## Today's Game



### EMIRATES SCOTTISH JUNIOR CUP R.2 TAYPORT v ANNBANK UNITED

It's a warm welcome to our visitors Annbank United who are only the fourth club ever from Ayrshire to have visited the Canniepairt. Muirkirk, Irvine Meadow, Cumnock and Glenafton all failed to make Scottish Cup progress here so there's extra incentive for both clubs today.

Annbank, like ourselves, started the season with a league cup campaign and, again like ourselves, failed to make it to the knock-out stage, winning two (Girvan and Craigmark) and losing three (Maybole, Troon and Whitletts).

The wet weather has seen three of their league games postponed. All five league fixtures played have been close affairs but an away win at Ardeer has been the only full pointer to date. Things have shown signs of picking up, however, with the most recent fixture being a credible win at Shettleston in the 1st round of the West of Scotland Cup.

It's been all change at New Pebble Park with manager Wullie Fisher and his assistant Duncan George placing the accent on youth with no fewer than nine under 21s in their squad, a number of whom are in their first season with the club.

Annbank have found the back of their opponents' net in each of their past nine games with Tommy Sloan, formerly with Mossblown AFC, the main goal threat with six goals this season including the crucial strike at Shettleston. Fellow striker 19 year old Scott Johnston has weighed in with four goals in four starts and Craig Fisher another recruit from Mossblown has netted four goals from midfield. Experience is provided by defenders Lee Holland and the long serving Ian Connolly (pictured)



The inspecting referee at Dundee Violet last week declared that it was touch and go whether the Glenesk pitch was playable but he decided it wasn't leaving us disappointed but the manager managed to fix a friendly v Forfar West End at Dundee ISC. It was a good work-out giving most of the players some game time. There are still injury doubts over Fraser Milligan and Stefan Elvin but Martin Strachan is close to a return. Paul Tosh returns after holiday and Steven McPhee is back after suspension. Jamie Mackie, however, misses out following his red card v Glenrothes. He also misses the following two games at Dunbar and Jeanfield.

The heavy rain during the week saturated the park but some surface water was removed and hopefully the remainder has drained away to allow this afternoon's game to go ahead.



## THE MANAGER WRITES



I'd like to start by offering everyone associated with Annbank United a cordial welcome to the Canniepairt, for today's Emirates Scottish Junior Cup 2nd round tie.

We were disappointed at last week's postponement, as I felt we had a good chance of going to Violet and continuing our positive run of results. At least we managed to arrange a friendly against Forfar West End, on the astro at the DISC, at short notice. With the exception of the injured players, the whole squad participated. While many teams were inactive, we had a semi-competitive game and I hope that will stand us in good stead for today's encounter. Often, when there is a free week, the players can become ring rusty, so I hope we've avoided that.

As far as the Scottish Cup is concerned, after our first round win against West Calder, I'd be surprised if any of our players will ever take a team lightly again. I had drummed it into them even before that match that cup football regularly provides upsets, at all levels. We were nearly caught out in that last tie.

Any team we play, be it in the East Region or further afield, will be a serious test for us. We are not good enough to expect to win every week by just turning up. With that in mind, we must ensure that we approach this, and every match, in the correct manner.

In my experience, I've yet to see any Ayrshire team anything less than 100% committed and with some top class players. You can be sure that Annbank will be in the same mould.

In cup ties, playing at home is always an advantage. The home team is familiar with the surroundings, does not have the problem of sitting on a bus for long a journey and, more importantly, will have the backing of the home support.

That backing is vital. The players have spoken about the tremendous support they have received from the sidelines this season, even during sticky spells within games. I would urge everyone connected with the club to show their appreciation for both sets of players today and get behind our lads at every opportunity, over the course of the entire ninety minutes. That support does make a difference.

## Today's visitors

### Annbank United

We welcome Annbank United from South Ayrshire to the Canniepairt this afternoon for their first ever visit to Tayport. This is our 140th Scottish Cup match and the first ever, back in 1990, was also against a South Ayrshire side, Muirkirk, who were also from a former mining community. Tayport won 2-0 that day and will be hoping to repeat that success.

Annbank play in the West of Scotland Region's Ayrshire District League at New Pebble Park, their home for the past 63 years. The record attendance at New Pebble Park, never to be surpassed, was 11,007 who witnessed the Scottish Cup tie v Kilbirnie Ladeside in 1952

The following season, 1952/53, was Annbank's most memorable, when they reached the final of the Scottish Junior Cup at Hampden Park. The Bankies lost that day by 1-0 to Vale of Leven, a game which attracted a crowd of 55,800, the sixth biggest ever attendance for a Junior game. Another figure which will never be surpassed.

These times are but memories now, with recent years having failed to yield much in the way of silverware. A South Ayrshire Cup win in 1998 is the club's most recent success. Not that Annbank had been in the doldrums, though. As recently as 2010/2011 they were playing in the second tier of the West Region, the Super League first division. Last season they recorded their record score, beating Craigmark Burntonians by 12-1 in a cup tie.

Annbank's Scottish Junior Cup record over the past ten years has been quite impressive.

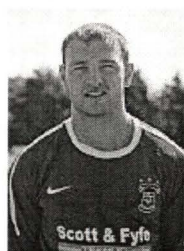

Last season, for example, Annbank won on the road at Islavale and Kello before holding eventual finalists Shotts Bon Accord to a 2-2 draw before being eliminated in the replay which had to be played at Lugar.

Two seasons ago there were impressive 3-2 and 5-2 wins respectively at Sunnybank and Dundonald Bluebell before elimination by Irvine Meadow in a replay.

Annbank haven't lost in a visit to Fife since Tayport joined the Junior ranks over twenty years ago.. Having previously won at Kirkcaldy and Dundonald, the Ayrshire club will be looking to maintain that run and record the hat-trick at our expense today.



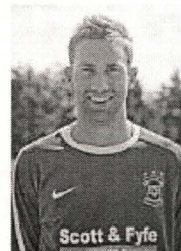

## 26 YEARS AGO

### Spotlight on the ALLIANCE TEAM

## 1986/87

In season 1986/87 Tayport's Alliance team was playing in the Midlands AFA. They had a pretty good league season but were pipped for the title by the now defunct Dundee YMCA. On 1st November 1986, the team, which was having a good league run, returned from Longforgan (another club now gone) having recorded a 1-0 win thanks to a first half goal by Sandy Hamilton.

The line-up was Kenny McRitchie, John Aitken, Davie Blair, Jim Hutchison, Andy McCann, Lyall Clark, Bryan Fitchet, Sandy Hamilton, Alan Hart, George Shepherd and Stevie Moyes. Alan McDade and Billy Moyes were the subbies.

Not surprisingly nobody in the team is still playing regularly although some provided the backbone of the team which travelled to Belgium earlier this year to play in a Veterans' Tournament eg John Aitken, Alan Hart, Alan McDade and Stevie Moyes.

Most of the players are still around these parts. John Aitken, for example is on the club's committee, Hutch is a well known caddy at St Andrews and Andy McCann (pictured) is now a Chief Inspector in the Tayside Police. Indeed it was Andy who decided not to arrest the Naked Rambler earlier this year, cleverly allowing him to ramble out of Tayside Police's jurisdiction into Fife.



### Some of the season's highlights

- Keeper Kenny McRitchie kept clean sheets in each of the first 4 games

- Scott Crichton netted a hat-trick in a 3-0 win over Tayside Fire Brigade and is still waiting on the match ball
- Stevie Moyes bagged 4 goals in the 6-0 home win over Morgan FP (but everybody probably knows that anyway!!)
