We welcome Ballingry Rovers to the Canniepairt this afternoon in what is a crucial battle for both teams as they bid to avoid relegation from the Super League. Tayport trail their visitors by 13 points with both teams having five games left after today. A victory for the visitors will see them virtually achieve a position of comfort. For Tayport, a win will keep the flame flickering prior to moving into their final five games, two of which are against other teams in trouble, St Andrews United and Carnoustie Panmure.

Ballingry have been something of a surprise package this season. Current Tayport gaffer Dave Baikie and his managerial team achieved their aim of delivering promotion and a first ever place in the Super League for Ballingry last season before standing down. With many players out of contract and fixed up with other clubs, new manager Stevie Kay was forced to virtually start from scratch to build a squad for the Super League challenge. This he has certainly achieved and now has a settled squad capable of matching the best on their day. There have been a few indifferent performances and results, for example the heavy league defeats v Sauchie twice and Musselburgh, but these have been outweighed with excellent victories against the odds v Scottish Cup semi-finalists Camelon and long time league leaders Newtongrange Star.

Crucially, however, Ballingry have avoided defeat in all eight games to date v the relegation threatened quintet of Armadale, Kelty, Carnoustie, St Andrews and ourselves, winning four and drawing four. By contrast, in seven games v fellow relegation haunted teams, Tayport have yet to post a win, losing v Armadale (twice), Kelty and Carnoustie and drawing v St Andrews, Ballingry and Kelty.

One familiar face in the Ballingry line-up will be flying winger Lee | Fraserburgh Bryce who had a spell at the Canniepairt in 2010/11. Also on Ballingry's books, but out injured recently, is Tayportian Grant Manzie who signed for Rovers from Oakley earlier this season.

Tayport will be without Ryan Suttie, suspended for four games after accumulating a vast quantity of yellow cards throughout the season, and there are injury doubts over Barry Donachie, Scott Mollison, Connaire Connelly and Kenny McCulley.

The last fortnight has seen Tayport take on arguably the two biggest clubs in the East Region, both of whom are vying for the Super League title. 'Port are in the midst of an altogether different battle, with the spectre of relegation looming larger by the week.

Linlithgow visited the Canniepairt two weeks ago, under new management, with Danny Smith taking charge of the team for whom he starred for many years. Lithgae dominated the first half, but their possession did not result in many goalscoring opportunities and only one goal separated the teams at the break. It was scored in the 26th minute, following a disputed decision. Rather than give Tayport a free kick, the referee awarded a corner to the visitors. When the ball was delivered into the area, it was cleared only a far as Ruari McLennan, whose strike took a deflection on its way past Sam Morris.

The Canniepairt outfit fared much better in the second half and deservedly earned a point, albeit that it was a Linlithgow own goal which gave 'Port the equaliser. Steven McPhee sent a dangerous ball into the box and the normally steady Billy Gibson headed it into his own net, to make it one apiece, late in the game.

There was still time for the visiting Jamie McKenzie to receive his matching orders, but Tayport had to settle for a point.

Last week, Tayport travelled to meet Bo'ness United at Newtown Park, where the wind blew ferociously down the pitch, somewhat spoiling the match. Steven McPhee was denied by Mark Peat early on, but the goalkeeper knew little about his save, having seemingly been beaten by McPhee's fierce, low strike. The ball, however, somehow found its way over the bar and Bo'ness soon took advantage of their reprieve.

On eight minutes, Steve Hislop was well-placed to tap home the opener, after Andy Scott had found space on the right. Darren Gribben cut in from the same flank to curl a second goal into the corner of the net, and Bo'ness were suddenly in control of the contest.

Again, 'Port produced a better second half showing, but there would be no comeback. Steven McPhee came closest, but was just off target. The only goal of the second half went to Bo'ness, courtesy of a Darren Gribben penalty, in the closing stages.

So, despite some encouraging signs, only one point was gleaned from the two Super League fixtures. Let's hope to see greater reward this afternoon, against Ballingry.

80 PCARS AGO

This week is the eightieth anniversary of the founding of the Tayport Branch of the British Legion [now Royal British Legion]

The Fiscal said "10% under proof—almost water". The Sheriff said "The fine must be substantial—£10 or thirty days in prison"

When Tayport FC Honorary President Andy Phin reminisced over his football career from time to time he would mention that he once played in goal for Tayside Rangers. Well, given that Andy isn't the tallest of guys, the response was often something along the lines of "aye, we believe you".

The edition of 12 April 1946 lists the Tayside Rangers team to play 13th BB Company as - Phin; Carmichael and Johnstone; Anderson, Mill and Keir, Rae, Howe, Scott, Milne & Pattie. Reserves were Aitken & Paton.

Recalling that Spring day nearly 70 years ago, Andy tells us that Tayside Rangers was an under 18s team of Tayport youngsters which played friendly fixtures.

Thinking back, Andy was able to put names to most of the guys, although he concedes that he may not be entirely accurate but as a couple of the team are still knocking about, we will no doubt hear if their recall differs.





Death of Abbie Walker


Lifetime Tayport resident Abbie Walker passed away last week aged 80.

SNIFFING AROUND WITH THE SNOUT

Further to the piece in last week's programme about Jimmy Toner, the former Dundee FC cup hero of the early 1950s, we learn that there is a further connection with Tayport FC. A younger sister of Jimmy's is Cathy Rossiter, wife of Joe Rossiter, one time art teacher at Tayport School. The Rossiters, it may be recalled, when they stayed in Tayport, lived in the house in Castle Street, only recently vacated by Tayport FC Honorary President, Andy Phin. Joe, now long retired, is still a fairly regular visitor to the town, playing the penny whistle at the Bellrock Tavern's Thursday night folk sessions.

Kirkintilloch Rob Roy played their last ever league fixture at Adamslie Park, last Saturday. However, it was to be no happy ending at their home for the past 88 years with Clydebank winning by 1-0. Tayport's only visit to Adamslie was a Scottish Cup replay in 2003 when a stunning goal by Roberto Morris was the highlight of our 5-1 win. Rob Roy are moving to a new stadium in two years and next season will groundshare at Cumbernauld's Guys Meadow ground. The proceeds of the sale of Adamslie Park will underpin their new stadium at Southbank which is being developed on a Community Sports Club concept.

Five days after the final whistle had blown at Camelon's Scottish Junior Cup semi final tie v Glenafton on Sunday afternoon, there was still no result, never mind a report, on the Scottish Junior FA's website. The website did, however, carry a lengthy report on Saturday's game between Kello and Whitletts. And one wonders why the Cup can't attract a sponsor.

Former Tayport players were to the fore when Dundee Violet won their Wednesday evening Premier League relegation battle against Kirrie Thistle. Violet won 2-0 with Simon Murray scoring a double with assists from Bryan Duell and Jake Mair.

Reports of Ballingry Rovers' pending demise (ref. Pie & Bovril) are no doubt greatly exaggerated but looking at the 22 strong Fife Junior League of 1950 we see that no fewer than 14 clubs are no longer with us - Kinglassie, Markinch VR, Valleyfield, Bowhill Rovers, Lumphinnans, Auchtermuchty, Blairhall, Kelty Rangers, Comrie Colliery, Alva Albion, Lochgelly Violet, GlencraigColliery, Nairn Thistle and Rosslyn

Next Saturday's Super League game v Sauchie will be Tayport's eighth at home in ten weeks. We are at home again on May 3rd when St Andrews United pay a visit in the guarter final of the East of Scotland Cup. This time last season we had played only three home games during the same period.
