TODAY'S GAME D J LAING EAST of SCOTLAND CUP 2nd round TAYPORT v ARBROATH VICS

Visits from Arbroath Vics to the Canniepairt over the years have been few and far between and this will be only their third visit since the turn of the century. The previous two were also cup ties and whilst Tayport will be looking to complete a cup treble, Vics will be hoping that it's third time lucky.

This will be the first East of Scotland Cup meeting between the clubs, however, and Tayport will be mindful of Arbroath's success in the first round when they returned from Riverside Stadium, Perth with a 4-3 win over the fancied Jeanfield Swifts.

The win at Perth should have been no real surprise as Vics results this season have suggested there is something of a resurgence at Ogilvy Park. They have missed the goalscoring talent of Colin Watson in recent games, though, following his injury in the 3-3 draw at Downfield. After being on the bench for three games, veteran Ross Kenny got a start v North End and rewarded the manager's selection by grabbing the consolation goal in the 5-1 defeat. Also carrying a goal threat is Abdourahonan Njie who is on the six goal mark for the season.

There is experience throughout what is a fairly settled Vics outfit and no more so thanformer Arbroath FC player Steve Florence who was a choice by many Red Lichtie fans to be in Arbroath FC's best ever team.

Tayport considered themselves hard done by at Hill of Beath last week and will be out to make up for that today. Jake Mair got a nasty knock in a midweek friendly at Forfar but should be ok for today. Kenny McCulley missed out at Hill of Beath but got a lengthy work out at Station Park as did Ruaridh Donaldson. 'Port will miss the firepower of Nik Mann who is suspended for two games following his unjust red card at Keir's Park.

The tie has to be settled today with penalty kicks if the sides are all square after 90 minutes.

THE BAIKER'S BIT





Good afternoon and a warm welcome to the Port Support and to the players and officials of our visitors Arbroath Vics.

Last week saw us lose out, away to Hill of Beath. As we arrived at 12.45pm it was raining very heavily and it was looking as if the game may not go ahead as puddles were beginning to form but the rain rescinded and the game got underway.

I felt that, although our opposition had more of the ball, we were comfortably holding our own. We had Ryan Suttie booked for a high challenge which was probably the correct decision. Five minutes later we were pretty much astonished to see Nicky Mann get a red card. Both players involved slid on the ground simultaneously to gain possession of a loose ball. The Hill of Beath player arrived a fraction before Nicky and as a result, it was deemed to be an ordering off offence so we were down to ten men for over an hour.

Five minutes after the ordering off our misfortune was to continue when a strike from the edge of the box took a deflection off Paul Thomson to send Sam Morris the wrong way. To compound that, within a minute, we found ourselves 2-0 down and the ten men had a mountain to climb.

After the interval we could have crumbled to a heavy defeat but instead, over the second period, I felt we were the better side. I'm encouraged with the fitness of our players and the character they showed, particularly in the final 20/25 minutes when we scored and may even have scored another couple.

We did that in our Scottish tie at home to Renfrew the previous week, coming from 2-1 down to run out 4-2 winners and have been rewarded for that victory with an away encounter versus our league leaders Newtongrange Star. A tall order indeed but one to which we should all be looking forward.

We took an opportunity to take a friendly at Station Park on Tuesday night against Forfar Athletic. It gave us an opportunity to give all of our players game time against a relatively experienced Forfar side. I felt it was very worthwhile for us and should give our players confidence from their performance.

This afternoon we face an Arbroath Vics side who are playing well in their division and only lost out narrowly to Lochee United recently, so we shouldn't be surprised to have a game on our hands. Only a disciplined and complete performance from Tayport will do in order to advance to the next round

THIS AFTERNOON'S VISITORS **ARBROATH VICS**



Arbroath Vics are one of the oldest surviving clubs in the Junior game, having been founded in 1882 and are based at Ogilvy Park in Cairnie Loan in Arbroath.

Currently playing in the East Region's North Vics League, Vics have to go back nearly 60 years to their halcyon period of the 1950s to recall a sustained spell of on-field success. Vics dominated the Angus Junior League during that period and remaining unbeaten at home for almost three years.

Like all clubs, Vics have experienced lean times and that's certainly been the case during the last Jeanfield Swifts 3-4 Vics thirty years. A cup double back in 1983/84, winning the Cream of the Barley Trophy and Tayside Lochee United 3-2 Vics Regional Cup, is Vics' last taste of silverware.

Playing for Vics back in the early 1980s were three players well known to Tayport fans, Andy Sommerville, Jimmy Hunter and Gus Malone.

DUNMORE REPORTS



There has been no shortage of drama over the last few matches. Last time out on the Canniepairt, Tayport staged a late comeback to see off visiting Renfrew and reach the third round of the Scottish Cup.

Frew took something of a shock lead early on, through a Graham Barbour strike. Paul Thomson, however, equalised midway through the first half, when he headed home a Steven McPhee corner kick.

There were chances for 'Port to go ahead during the remainder of the half, but it was all-square at half-time. Then, early in the second period, Renfrew regained their advantage, when Chris Gilmour was afforded space and a couple of opportunities to find the back of the net.

The 1-2 scoreline lasted until the 84th minute, by which time a cup exit looked very much on the cards. Dale Robertson, however, marked his Tayport debut by bundling in the leveller, after another McPhee corner had caused problems for the opposition.

McPhee took centre stage with a couple of minutes left, when he raced onto a ball from Nik Mann and sent an exquisite lob over the advancing goalkeeper to give his side a 3-2 lead. Then, in injury-time, with 'Frew pushing men forward, Matty Adam led a break upfield, releasing Jake Mair who squared for Nik Mann to complete the dramatic victory.

Mann would have experienced contrasting emotions last week, when he was harshly ordered off twenty-two minutes into the Super League clash away to Hill o'Beath Hawthorn. The sodden conditions played a part in the dismissal, with Mann sliding in, in an attempt to win the ball, only to catch his opponent, who was also sliding into the challenge. Down to ten men, Tayport were soon punished by a deflected shot by Barry Smith and a well-taken effort by Lyall Shaw.



What was happening in Tayport 128 Years Ago, 108 Years Ago and 87 Years Ago

FIFE HERALD OCTOBER 1885

When Arbroath Victoria FC was only three years old, the football team in Tayport was known as Our Boys Tayport and the Herald reportedBlebo, Dura Den v Our Boys, Tayport. A match was played between the above clubs on the ground of the former on Saturday last and resulted in a win for "Our Boys" by one goal to

This is possibly one of the earliest records of organised football in Tayport. It's hard to imagine a game being played at Blebo Craigs and Dura Den in the modern era and one wonder by which means they travelled there

EVENING TELEGRAPH DECEMBER 1905

Let's get rid of these pesky paupers- send them to Arbroath!!

Wednesday 12 December 1905. At a meeting of the [Tayport] Parish Council, Mr James S. Young was elected chairman. It was unanimously agreed that paupers should be sent to Arbroath instead of Kinghorn as the cost was less and there was plenty of accommodation.

EVENING TELEGRAPH 9 JUNE 1926

Successful Tayport Football Club

The first general meeting of Tayport's undefeated club, Tayport Thistle FC was held last night in their clubrooms when a large turnout heard the report of the season's workings and office bearers for the coming season were elected to office. After all liabilities had been squared, the credit balance to be carried forwards was £1.8s.3d.

The office bearers elected were Hon President Mr John B. White; President Mr D.C.Campsie; Vice-President Mr H.Ross sen.; Secretary & Treasurer Mr J.G Clark. Committee - Messrs Jas. Wilkie, W.McKay, J.Garvie, J.Hughes, R.Ross Sen, R.Ross jun, and J.Gray. Trainer J.Cavanagh, Asst Trainer W.Black.
