul Tosh, from closerange, after Grant Manzie had capitalised on a slip in the defence to fire the ball across goal.

With Tayport dominating, Vics lost their discipline somewhat and forward Craig Watson got himself ordered off, before half-time.

Ten minutes after the break, Vics conceded a penalty, with Grant Manzie fouled, just after shooting. Paul Tosh stepped up to convert the spot kick and, at that point, victory was secured.

On the hour, Derek Wemyss conceded a penalty, but lain Ross saved from Garry McFarlane and instigated a break upfield, which ended with Jamie Mackie slotting home Tayport's fourth.

Kevin Durno then received his marching orders, leaving the visitors with just nine men. Given the numerical advantage, it was a case of one-way traffic for the remainder of the match. Grant Manzie twice netted, only to be foiled by the assistant's offside flag. However, Stefan Elvin's effort did count. He rifled the ball into the net, following a well-worked corner, to complete the 5-0 win.

Let's hope that 'Port can continue to build on this good run of form when they get back to East Premier League duty today, against Downfield.
