Our visitors have made a sound start to the season with a 100 % record from their two away games to date, at Lochee United and last week, at Armadale. The Mariners collected three points at home to Sauchie but were disappointed to lose 2-0 to defending champions Linlithgow Rose two weeks ago. Camelon were relegated in 2004/05 but bounced right back as champions and although they have flirted with relegation on a couple of occasions since, there has been steady improvement and a third place finish last season was the club's best since 2009 when they finished runners-up to Bonnyrigg Rose.

Manager Danny Smith, the former Linlithgow Rose favourite, is gradually shaping his team to his own specification but still relies on a core of experienced campaigners who have been around Carmuirs for a number of seasons.

Forwards Colin Allison and Blair Bachelor, midfielders Craig Young and Mark Gillespie, long serving defender Bryan Bell and tough as teak central defender Stuart Cringean, for example, are no strangers to The Canniepairt.

Manager Smith has made a couple of astute signing this season in a bid to galvanise his championship challenge. Former Raith Rovers defender Colin Leiper was signed from Bathgate Thistle and striker James Donaldson arrived from Bo'ness United.

Tayport's results this season to date have been far from impressive, but with a number of new signings, a settling in period was probably inevitable. There have been flashes of promising play in most fixtures but a failure to capitalise on reasonable scoring opportunities

has kept the side on the back foot.

Chopping and changing hasn't helped either with enforced absences through holiday commitments etc and missing this week is Grant Lawson. On the plus side Paul Thomson is back and will no doubt start today.

#### THE MANAGER WRITES





I want to begin by extending a warm welcome to everyone associated with Camelon, as they visit the Canniepairt for today's Super League fixture. I hope it will be a good footballing encounter. It will also be a tough one, as I've spoken to a few people in the game who see Camelon as a team which could be looking to finish in the top four this season.

So far, although we've come unstuck in three out of the four matches, it's very pleasing to see the number of chances that we're creating and I'm sure we'll soon start converting these chances into goals on a regular basis. It would be a bigger worry if we were defending for ninety minutes, but that's not been the case.

I know it must be frustrating for the supporters, who've waited a few years for Tayport to get back into the top flight, to see us lose a local derby against Lochee United. I can understand those feelings, but this is a new Tayport team. We're not back in this division because we're Tayport. We're back because this team has earned the right to play Super League football.

Everyone associated with the club is doing their utmost to give us the best chance of competing at this level. The road will be rocky and steep, but I fervently believe that we will improve as the season progresses. As much as I would have liked a better start, there are still 26 matches to go and a lot of points to play for.

I appreciate the backing we've had from the supporters, as I think the fans realise that having a young team is the only way forward. We have to live within our means and I believe we're all the better for it. The other route of a mad dash to success is not sustainable. I want Tayport to be around for the long term and I believe that this group of players will be successful in the long term. So, I don't intend to change tack.

To finish, I want to mention our captain, Stefan Elvin, who is set to play his last home game this afternoon. He has decided to pursue his career as a personal trainer on the cruise liners and I fully support his decision, although I'm obviously sad that he'll be leaving us. He'll be missed on and off the pitch. Stefan is one of the finest midfielders that I've had the pleasure of working with. He is a manager's dream. Everyone at the club wishes him all the very best

and we hope to see him in Tayport colours again in the future.

DUNMORE REPORTS....

Four games into the Super League campaign, Tayport have found the going tough, collecting one point so far.

The season began with a trip to Musselburgh, who came out with all guns blazing and roared to a three goal lead, after only half an hour. Striker Paul Harvey was the star for the home side, netting a hat-trick, his third goal coming from the penalty spot.

Thereafter, Tayport began to compete and had a couple of chances before the break. Not long after the interval, John McGlashan's men reduced the leeway. Jake Mair led a break upfield, Ross Grant had an effort on goal and Paul Thomson knocked the ball into the net from close range.

There were further opportunities for the visitors, with Kenny McCulley twice unlucky, but there was no more scoring.

In a midweek fixture on the Canniepairt, St. Andrews United were the visitors for a local derby. Again, the opposition made the better start, with Barry Sibanda setting up Gary Sutherland for the opener, after only three minutes.

Towards half-time, wonderful skill from Steven McPhee on the right led to the equaliser. After twisting and turning to make space for himself, McPhee sent over a cross which eluded the 'keeper and went into the net, off the far post.

The match proved to be an enthralling one. Stefan Elvin twice hit the woodwork and Steven McPhee did likewise, late on, but the points were shared.

Next up was another home fixture, although this one proved to be a much more mundane affair. Visiting Armadale Thistle scored a late goal in each half, to record a 2-0 win and leave the Tayport contingent feeling rather disgruntled.

Last weekend saw 'Port take on Lochee United at Thomson Park, where there was a more spirited performance. Steven McPhee was a real threat to the Lochee rearguard and Grant Lawson was unfortunate on a couple of occasions, against one of his former clubs.

Crucially, it was Lochee who netted the first goal of the afternoon. Phil Hagan set up Brian Clark, who drilled his shot into the corner of the net. The Bluebells added a second goal, in the second half, when Greg Kirk headed home a wide free kick. To rub salt into the wounds, Hagan added his name to the scoresheet, as the hosts took full advantage of their chances.

Hopefully, Tayport can do something similar today and announce themselves on the Super League stage.



#### ALL CHANGE IN THE EAST REGION

Eleven years after the advent of the Super League concept, the East Region clubs voted to restructure their league set-up for this season with a 16-16-15 format which accommodates a Super League, a Premier League, a North League and a South League.

The league cups which had traditionally kicked off the season have been ditched. No surprise there, as it was often many months before the final of what was supposed to be a short sharp tournament, could be played. The absence of a league cup has allowed the league campaigns to kick off from day one. Given that most clubs will be playing eight more league games in the new format, the league cup had to go.

With no relegation last season, the Super League was a disappointing affair but the addition of the Premier League's top four, Newtongrange Star, Ballingry Rovers, Tayport and Armadale should make for a more exciting 16 club competition this time round.

The bottom two clubs will be relegated automatically and the team finishing third bottom will be given a lifeline and an opportunity to retain their Super League place by playing off against the team which finishes third in the re-structured 16 club Premier Division.

The Premier Division has seen Kirrie Thistle, Montrose Roselea, Kinnoull, Kirkcaldy YM, Pumpherston, Fauldhouse United, Livingston United and Arniston Rangers join the eight remaining clubs of last season's Premier Division.

Forfar West End would have been there at the exclusion of Montrose had they not been deducted six points for going into abeyance the previous season. Indeed these six points would have given them the Championship.

With four teams being relegated, 25% of the division, it's going to be a tough competition.

That leaves the North League and the South League with 16 and 15 clubs respectively and the top two from each will be promoted to the Premier League. There had to be a geographical line drawn somewhere and that's why we find the likes of Lochore Welfare and Lochgelly Albert in different divisions, Lochore in the North and Lochgelly in the South. Depending on which clubs are promoted and relegated at the end of the season, some west of Fife clubs could be bouncing about Divisions from season to season in order to ensure the Divisions have an equal or nearly equal number of teams. Plenty variety, then.

From last season's complement of clubs there is a net loss of one team. Spartans' Junior side has moved to the East of Scotland League, thus allowing their parent club to compete in the new Lowland League, and Bankfoot Athletic have gone into abeyance for a season. Whether or not they will return remains to be seen. There is some good news, however, with Kennoway Star Hearts leaving the amateurs to play in the North Division. The successful Kennoway amateur team has joined forces with Star Hearts and will play out of Star of Markinch's Treaton Park.

#### FROM THE ARCHIVES

109 Years Ago

#### EVENING TELEGRAPH AND POST MONDAY 3 OCTOBER 1904

Here's how Monday 3 October 1904's Evening Tele reported the Junior match between Tayport and Thornton Rovers 111 years ago

The roughest game ever seen at Tayport was the opinion of all who witnessed the match between Thornton Rovers and Tayport on Saturday.

It was apparent from the very beginning that the game was to be a fast one, and before many minutes' play the referee was issuing warnings, one of the backs being the chief offender.

Subsequently the game was several times interrupted by the very questionable tactics of the visitors and free fights were engaged in, the referee being powerless.

It is to the credit of one or two of the visitors that they did their utmost to soothe the offenders and the game was resumed.

But the homesters were putting plenty of vim into their play, especially the two Oswalds and a third point was added by Campbell, catching a beautiful pass from Wilkie and banging it into the net.

The unruly scenes still continued and it was a relief when the whistle sounded, finishing up the roughest game ever seen at Tayport with the scores standing Tayport 3 Thornton Royers 1

#### EVENING TELEGRAPH AND POST FRIDAY 20 MAY 1927

..and there was a lack of pitches in Tayport 86 years ago, according to the Tele

Some controversy was raised some time ago when it was agreed that the pitch would be granted to the two teams week about, so it looks as if the Thistle were the rightful ones for Saturday first.

At the same time it is now time that steps were taken by the proper parties to have all the difficulties overcome, especially where there is sufficient space to have another pitch made, and so keep each club on friendly terms with the other. With the close almost here, it could be made and by August it could be all over.

#### **NEW SEASON... NEW FACES**

The last issue of our match programme was away back at the beginning of May and production difficulties prevented an issue for our first home Saturday game, so this is a first opportunity to provide an update. There have been a few changes in our playing staff over the Summer.

Off to pastures new has gone goalkeeper Neal Ferrie who has joined Carnoustie Panmure. Neal joined from North End in the Spring of 2010 and played 56 times, including all but three of the games played by the club in season 2011/2012.

Blair Mudie moved on to Forfar West End after one season at The Canniepairt during which time he played in all but two of last season's games. Stephen Tront is playing amateur football after an employment change restricted his football commitments.

Biggest loss, however, was undoubtedly Simon Murray who went adventuring to Australia in June. Ace marksman Simon netted around 40% of the team's goals last season, 27 from only 25 starts.

John McGlashan has brought in six new faces. Striker Matthew Adam (20) joined from Forfar Athletic, defender Ruaridh Donaldson (19) from Forfar West End, midfielder Ross Grant (23) from Lochee United, midfielder Grant Lawson (26) from Dundee Violet, midfielder Ryan Suttie (22) from St Andrews United and defender Alistair Smith (19) from Forfar Athletic.
