

Our closest Super League neighbours Lochee United are our visitors today and we welcome their players, management and supporters to the Canniepairt.

Under the management of Steven Leahy and Lee Wilkie, Lochee saw their league season get off to a reasonable Lochee United start before being hit by a slump which saw them lose six Carnoustie Super League games on the trot.

There has been a significant improvement in recent weeks however, and the Thomson Park club are now unbeaten in their last three. There is no lack of spirit in the ranks as was shown in their most recent league game at home to Broxburn when they salvaged a point from a Lochee United 3-3 draw after trailing 1-3 going into time added on at Lochee United the end of the game. DUNMORE REPORTS

Let's hope for some festive cheer this afternoon, as, so far, the month of December has not been kind to Tayport. Three successive Super League reversals have prevented the Canniepairt outfit from climbing the table.

A fortnight ago, Bonnyrigg Rose came to town and inflicted a 4-0 defeat. The margin of victory seemed harsh on Tayport, but Rose were just more clinical when the chances were presented to them.

David White opened the scoring, from 'Rigg's first set-piece of a bleak, blustery afternoon. Paul Currie doubled the advantage, courtesy of a dubious penalty award. Then, on half-time, Barry Donachie diverted a low cross into his own net and 'Port trailed by three. Other than an earlier, disallowed goal, the visitors hadn't really created any more chances.

In the second period, Tayport themselves became more if a threat. Ross Grant sent the ball over the bar from a good position and Matty Adam had a shot blocked after a Kris Rollo cross had caused problems for the Rose 'keeper.

At the other end, Sam Morris made one save during the second half, but was beaten in injury time, when Ross Archibald netted a diving header.

Last weekend, at Kelty, another goal was conceded from an early set-piece, with David Carr the scorer of a near post header. Tayport, however, responded well and netted an equaliser midway through the half, when Matty Adam got in front of his man to connect with Grant Lawson's cross and beat Allan Fleming with a well-taken volley.

Kelty quickly responded though and Neil McCabe's fine finish restored their lead within minutes. On 37 minutes, central defender Roger Duffin rubbed more salt in the wound when he scored from what looked like an offside position, making it 3-1 to the hosts.

Tayport probably had the better of the second half, but only managed to pull one goal back. With around ten minutes to go, 'Port worked a short corner and Grant Lawson delivered for Dale Robertson to power home a header; his fourth goal in Tayport colours and third in four games.

FROM THE ARCHIVES....Dave Baikie's 'Dream Team' from a Port Programme article 20 years ago in 1993. After a further 20 years in the game what changes might be want to make?

DAVE BAIKIE'S 'DREAM TEAM'

The Jeanfield Swifts' Match Programme has an occasional feature in which local Junior Football personalities have the opportunity to select their 'DREAM TEAM'. In the programme for the Arbroath SC game in October, Tayport manager Dave Baikie was invited to select his Dream Team. Swifts' programme editor Ian Gordon has given his blessing to the Baiker's selection being reproduced here. The article is reproduced in full -

In the second of this series, Tayport manager Dave Baikie is given the opportunity to select his Tayside Dream Team. Here is his selection and comments.

"Picking a Dream Team is not as easy as you might think, especially as my selection spans three decades, so I've decided to pick a pool of 16 from which my team will be selected.

Goalkeeper

My two goalies would be Ged Reilly and Grant Clark. Both are Scottish Internationalists and I was fortunate to play alongside both. Ged, with two clubs, firstly in the early 1970's with my first Junior club, Broughty Athletic and then for a brief spell at Lochee United in the early 1980's and, of course I played with Grant at Downfield. Both goalkeepers had different strengths. Ged was the best at communicating and organising that I've seen while Grant's agility and shot stopping were second to none.

Defenders

Wy five defenders would be George Malone, Jimmy Stewart, Mike McManus, Graeme Forbes and Lindsay Kydd. All players I've played with or against. George Malone (Lochee United). Right back and Scottish cap, George was once described by our manager as the Rolls Royce of Junior Football and I can't disagree with that assessment. The best sweeper would be the former Chelsea player Jimmy Stewart. A real hard man and a tremendous leader and reader of the game who led Blairgowrie to the Tayside 1st Division Championship. I've chosen two centre balves. Firstly, Mike McManus of Lochee Harp, just recently retired from the playing side but what a Junior stalwart Mike has been and, of course, another Scottish cap. Secondly, Graeme Forbes. Back again at Lochee United, he had spells at Motherwell, Walsall, Dundee and Montrose — a truly outstanding centre half.

At left back I've chosen Lindsay Kydd, another Scottish Internationalist who was, in fact, voted the best player of Junior Scotland's tour of Germany in the 1970's.

Midfield.

After a great deal of thought my four midfield players would be Charlie Adam, George Morris, Billy McLardy and Jimmy Kinnes. Once again I was lucky enough to play with or against all four.

Charlie Adam was at Downfield when we went to the Scottish Cup semi final in 1984/85. Charlie, now playing and coaching at Arbroath, had all the ingredients required - brilliant in the air, could tackle, packed power in both feet and, perhaps most importantly, he was a complete 'nutter'!

Like Charlie, George Morris and I also played in a Scottish Cup semi final five years earlier with Lochee United. George was, for me, the most competitive,
tenacious ball winning midfield player, the best I've seen in Tayside or
anywhere else for that matter. He never really received the recognition which

Billy McLardy of Carnoustie Farmure would have been a great foll for Adam and Morris, adding that touch of class that every team requires. Billy, a former Dunfermline Athletic player, was the mainstay of the side during Carnoustie's most successful period in the 1970's. My final midfielder would be Jimmy Kinnes, probably the most difted player of all. Jimmy, a former Alyth United, Downfield and Brechin City player, would be the first to agree with me that he was never a taem player but was one of the most talented in Tayside. (Jimmy also

liked a pint or twenty!)

Forwards.

This was the most difficult task of all because there have been so many good forwards. I've chosen five. John Markie and Eddie Innes from the late '60's, Brian McNicoll and Brian Flynn from the '70's and Hamish Mackay from the '80's and '90's.

I watched John Markie (Lochee Harp & Jeanfield Swifts) in many great Scottish Junior Cup ties at Beechwood Park. He was a brilliant old fashioned centre. Eddie Innes, the 1960's goal machine, ex-Carnoustie Panmure and Violet has to be in this pool. Once again I was privileged to play alongside Eddie when the Griers managed to pull him out of retirement for half a season in 1977.

The two Brians, Flynn and McNicoll, had so many things in common. Not only did they share first names, both had spells at Brechin City and both were Scottish Internationalists. But most importantly, they were both prolific goalgetters. Flynny was, of course, my striking partner for many years at Lochee United. The other Brian is of Carnoustie Parmaure fame.

Lastly I must go for my present striker at Tayport, Hamish Mackay, without doubt the most consistent striker of the '80's and '90's to date. Again, a Scottish cap, who did a lot of his goalscoring damage with Lochee Harp.

That completes my 16 man squad. Now to selecting the starting line-up. Very difficult, but here we go, Dave Baikie's Dream Team.
