Today's Game

ACA SPORTS PREMIER DIVISION TAYPORT v NEWTONGRANGE STAR

Relegated from the Super League along with ourselves at the end of last season, Newtongrange have not been finding it particularly easy in a very competitive Premier League where only 14 points separate top from bottom more than halfway through the campaign.

Unlike ourselves Newtongrange got their season off to a flier and reached the final of the South League Cup where they lost to Linlithgow Rose. Like Tayport, however, their league form to date has been a bit patchy with two wins, two draws and two defeats in their last six outings. Tayport's last six league games have yielded five draws and a defeat so a win is maybe overdue.

Something's got to give today. Newtongrange have hit the back of their opponents' net on every league game on the road this season to date, but have yet to score in three visits to Tayport. Scottish Cup ties in 2006 and 2010 saw Nitten go down by the only goal of the game on both occasions and last season in the Super League it was 2-0 for Tayport. Goals certainly have not been in short supply for Newtongrange in their previous two visits to Tayside in the league this season with resounding wins recorded at Broughty (5-2) and more recently a 7-1 win at Downfield.

Both clubs have freshened up their squads following the enforced winter break. Tayport have brought in defender Gary Robertson in a swap deal with Violet which saw Grant Manzie go to Glenesk and a new strike force is in place. Simon Murray, who had been on loan at Downfield, arrived



from Montrose FC and Kevin Milne arrived on loan from Carnoustie Panmure with keeper Neal Ferrie going on loan to the Gowfers until the end of the season. Milne makes his home debut this afternoon

Newtongrange have splashed the cash this week to bring in the talented striker Chris King (pictured) who has scored 14 goals for Super League side Musselburgh this season and has averaged almost a goal a game in just over 100 outings for the Olive Bank club, including a crucial free kick goal here last season. King was signed for Linlithgow by Dave Baikie but didn't always get a regular starting jersey and it wasn't too long before he was back at Musselburgh.

Tayport welcome back in their squad last week's absentees Gary Robertson, Derek Wemyss, Ronnie Kenneth, James Russell and Andy McDonald.

THE MANAGER WRITES





I'd like to begin by extending a very warm welcome to Alan Miller and all those connected with Newtongrange Star.

This is our second meeting of the season and the first encounter resulted in a very good victory for us. Since then, both teams have huffed and puffed a bit and that just goes to show how difficult and competitive the East Premier League is. There are no easy games, with most being finely balanced.

Last Saturday at Sauchie was a case in point. In my opinion, we were the better team, but came away with a defeat. I thought we created good opportunities and were unfortunate not to score on a couple of occasions. These chances were well-crafted, which, ironically, is more pleasing than relying on defensive lapses like the one we capitalised on for our second goal at Newtongrange.

Going back to last weekend's match, it has to be said that the surface was terrible. Both sets of players deserve great credit for trying to play football on that pitch.

One thing that gladdened my heart on Saturday was to see a group of Tayport supporters show their appreciation at the end of the game. It's easy to be critical and find lots of negatives, but it is more difficult and more beneficial to find positives.

Criticism is part and parcel of football and if it is constructive, it can be used to motivate and to improve. It's harder to deal with negative criticism, especially for young players and it's worth mentioning that we had what was possibly our youngest ever starting XI on the field last Saturday.

Ourselves and Newtongrange were both relegated from the Super League last season and were fancied to be to the fore during the campaign. Both clubs are going through a transitional period and that brings ups and downs.

My message for the Tayport supporters is to stick with us. The players are training really hard and our aim is to win each and every one of our nine remaining games. Everybody in our dressing room has the belief that we can do just that.





