MUSSELBURGH ATHLETIC

Musselburgh haven't been the most frequent of visitors to the Canniepairt as their promotion to the Super League coincided with Tayport's yo-yoing between Super and Premier Leagues. Since being promoted in 2009 and reaching the final of the Scottish Cup in 2011, Musselburgh have established themselves as residents in Musselburgh the top tier.

There were hopes that the Scottish Cup exploits of 2011 when they took Auchinleck to extra time before losing 2-1, would be repeated this season but Glenafton Athletic Armadale Thistle 2 - 3 Musselburgh put paid to those dreams when they won 4-1 in last Musselburgh Saturday's 4th round tie at Olivebank. The home side Musselburgh actually too the lead before the Ayrshire men took over to go through to the last 16.

Like Tayport, Musselburgh brought in a number of new faces this season but prolific scorer Matti King, who has netted a goal every other game in his 200 odd games for Musselburgh the club, remains a fixture on the Olivebank teamsheet Musselburgh every week.

Among the new faces are 20 year old defender Chris Musselburgh Moffat who had three years at St Johnstone and Michael Hunter who signed from East Stirlingshire with whom he played 56 games in the past two seasons.

Another newcomer in manager David McGlynn's squad Edinburgh Utd 1-1 Musselburgh * this season is centre half Brian Martin who was a member of the Haddington Athletic team which lost to Musselburgh Tayport in the East of Scotland Cup back in 2010.

Midfielder Brian Murray will be absent through suspension, as will Tayport's Ryan Suttie who is banned Musselburgh for two games after accumulating too many bookings Musselburgh since the start of the season.

Manager Dave Baikie has a number of options in replacing Suttie in the starting line-up with John Tonner, Ross Grant and former Scottish Schoolboy internationalist Connaire Connelly all coming into the frame.

DUNMORE REPORTS

Tayport produced another memorable Scottish Cup performance to oust Hill o'Beath from the national competition last Saturday, in what was a cracking game on the Canniepairt.

Recently, we've been bemoaning the fact that decisions have been going against us. It was the same on Saturday, with two harsh dismissals and a few other strange calls during the ninety minutes, but the players rose to the challenge and thoroughly deserved to secure their place in the last sixteen.

The Haws opened the scoring through Craig Smart, but 'Port hit back courtesy of skipper Grant Lawson. Full of confidence, Lawson cut in from the right and fired a left-footer into the bottom corner from around twenty yards out, just before the half hour mark.

Then goalkeeper Sam Morris took centre stage. After the re-start, a Hill o'Beath attack faltered and Sam collected the ball inside his box. In the immediate aftermath of an equaliser, the general shout was for Sam to calm things down. He did much better than that, launching his kick upfield and watching in delight as the ball bounced over his opposite number and into the net, to give Tayport the lead. It was a moment that will be remembered for many years to come.

A lapse just before the break allowed Gareth Wardlaw to level the score, but Tayport retained belief that they could win the tie. Early in the second half, that belief was strengthened, when Grant Lawson curled home a stunning goal from the edge of the area, making it 3-2.

Dale Robertson's red card, for what was deemed to be a last-man challenge, was a blow, but at least the referee didn't award a penalty, which, for a moment, was a real concern. Morris tipped the free kick over the bar and the ten men were able to hold out comfortably. After playing one short for forty minutes, Tayport were reduced to nine in injury-time, with the hard-working Kris Rollo given a second yellow card.

Tayport had, however, earned their right to be in Sunday's fifth round draw and the players deserve great credit for that achievement.

FROM THE ARCHIVES

Tayport....the football club

67 YEARS AGO

6 August 1947

Although Tayport Violet were playing in the Midlands AFA, they were joined in 1947 in the Midlands AFA by another Tayport team, Tayport Amateurs, the club we have to-day. This is possibly the present club's first ever line-up.

v Port Albion on 6 August 1947 the East Common at 7.30pm, the Tayport team lined up Campsie; A Pattie, Wighton; Rae, O.Pattie, Dempster; Small, Perry, Hughes, Ransford, Kidd.

Tayport....the town 175 YEARS AGO 21 March 1839

One hundred and seventy five years ago, football as we know it wouldn't be born for another twenty five years, so what did the Fife Herald report? Well, under the Tayport (then Ferry Port on Craig) news in the Fife Herald of 21 March 1839 there was the following report on a booming local industry of the era...Shipbuilding.

There was launched from the Calman's building yard on the 16th inst., the schooner named Betsey Stewart of about 150 tons per register. This superior oak vessel was built for Mr Davidson, iron merchant, of Dundee. The launch was an excellent one, and not withstanding the boisterous state of the day, a numerous concourse of spectators turned out to witness it, and seemed highly gratified at the gallant style in which the vessel glided into that element on which we wish her a long and prosperous career.

After the launch about 40 gentlemen (a great proportion of whom were strangers, and many of them from Dundee) sat down to an excellent dinner prepared for them in Mr Keay's. In the course of the evening Mr Calman was justly congratulated upon his rising character as a builder, and for his model, material and workmanship—these are fast gaining him a name, and it must have been gratifying for him in so large and mixed a company, to find his merits so much appreciated. The party, after much interchange of friendly sentiment, separated highly pleased.

Musselburgh are a very good Super League side and if we are to prevail this afternoon, it's a given that our players produce something special to overcome them. Are we capable of that? Yes, I believe that and so must our players.





SNIFFING AROUND WITH THE SNOUT

The SJFA have been discussing a suggestion by Wishaw Juniors to alter the format of the Scottish Junior Cup, one of the benefits would be to alleviate fixture planning for Regional Secretaries. The key points are a) Equalisation Round would be Round 3 rather than Round 1. b) 1st Round mid-September, 2nd Round mid-October, 3rd round mid-November. c) Drawn or postponed games to take place on 2nd Saturday after scheduled game. 4) No replays. These suggestions are to be further discussed with Regional Secretaries before matters are taken any further.

There is to be an SJFA Management Committee recommendation to clubs on the formation of a new Super Premier League from season 2015/16 involving clubs in the existing East and West Super Leagues. The formation of the top league would be 8 East and 6 West. There would be a similar structure for the league below (based on the league position at completion of season 2014/15). There would be no structural changes for the leagues below the current East and West Super Leagues. The newly formed Leagues' fixtures would be administered by the SJFA.

It has been pointed out to *The Snout* that this is the tenth time that Dave Baikie has led Tayport to at least the fifth round of the 'Scottish.' That's in only eleven campaigns by the way! 90/91: 5th round v. Pollok, 91/92: quarter-final v. Glenafton, 92/93: final v. Glenafton, 94/95: quarter final v. Whitburn, 95/96: winners v. Camelon, 96/97: final v. Pollok, 2001/02: semi final v. Linlithgow, 02/03: winners v. Linlithgow, 03/04: final v. Carnoustie, plus this season, 13/14.

Further to last week's programme articles, we understand, it was Graeme Hughes, not Davie Hughes who was the No. 10 in the Tayport Violet line-up of 69 years ago. With reference to the Chris Symes article, Ian Mathers tells us he was a member of the North Fife Juniors team which lost to Dundonald Bluebell in the 1978/79 Scottish Cup. Although North Fife's life was fairly brief, Ian recalls an enjoyable time with Chris's team which he remembers contained a real assorted bunch of characters.

Tayport are on the road for the next two Saturdays. Next week it's a trip to Beechwood Park in Sauchie and the following week, February 8th, it's a visit to Volunteer Park in Armadale. Both are Super League fixtures. Scottish Cup is on 15 February and Maud visit Tayport in GA Cup on 22nd.
