HURLFORD UNITED

We welcome Hurlford United for their first ever visit to the Canniepairt for this fifth round Scottish Junior Cup tie. It would be fair to say that Hurlford, from just outside Kilmarnock, have never made any little real impact on the competition, the fourth Hurlford round being as good as it's got since at least the turn of the

It's all changed down East Avrshire way now, however, with Hurlford having developed into a force to be reckoned with in Kilbirnie the Scottish Junior game. After escaping relegation to the Hurlford District League on goal difference in 2012, it's been success all Beith the way. The Super League First Division title was secured last season and they are now well positioned to provide Auchinleck and Irvine Meadow with a serious challenge for the West Super Hurlford League Championship.

The change of fortune has come at a price but the significan investment in players would appear to delivering the goods and of course, the Scottish Cup is very much on Hurlford's horizon.

With the club taking its first steps in the top tier this season, the Hurlford committee looked to install an experienced manager at the helm and attracted Glenafton boss Darren Henderson to the post. Henderson, 20 years a senior, including two seasons at Station Park, Forfar, had already cut his teeth in the Juniors. reaching the Scottish Cup final with Cumnock in 2008, the semi finals with Dalry Thistle and then enjoying a successful spell Irvine Meadow 2-4 Hurlford with Glenafton Athletic.

Hurlford arrive here on the back of a comfortable local cup win Vics over Saltcoats last week, their first competitive action for some time. Indeed in December, January and February, Hurlford suffered something like eight postponements. Tayport had no postponements during this spell but had to plough their way through the mud of Sauchie and Armadale these past two weeks Hurlford for little reward.

129 Pears ago

Ever wondered why there are no hotels in Tayport? This report lifted from the Fife Herald in 1885 might provide some enlightenment.

At St Andrews & District Licensing Court, Wm. Oswald, Licensee of the Freemasons Hotel, Tayport [now Cobbies Inn] and Thomas Miller, Scotscraig Hotel, Tayport appealed against the decision of the St Andrews Justices in restricting their certificates to Public House Licences. The appeals were dismissed.

It was stated that the Justices in the Court below had decided to take away the hotel licences as a consequence of the abuses which were occasioned by travellers coming from a distance on Sundays to procure drink. Admiral Maitland Dougall [Tayport's representative on the Board] said 'he had always been for putting down drinking habits, especially Sunday drinking'.

Kick off is at 2.30pm and the tie will be settled by penalty kicks if at finishes all square after 90 minutes.




